

Rs 5280 crore loan to Choksi under CBI scanner; 3 bank employees questioned

NEW DELHI, Apr 11: A loan of Rs 5,280 crore extended by a consortium of 31 banks led by ICICI Bank to the companies of absconding billionaire jeweller Mehul Choksi has come under the scanner of the CBI, officials said today.

The agency questioned three officials from foreign branches of Indian banks, which had given credit facilities to the companies of absconding billionaire jewellers Nirav Modi and Mehul Choksi, on the basis of Letters of Undertaking (LoUs) issued by Punjab National Bank's Brady House branch in Mumbai.

The USD 2 billion scam became public in January after the CBI registered an FIR in the matter, but by that time both the high-profile jewellers had left India with family, they said.

Two officials of Canara Bank's branch in Bahrain, including its branch manager, and an official of

Bank of India's branch in Antwerp in Belgium were questioned by a CBI team in Mumbai, they said.

Meanwhile, the agency officials said that while their focus remains on the fraudulent LoUs, the loan of Rs 5,280 crore to the companies of Choksi in 2016 will come under its probe at a later stage.

They said whether a fresh FIR will be registered in the case or the ambit of an existing FIR will be expanded, will be decided before proceeding with action in the matter.

The agency in February had examined a senior ICICI Bank functionary too, they said.

It is alleged that Choksi and Modi got LoUs and Foreign Letters of Credit (FLCs) of USD 2 billion issued in favour of foreign branches of Indian banks based on fraudulent claims.

The accused PNB officials did not enter the instructions for these LoUs in their internal software to

avoid scrutiny.

They were sent through an international messaging system for banking called SWIFT, which is used to pass instructions among banks globally to transfer funds.

An LoU is a guarantee given by an issuing bank to Indian banks having branches abroad to grant short-term credit to the applicant.

In case of default, the bank issuing the LoU has to pay the liability to the credit-giving bank along with the accruing interest.

The PNB officials allegedly sent these messages to Indian banks - Canara Bank, State Bank of India, Bank of India, Axis Bank, Allahabad Bank - located in Antwerp, Hong Kong, Bahrain, Mauritius, Frankfurt without making entries in the banking software about the LoUs.

Upon receiving the messages from PNB under SWIFT, the banks abroad transferred these amounts into Nostro account of PNB with them.(PTI)

CJI an institution in himself, has exclusive prerogative to set up benches: SC

NEW DELHI, Apr 11: Asserting the superior authority of the Chief Justice of India, the Supreme Court today held that the CJI is an "institution in himself" and occupies a "unique position" having the "exclusive prerogative" to allocate cases and set up benches.

Rejecting a plea for guidelines on the setting up of benches and allocation of work to judges, the bench headed by Chief Justice Dipak Misra also said there cannot be a "presumption of mistrust" against the CJI.

The verdict assumes significance as it comes against the backdrop of an unprecedented press conference on January 12 by the four senior most judges of the Apex Court where they targeted Justice Misra over what they called improper allocation of cases.

Justices J Chelameswar, Ranjan Gogoi, Madan B Lokur and Kurian Joseph had said the Chief Justice was "the master of the roster" but is "only the first amongst the equals - nothing more or nothing less."

Significantly, senior advocate and former Law Minister Shanti Bhushan has also recently filed a

PIL seeking clarification on the administrative authority of the CJI as the 'master of roster' and laying down of principles in preparing the roster for allocation of cases to different benches.

"In his capacity as a Judge, the CJI is primus inter pares: the first among equals. In the discharge of his other functions, the Chief Justice of India occupies a position which is sui generis (unique)...Article 146 reaffirms the position of the Chief Justice of India as the head of the institution."

"From an institutional perspective the Chief Justice is placed at the helm of the Supreme Court. In the allocation of cases and the constitution of benches, the Chief Justice has an exclusive prerogative," the bench that also comprised Justices A M Khanwilkar and D Y Chandrachud said.

Dismissing a PIL filed by Uttar Pradesh-based lawyer Ashok Pande seeking evolution of a "set procedure" to constitute benches and allot cases to different benches, the bench said that as a "repository of constitutional trust, the Chief Justice is an institution in himself".

"The authority which is conferred upon the CJI, it must be remembered, is vested in a high

constitutional functionary. The authority is entrusted to the Chief Justice because such an entrustment of functions is necessary for the efficient transaction of the administrative and judicial work of the Court.

"The ultimate purpose behind the entrustment of authority to the Chief Justice is to ensure that the Supreme Court is able to fulfil and discharge the constitutional obligations which govern and provide the rationale for its existence," it said.

The entrustment of functions to the CJI as the head of the institution, is with the purpose of securing the position of the Supreme Court as an independent safeguard for the preservation of personal liberty, it said, adding "there cannot be a presumption of mistrust. The oath of office demands nothing less."

Simultaneous polls can be held in two phases: Law panel

NEW DELHI, Apr 11: Seeking to give shape to the Government's concept of 'one nation, one election', a law commission internal working paper has recommended holding of simultaneous Lok Sabha and assembly polls in two phases beginning 2019.

The second phase of simultaneous polls can take place in 2024, the document states.

The document has proposed amending the Constitution and the Representation of the People Act to shorten or extend the terms of State Legislative Assemblies to effect the move.

The amendments are in line with the ones recommended by a parliamentary panel and the Niti Aayog.

The working paper will be discussed by the 'full commission' on April 17. "It is a draft document and no final decision has been taken. If members suggest, changes could be made before a final report is submitted to the Law Ministry," a top law panel functionary said here today.

The states which are recommended to be covered under phase I are where assembly polls are due in 2021. These include Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.

States which will come under phase II are Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Delhi and Punjab. To hold elections in these states along with LS polls, the terms of the assemblies have to be

extended.

Based on a suggestion made by the Election Commission, the working paper also says that a no confidence motion against the Government should be followed by a confidence motion. This would ensure that if the opposition does not have numbers to form an alternative Government, the regime in office cannot be removed.

Chief Election Commissioner Om Prakash Rawat had a word of caution on simultaneous polls when he recently said that the legal framework required for holding of the two elections together will take a "lot of time" to get ready.

"We cannot put the cart before the horse. Logistical issues are subservient to legal framework. Unless legal framework is in place, we don't have to talk about anything else because legal framework will take a lot of time, making constitutional amendment to (changing) the law, all the process will take time," he said.

He had said once the legal framework is ready, the EC will deliver. "... EC is a creation of the Constitution. We have to perform willy-nilly, deliver the election, whatever way prescribed in the law," he had said. (PTI)

Deported Pak man wants to meet his family, seeks help from both Govts

KARACHI, Apr 11: A Pakistani man, who crossed into India two decades ago after being separated from his family and was deported to his country last month, today made an appeal to the Indian Government to allow him to meet his wife and three children in Mumbai on humanitarian grounds.

Siraj Khan, 33, narrating his ordeal said that he has lost the legal battle in Mumbai and that his case should be seen on humanitarian ground as he was "neither a spy or a terrorist".

"My wife, Sajida Pathan, who is an Indian national, has used every legal recourse to get me permission to remain in India with the family. We have three children and I am dying to meet them again," he told PTI over telephone.

The Ansar Burney Welfare Trust office here has taken up his case when he approached them after losing hope following a visit to various Government offices, since his return to Karachi.

Khan, a resident of Manshera in Pakistan's Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa province, said that he got separated from his parents at the age of 11 in 1996, when he boarded 'Samjhauta Express' instead of a train to Karachi from Lahore.

"I landed in Amritsar. Later I spent four years at a children's shelter in Gujarat and after turning 18, I went to Mumbai," he

said.

In Mumbai, Khan worked as a waiter for road side vendors, before finally becoming a chef.

He said in 2005, he got married to Sajida Pathan and in 2009, he surrendered himself before the Indian authorities to claim Indian nationality.

Khan said the moment he surrendered, he realised that perhaps he had made a mistake as authorities made it clear to him that they would not allow him to stay in India.

Urging the Governments of the two countries, Khan said "they should realise that there was lot in common between the people of two countries".

"Some cases should be dealt on humanitarian grounds. I just want to unite with my family again," he said.

Ruining that no Pakistan Government officials met him and heard his case, Khan said, "When Indian girl Geeta was sent back to India, their Government received her with open arms. Why is our Government treating me so insensitively? I just want to be with my 12-year-old daughter and twin sons, who are just seven-year-old."

Khan admitted that after spending a long time in India, he is now feeling strange after coming back to Pakistan.

"My father died years ago trying to search for me. Now it was my turn to worry about my children," he added. (PTI)

257 dead in plane crash

BOUFARIK (Algeria), Apr 11: An Algerian military plane crashed and caught fire today killing 257 people, mostly Army personnel and members of their families, officials said.

An AFP photographer at the scene saw the charred wreckage of the plane in a field near the Boufarik airbase from where the plane had taken off.

Hundreds of ambulances and dozens of fire trucks with their sirens wailing rushed to the scene of the crash about 25 kilometres southwest of Algiers.

The Defence Ministry said in a statement that 247 passengers and 10 crew were killed without mentioning any survivors.

Deputy Defence Minister General Ahmed Gaid Salah visited the site and ordered an investigation into the circumstances of the crash, the Defence Ministry said.

The Ilyushin Il-76 transport plane was bound for Tindouf in southwest Algeria.

Algeria has suffered a string of military and civilian aviation disasters.

Two military planes collided mid-flight in December 2012 during a training exercise in Tlemcen, in the far west of the country, killing the pilots of both planes.

In February 2014, 77 people died when a military plane carrying Army personnel and family members crashed between Tamanrasset in southern Algeria and the eastern city of Constantine.

Only one person survived after the C-130 Hercules transport aircraft came down in the mountainous Oum El Bouaghi region.

The Defence Ministry blamed the crash due to bad weather.

An Air Algerie passenger plane flying from Burkina Faso to Algiers crashed in northern Mali in July 2014, killing all 116 people on board including 54 French nationals. (Agencies)
