PUBLIC NOTICE**

Whereas, on 28.07.2013, a vehicle bearing registration No. HR38S-4737 attached with M/s D2D Express Cargo loaded from Jammu was handed over by Toll Post Authority Lakhapur to Commercial Taxes Department, Lakhapur vide letter No. 797-98/LKP dated 28.07.2013. It was stated in the said letter that as per document and as per the declaration made by the driver, the said vehicle was, interalia, declared to be loaded with Walnut Kernels, which on Physical Verification were found to be banned herbs.

Whereas, the said vehicle was put to Physical Verification by Commercial Taxes Department also and it was found that 92 cartons declared to be containing Walnut Kernels were actually filled with roots of a herb commonly known as Nag Chattri (Trillium Gavanianum). Notice under Section 67(5) & 67(10) of J&K VAT Act, 2005 were issued to M/s Shafiq Sales Corporation, Hijaj Market, Kupwara 193222 as said consignee had wrongly declared (as per invoice No. 048 dated 26.07.2013) goods consigned to M/s Jagdish Kumar Rajiv Kumar, Majeeth-Mandi, Amritsar to be Walnut kernels whereas these were actually Nag Chattri (Trillium Gavanianum). Whereas, notice of hearing under Section 67(9)(a) was also issued to Sh. Madan Lal, Driver of Vehicle attached with M/s D2D Express Cargo for knowingly carrying wrongly declared goods in the vehicle.

Whereas, notices of hearing under Section 67(5) and 67(10) of J&K VAT Act, 2005 to M/s Shafiq Sales Corporation, Kupwara (TIN 01782211063) were issued through the transporter (vide No. 5524-Q dated 31.07.2013) with directions to appear before Checkpost Assessing Authority on or before 08.08.2013.

Whereas, the dealer failed to appear on or before the appointed date and hence, another notice (vide No. CTL\1396 dated 08.08.2013) was issued to M/s Shafiq Sales Corporation, Kupwara giving further opportunity to it upto 18.08.2013 to show cause as to why Penalty and Security under section 67(5) & 67(10) respectively of J&K VAT Act, 2005 be not imposed against him.

Whereas, above notice issued to M/s Shafiq Sales Corporation, Hijaj Market, Kupwara (PIN 193222) sent through Registered Post was returned undelivered to this Checkpost by the Postal department with the remarks that "addressee not found at proper place". Whereas, it is learnt through internet sources and media reports that the above commodity has a great commercial value being a medicinal plant with high international market.

Whereas, the seized herbs weighing grossly 2100 kg (approx) contained in vehicle No. HR38S-4737 is still lying at this Checkpost unclaimed despite issuance of notices to the purported consignee M/s Shafiq Sales Corporation.

Whereas, the quality of the seized goods is likely to deteriorate being perishable in nature.

Whereas, in the light of above stated circumstances, under-signed proposes to Auction the seized commodity viz Nag Chattri (Trillium Gavanianum) under Section 67(12) of the J&K VAT Act, 2005 on as is where is basis. Now, by way of this notice M/s Shafiq Sales Corporation, Kupwara or any other claimant of the goods or any other person having interest in the seized commodity is notified to show cause before 18.09.2013 (5:00 pm) as to why such Auction shall not take place. After the due date i.e 18.09.2013, no such claim shall be accepted and under-signed shall proceed with the Auction as prescribed under Section 67(12) of J&K VAT Act, 2013 without any further notice.
