Notice

Important Message for Fruit Growers of Jammu Division.

The fruit growers of Jammu Division are hereby advised to adopt the following cultural and protective measures during the month of August 2013 for better management of their orchards:-

1. Continue plantation of new orchards in well planned lay outs and gap filling in old orchards.
2. Do not allow water to stagnate in the orchard area and drain out excess water from the orchard area .
3. Grafting union point should be kept about 6-9" above the ground otherwise fruit plant will become wild.
4. Remove water sprouts, offshoots from newly planted plants.
5. In Mango, continue harvesting of fruits and keep the orchard area free from weeds. Prune the overcrowded and dried branches and destroy them. Spray Copper oxychloride 50 wp @3gm/ litre of water to control Dieback, Blight and Anthracnose.
6. In Citrus, drain out excess of water from the orchard. Harvest lemon fruit and spray Dimethoate 1.5ml/litre of water against Citrus psylla, Leaf miner, White fly and Lemon caterpillar. Spray Streptomycin 200 mg/litre of water or Copperoxychloride 3g/litre of water against Citrus canker after pruning /destroying the infected shoots. Repeat above spray after 10-15 days intervals. Also spray Zinc sulphate 3 g/litre of water against zinc deficiency if observed in summer flush of citrus.
7. In Guava, Continue Air layering. For control of fruit fly, destroy the fallen fruits and repeat the bait (Malathion 200ml+Gur 1kg in 100 litre of water). Harvest the fruit when still hard.
8. In Grapes, Repeat spray of Carbaryl 2 gm/litre of water against Chaffer beetle. Also spray Mancozeb 2.5 gm/ litre of water or Carbendazim 1/2 gm/ litre of water against Anthracnose .
9. In Ber, Continue budding operation and transplanting of Ber seedling in the field.
10. In Itchi, air layering be continued.
11. In Aonla - half dose of urea and MOP be applied
12. In Apple, Spray against scab during fruit formation with Hexaconazole 5 Ec @ 30 ml/100 litre of water or Tridemeton 25 wp @ 50 gm /100 litre of water or Myclobutanil 10 wp @ 30 gm/ 100 litre of water, the spray should be conducted during morning or evening hours. Repeat sprays at fortnightly intervals. Start harvesting of mid season cultivars of apple.
13. In Pear, Spray Mancozeb 300gm/100 liter of water in the morning or evening hours against Fly speck / Sooty blotch during first week of the month. Repeat sprays at 12 to 15 days intervals. Commencement of harvesting of mid-season cultivars
14. In Stone fruits (Peach, Pear, and Apricot) ,harvesting of late cultivars to be completed . Post-harvest spray of Copper compound @ 300 gm/100 litre of water be conducted to control future inoculum of Leaf curl and Blight.
15. In Walnut, Stem borer attacks become evident as saw dust is observed coming from the holes for controlling the attack, Clean the holes by a thin wire, then inject Chloropyrifos @ 2 ml/ of water followed by plugging with cotton soaked in petrol. Cover the infested area with mudplaster
16. For fruit plant nurseries, (i) Budding of nursery stock of apple and pear be continued. (ii) Burying of green manure crops in vacant plots of nurseries to be completed. (iii) Start budding of walnut nursery rootstock.

Whereas one person namely Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Gian Chand R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur obtained Pharmacist's Registration Certificate under Category 'd' vide no : 10564 dated 19.09.2008 from J&K Pharmacy Council on the basis of following documents :

1. Form-BB duly filled by the applicant.
2. Attested Photocopy of the State Subject.
3. Attested Photocopy of the Secondary School Examination
4. Experience Certificate issued by M/s Sharma medical Hall, Jaganoo for the period March, 1996 to 2002
5. Affidavit duly attested by Executive Magistrate First Class ,Udhampur sworn by one Sh Ashwani Kumar :Prop cum Qualified person of M/s Sharma medical Hall, Jaganoo to the effect that Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Gian Chand R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur has worked in his firm for the period March, 1996 to 2002
6. Affidavit duly attested by Executive Magistrate First Class ,Udhampur sworn by one Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Gian Chand R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur to the effect that he has worked with the firm M/s Sharma Medical Hall, Jaganoo for the period March, 1996 to 2002.

Whereas , a complaint has been received from SP (Central) ,State Vigilance Organization, J&K, Jammu vide letter no : SVO-Med-PP-28/2013-4747-48 dated 22.04.2013 in which it has been mentioned that Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Gian Chand R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur has fraudulently obtained Pharmacist Registration Certificate & subsequently Retail Drug Sale Licenses vide no : UR/01/460 & UR/01/461 on Form -20 & Form -21 respectively in the name & style M/s Om Medical Hall at Village Dhalpod, Udhampur through impersonation/misrepresentation by using documents of a person with synonymous initials.

Whereas this Office vide letter no : Pe/13/5511-13 dated 01.05.2013 has referred the above said complaint to the Deputy Controller, DFCO, Jammu for carrying out an enquiry in the matter along with Assistant Controller Drugs, Kathua/Samba.

Whereas , Deputy Controller, DFCO, Jammu vide letter no : DCO/J/ 1238-40 dated 05.06.2013 confirmed that Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Rudi Ram R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur has obtained the Pharmacist's Registration Certificate as well as Retail Drug Sale Licenses in his favour through unfair means using the documents of Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Gian Chand R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur;

Whereas it has also been given to understand that the Licensing Authority (Retail) ,Udhampur/Reasi/Ramban has since cancelled the Retail Drug Sale Licenses granted in favour of M/s Om Medical Hall at Village Dhalpod, Udhampur bearing no : UR/01/460 & UR/01/461 vide his letter no : ADC/UDH/2011/4465-4467 dated 25.06.2012 on the request made by the surrogate person;

Whereas in terms of the findings placed in the file duly verified from Tehsildar Settlement ,Udhampur it has become explicitly clear that Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Rudi Ram has obtained Pharmacist's Registration Certificate which subsequently made him eligible for obtaining a retail drug license under the provisions of the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 & rules thereunder by means of misrepresentation and suppression of material facts.

Now, Keeping in view the above position of the case and in exercise of powers vested with the undersigned under section 23(1),23(2) of J&K Pharmacy Council Act, 2011 , the Pharmacist Registration Certificate No: 10564 , Dated 19.09.08 issued in favour of Sh. Om Parkash S/o Sh. Gian Chand R/o Dalpod , Tehsil & Distt Udhampur is hereby cancelled with immediate effect and the name of the Pharmacist is removed from the Pharmacist's Register maintained by the Council.

Trained teachers should get pension as per their grade: HC

MUMBAI, July 31:

The Bombay High Court has ruled that trained teachers should be given pension applicable to employees in their grade as it would be illegal and unjustified to give them pension of untrained teachers.

Accordingly, justices S J Vajifdar and M S Sonak recently directed the civic body in Mumbai to pay pension to an assistant trained teacher, who retired from the same post after 27 years of service in a municipal school, on the basis of the pension applicable to a trained teacher.

Charumathi Kannappa Mudaliar, right from the date of her appointment and up to the date of her retirement, i.E upto October 31, 2009, was paid salary and other benefits payable to an assistant trained teacher.

There is no dispute that the service conditions of Mudaliar entitled her to draw pension upon superannuation. However, for a period of about two years, no pension was paid to her. Ultimately, pension payments commenced on the basis that she had superannuated as an assistant untrained teacher.

There is a difference in the pay scales of Assistant trained teachers and assistant untrained teachers. This difference naturally persists in the pensionary benefits as well.

After hearing the arguments, the court ruled that she is entitled to pension applicable to trained teachers and hence asked the municipal authorities to pay pension accordingly.

They have been asked to pay her the difference in the pension amounts of trained and untrained teachers and also pay interest of 12 per cent on these arrears by September 2015.

The impugned action was defended, saying Mudaliar's initial appointment as an assistant trained teacher was defective. The qualifications for appointment of assistant trained teacher was SSC/HSC with Diploma in Education (D.Ed), while she had B.A. And B.Ed (Physical Education and History) degrees.

Mudaliar's qualifications were not only valid in the relevant field, but were higher than requisite qualification. Despite the same, her initial appointment 27 years prior to the date of her superannuation was not only virtually annulled, but the respondents even sought recovery of the difference in pay between trained and untrained teachers.

They also resisted payment of pensionary benefits commensurate to the post of a trained teacher.

The high court quashed and set aside the impugned communication of December 29, 2011, which directed recoveries from the petitioner as regards her salary and other benefits. (PTI)
