Plight of students

I want to highlight the "Plight of the students in H.S.S Goha" (Doda).

Firstly in this scorching heat there is no arrangement of fans in the classes, due to which the study is distant thing but even the maintenance of health of students has become difficult. The condition is worse than perhaps in prisons. Under RMS a separate grant is meant for electrification and in addition to this electric fee is charged from the students, but God knows better where it is used. The students of class X are worse victims of this situation they are compelled to sit in shed made of metal sheets (tin).

Secondly, on the name of laboratory security, library security, refundable magazine fund and prospectus are realized from the students, but all these items are in papers and students have never seen them in the school, neither the money paid by poor students which is supposed to refund is refunded to them.

Thirdly there are several flaws in the admission system, the students of influential families get mere admission here and study either at Jammu or in some private schools of district Doda, and get the benefit of RBA certificate without attending even a single lecture.

All these circumstances have put the students studying here in great difficulty and their future is being made dark by some staff members.

Hence Director School Education Jammu, Deputy Commissioner Doda and C.E.O Doda are requested to look into the matter and redress the plight of the students.

Step-motherly attitude of PDD

At the time of installation of electronic meters, tall claims were made by the top officers of PDD that there will be no power cuts in electronic metered areas/localities but today scheduled/unscheduled power cuts in metered areas of Jammu region are common, whereas unmetered areas are still enjoying continuous/regular power supply due to the blessing of the PDD or nexus between PDD & irregular consumers (having illegal connections) for the reasons best known to PDD. It is not understood as to on what basis electricity is being supplied by PDD to Jhuggi labourers using heaters, TVs, coolers etc without any meters, whether any revenue is being generated from such illegal consumers. If so, whether the revenue goes to the Govt account or personal pockets of officials of PDD?

In view of the above, we appeal to the concerned Minister and authorities of PDD to look into the matter to

- *Implement equal scheduled powers cuts in all areas ignoring the status of residents,
- *Rechecking of power load especially in posh areas including residence of top officials of PDD and influential people/VIPs,
- *Check the proper realization of electricity revenue from all consumers and
- *Special audit by Central Govt agency with the assistance of CBI to unearth the nexus between corrupt PDD officials and illegal/irregular consumers so that the consumers may get proper electricity supply.

An intervention of Chief Minister is sought by dwellers of the area for an early solution to this grave problem of power cuts so that they may get completely relieved of this tension for ever.

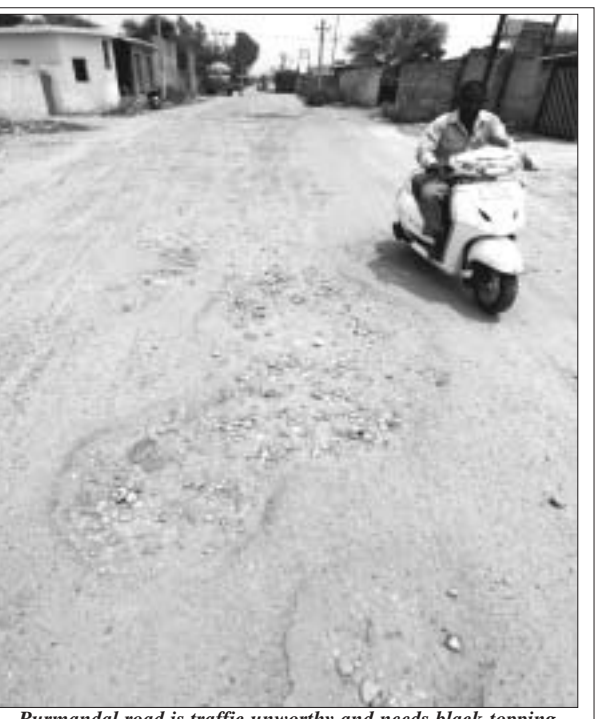

Some of the rumors heard are that, due to the chaos occurring at various chowks/rotaries such as Vikram Chowk, Jewel Chowk, Paloura, Vivekananda Chowk and High Court Chowk at Janipur, crossing near Asia Hotel etc. the traffic lights at these areas were left blinking. After being questions from the SSP Traffic Jammu, it came to notice that the lights were left blinking so that the ongoing sewerage work by the NBCC could be completed smoothly. A candidate shall be eligible for enrolment to the M.Phil/ Ph.D. if he/she has obtained Masters Degree, with not less than 55% marks in aggregate (50% in case of SC/ST Candidates) in the Programme in which he/she desired to work for M.Phil/ Ph.D.

Every enrolled candidate seeking admission to Ph.D. Programme (except those with M.Phil from University of Jammu, JRF qualified or those who have qualified NET/ SET/ SLET/ INSPiRE/ College Teachers, the Statutory Officers and non-vacational officers of the University having minimum experience of five years and M.Phil from other Universities) shall have to undergo Entrance Test. A candidate shall be required to obtain minimum 50% marks in the Entrance Test that shall be considered as the eligibility for further processing of the case of the candidate.

The candidates who have appeared in M.A/M.Sc. 4th semester/final examination can also apply for combined entrance test for M.Phil/Ph.D. and their case will be considered only if their result is declared at the time of determining the merit.
