Form No. 20 has to be filled, which is available at <http://Parivahan.nic.in>, jkttrans.nic.in and also in the offices of RTO/ARTO, located at every District head-quarters of J&K Registration of vehicles involves following process. After filling-in the Form No. 20, one has to attend the Regional Transport Officer/ ARTO's in their respective Districts along with the permissible fee prescribed for such vehicles. After the purchase of a vehicle, a sale letter is issued by the dealer, thereafter Form No. 20 is to be filled-in by the owner as per the details of the Sale letter with reference to the class of vehicle, manufacturer, Chassis No., Engine No., Type of body, Colour, un-laden weight, Gross Vehicle Weight, detail of insurance and endorsement for hypothecation from banker/financier. The application made in Form No. 20 alongwith the relevant papers viz. (i) Form No. 21, (ii) Form No. 22, (iii) Temporary registration Certificate, (iv) copy of insurance certificate, (v) address proof, pan Card copy or duly filled and signed Form No. 60 (I.T. form) is to be presented before the RTO/ARTO (registering authority), Form (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) above are to be provided by the dealer at the time of sale. Registering authority marks the application to the concerned dealing assistant, (Registration Section) who will check the file and relevant documents and the file will be submitted back to RTO/ARTO, who will further mark the file to the Board of Inspection Board of Inspection, (BOI) will examine the vehicle, on various parameters and will check and trace the chassis No. of the vehicle on Form No. 20, in the personal presence of the purchaser to avoid any difficulty/complicity, Board of Inspection will provide the services within the same day, BOI will return the file to RTO/ARTO for formal approval After approval, the registration fee is to be deposited, along with token tax at the specific window in the RTO/ARTO office, against a computerized receipt. The reference no. of the receipt, is noted on the file and then the file goes to the registration clerk, who in turn feeds different items on Vahan Software. Subsequently, the RTO/ARTO allots the registration number, Finally, the print-out is taken and RTO/ARTO put his signature on the registration certificate (RC) which is delivered to the concerned owner on the specific window.

The vehicle in question, has to be registered within 30 days, under the provisions service Guarantee Act 2011 however the registering office will endeavour to dispense the services, within the shortest possible time period. **Ford India sales up 48 pc
 in July at 12,338 units**

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

Car maker Ford India today reported 48.23 per cent increase in total sales in July this year at 12,338 units on the back of newly launched compact sports utility vehicle EcoSport.

The company had sold a total of 8,323 units in the same month last year, Ford India said in a statement.

Domestic sales also went up by 26.15 per cent to 7,867 units in July this year as against 6,236 units in the same month last year, it added.

The company exported 4,471 units last month compared to 2,087 units in the year-ago period, a jump of over two-fold.

"With Chennai strongly positioned as a regional export hub for Ford, we are excited to register the highest-ever exports too and are hopeful that the Chennai-built vehicles will satisfy customers in international markets," Piparsania said. (PTI)

**Mahindra & Mahindra July
 sales down 21.17 pc**

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

Auto-maker Mahindra & Mahindra today reported 21.17 per cent decrease in its total sales at 37,096 units in July, 2013.

The company had sold 47,059 units in the same month in 2012, Mahindra & Mahindra (M&M) said in a statement.

In July this year, M&M's domestic sales stood at 34,490 units as against 42,799 units in the same month last year, down 19.41 per cent.

M&M's exports declined by 38.82 per cent to 2,606 units during the month from 4,260 units in July, 2012.

"Over the last few months, the auto industry has been going through one of its worst phases of the last decade with planned shutdowns being taken by companies to correct demand supply mismatch. The industry is in desperate need for an immediate stimulus from the government" M&M Chief Executive (Automotive Division) Pravin Shah said.

He added that with interest rates remaining unchanged and the rupee plunging to new lows, lowering of excise duty is the need of hour which would rev up demand for auto products, leading up to festive season. (PTI)

**Yamaha Motor India total
 sales up 57 per cent in July**

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

Two-wheeler maker Yamaha Motor India Sales (YMIS) today reported 57 per cent increase in total sales at 58,151 units for July, 2013.

The company had sold a total of 36,993 units in the corresponding month last year, YMIS said in a statement.

In the domestic market, the company registered a rise of 35 per cent in its sales at 37,494 units compared to 27,858 units in the year-ago period, it added.

In the export markets, YMIS sold 20,657 units in July, 2013 as against 9,135 units in the same month last year, achieving a growth of 126 per cent. (PTI)

**Renault India July sales
 up two-fold at 3,763 units**

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

Renault India today reported two-fold increase in sales in July at 3,763 units from 1,776 units in the same period of previous year.

Despite challenging conditions in the automotive market, Renault India achieved sales of 3,763 units in July 2013, growing over two fold year on year, Renault India said in a statement.

"Renault has had a very eventful two years in India, achieving sales volumes, network reach and brand visibility comparable to players who have been present in the industry for more than a decade," Renault India Managing Director Marc Nassif said.

Renault India sold a total of 3,763 units in July, with the Duster accounting for 3,089 units, the Scala 371 units, Pulse 292 units, Fluence 10 units and Koleos 1 unit.

"Duster has played a crucial part not just in Renault's success in India, but also in spearheading the changing landscape of the Indian automotive industry," Renault India Executive Director, Marketing and Sales Sumit Sawhney said. (PTI)

**Mahindra tractor sales
 up 12 pc in July**

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

Auto major Mahindra & Mahindra (M&M) today reported an increase of 12 per cent in its total tractor sales to 18,469 units in July 2013.

The company had sold a total of 16,521 units in the same month last year.

Domestic tractor sales has increased by 15 per cent at 17,771 units in the month under review as against 15,495 units in the same month last year, M&M said in a statement.

"The second quarter has begun well and the monsoon this year has been normal, which augurs well for the farm sector. A revival in agri-production will provide greater impetus to the economy amidst the overall slowdown," Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd Chief Executive, Tractor and Farm Mechanisation, Rajesh Jejurikar said.

However, its exports were declined by 32 per cent to 698 units in July 2013 as against 1,026 units in July 2012, it said. (UNI)

**Maruti July sales up 1.3 pc
 at 83,299 units**

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

Maruti Suzuki India Ltd (MSIL), country's largest car-maker, today reported a marginal 1.3 per cent increase in its total sales in July at 83,299 units.

The company had sold 82,234 units in the same month last year.

The company said its domestic sales has increased by grew 5.8 per cent during the reported month to 75,145 units as against 71,024 units in the same month last year, MSIL said in a statement.

Exports during the month has declined by 27.3 per cent to 8,154 units as compared to 11,210 units in July last year, it said.

Sales of mini segment cars, including M800, Alto, A-Star and WagonR, grew by 15.8 per cent to 33,587 units as compared to 28,998 in the year-ago month, it added. (UNI)
