Forest clearance issues continue to dog projects: Rajnath

NEW DELHI, Jan 12:

Forest and environmental clearance issues continue to dog strategic projects and the Central Government will expedite the process of giving nod to them, Home Minister Rajnath Singh said today.

Inaugurating the 43rd annual day function of the Military Engineer Services (MES) builders association of India here, Singh also said there is no shortage of funds for development of infrastructure along the border areas.

The Government will expedite forest and environmental clearance issues which still continue to dog such strategic projects, Singh was quoted as saying in an official release.

Singh said Prime Minister Narendra Modi has laid emphasis on the strategic projects and relaxations will be obtained to facilitate completion of projects in national interest.

He said the private-public

partnership (PPP) model will be crucial to create strategic infrastructure.

The Home Minister said the Government has embarked upon a five year ambitious project and during 2017-2022, road infrastructure to the tune of Rs 7,00,000 crore will be built and the project include more than 2,000 kms border roads.

Pointing out that e-tendering process has led to transparency, Singh said quality delivery of the projects will be paramount.

The Home Minister called upon the armed forces and the central armed police forces for better coordination on the creation of border infrastructure.

Singh said for the first time in India's history, this Government has continued to roll out economic reforms even when the economic situation in the country has remained comfortable.

The previous Governments were compelled to take the path of reforms after landing in dire financial position, he said. (PTI)

Colder nights, warmer days in Kashmir

SRINAGAR, Jan 12: The nights in Kashmir are colder due to clear skies while the days are warmer than normal winter temperatures due to sunny days.

Srinagar recorded a low of minus 3.2 degrees Celsius, 0.2 degrees Celsius down from minus 3 degrees Celsius the previous night. The day temperature was recorded at 12.7 degrees Celsius, which is 6.1 degrees Celsius above normal.

The night temperature in Qazigund in south Kashmir settled at minus 3.2 degrees Celsius, down from yesterday's minus 2.8 degrees Celsius. The day temperature was recorded at 12.8 degrees Celsius, which is 6.8 degrees Celsius above normal.

Kokernag town saw the mercury drop to minus 2.0 degrees Celsius from yesterday's minus 1.6 degrees Celsius. The day temperature was recorded at 11.6 degrees Celsius, which is 7.3 degrees Celsius above normal.

Kupwara in North Kashmir recorded a low of minus 4.5 degrees Celsius, down from minus 2.8 degrees Celsius the previous night. The day temperature was recorded at 12.9 degrees Celsius, which is 6.4 degrees Celsius above normal.

Gulmarg recorded a minimum temperature of minus 5.4 degrees Celsius up from previous night's 8.5 degrees Celsius. The day temperature was recorded at 5.8 degrees

Celsius, which is 5.3 degrees Celsius above normal.

Pahalgam recorded a low of minus 3.5 degrees Celsius was recorded last night, down from minus 3.3 degrees Celsius the previous night. The day temperature was recorded at 10.3 degrees Celsius, which is 6.2 degrees Celsius above normal.

Kargil town continued to remain the coldest recorded place in the state as the minimum temperature there settled at minus 14.8 degrees Celsius, which is up from previous night's minus 20.6 degrees Celsius. The day temperature was recorded at 6.5 degrees Celsius.

Leh town settled at a low of minus 7.7 degrees Celsius, compared to minus 14.6 degrees Celsius the previous night. The day temperature was recorded at 4.7 degrees Celsius.

Meanwhile, the MET office has forecast mainly dry weather in the state over the next week. "The weather is likely to remain dry till January 17 and we are expecting some precipitation on January 18," Meteorological Department, Srinagar, director Sonam Lotus told Excelsior.

"We are not expecting heavy precipitation. So, there is no forecast of heavy snowfall as of now. But, we are monitoring its intensity and distribution, whether it will be light or moderate and in higher reaches only or in plains as well," he said.
