RAMBAN, Jan 13: One person was killed while another got critical injuries when an Alto car rolled down on Maitra-Gool road. In the mishap, both the occupants of the car, who were identified as Munish Singh, son of Belly Ram, resident of Balihote (at present residing at Perinote) and Vijay Singh son of Dev Raj, resident of Perinote, received serious injuries.

The locals shifted both the injured persons to District Hospital, Ramban, where Munish Singh was declared as brought dead by the doctors whereas Vijay was referred to Government Medical College and Hospital, Jammu.

Man arrested with intoxicants

Two held with poppy straw

JAMMU, Jan 13: Narwal police today arrested two persons with poppy straw.

According to a police official, during a naka checking at Narwal, a police team intercepted a truck bearing registration number JK02AF-6525 and recovered 5 kg of poppy straw from the vehicle.

The driver and conductor of the truck, who were identified as Ajit Singh son of Darshan Singh, resident of Trikuta Nagar Extension and Deepak Kumar son of Rajkumar, resident of Bhawanagar, Jammu, was arrested on the spot and the recovered poppy straw seized.

"In this connection, a case under relevant section was registered at police station Trikuta Nagar and investigations started" the police official added.

One arrested with heroin

JAMMU, Jan 13: One person was arrested today with heroin by Bishnah police.

"Today on specific information, a special naka was laid between Deoli and Kotli Mian Fateh road by a team of police station Bishnah. During checking, one motorcycle bearing registration number JK02BX-4582 tried to dodge police naka but alert cops immediately intercepted the bike", a police spokesperson said.

He said on personal search of the rider, who was identified as Avinash Kumar son of Chaman Lal resident of village Banota (RS Pura), four gram of heroin like substance (chitta) was recovered from his possession and he was arrested on spot.

"In this connection, a case FIR No 11/2018 under Sections 8/21/22/NDPS has been registered at police station Bishnah", the spokesperson said, adding, the arrest was made by a police team headed by Inspector Rajesh Sharma under the close supervision of Surinder Choudhary, SDPO RS Pura and Ramesh Kotwal, SP HQ Jammu under overall supervision of SSP Jammu, Vivek Gupta.

ED raids on Karti

NEW DELHI, Jan 13:

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) today conducted searches in 10 premises linked to Karti Chidambaram, including the residence of his father and Congress leader P Chidambaram in Delhi, in connection with its money laundering probe in the Aircel-Maxis case.

The raids were initiated early morning in nine premises in Chennai and at the Jorbagh residence of senior Chidambaram in south Delhi, official sources said.

Those searched include a chartered accountant linked to Karti, his personal assistant and Karti's residence at Thousand Lights area in Chennai, they said.

The sources said that certain "incriminating" documents have been seized during the raids. P Chidambaram termed the raids against his son "a comedy of errors" and claimed the officers were left "embarrassed" and "apologetic" as they could not find anything at his house.

He was speaking to media persons outside his Jorbagh residence here. The Central probe agency had, on December 1 last year, conducted similar searches on the premises

of a relative of Karti and others in this case. "Since they had the search warrant, I did not raise any objections to the search but I said I will record my protest that there is no FIR in respect of the scheduled crime registered by any investigating agency including the CBI. "There are obviously no proceeds of crime and the ED has no jurisdiction under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA)," P Chidambaram told reporters. However, ED sources said their action is based on the FIR registered by the agency and the CBI in the case that has not been quashed by the court.

The ED case pertains to the Foreign Investment Promotion Board (FIPB) approval granted in 2006 by the then finance Minister P Chidambaram. The agency had said it is investigating the circumstances of the said FIPB approval granted by the then Finance Minister (P Chidambaram)".

The ED also alleged that Karti has "disposed of" a property in Gurgaon, which he had allegedly rented out to a multinational company "to whom Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) approval had been granted in 2013".(PTI)
