Taj reviews logistic facilities

SRINAGAR Aug 1: In order to review logistic facilities at GMC Srinagar, in view of enhancement of intake capacity for MBBS course, Minister for Medical Education and Sports Taj Mohud-Din today visited the college and undertook marathon discussions with the faculty and administration.

The Minister directed augmentation of space for students for which he asked the Principal to prepare to complete proposal and submit it to the Government. Mr. Taj also directed for removing bottlenecks coming in the way of career advancement

of the faculty. He further directed for adoption of Continuous Medical Evaluation (CME) for the professional assessment of faculty. He asked the faculty to work with zeal so that the college regains its past glory.

The Minister also directed for delegation of powers of deputiation to conferences, seminars, workshops of faculty members to the Dean/Principal.

He also reviewed the hostel accommodation of students and other recreational facilities available to them.

The meeting was told that GMC has affiliated bed strength of 2300 beds at present and is capable to admit around 250 students annually.

Radia tape

SC pulls up IT dept, CBI for not acting on info

NEW DELHI, Aug 1:

The Supreme Court today pulled up the Income Tax department and CBI for not taking action in the last five years on information gathered from tapped phone conversations of Niira Radia with corporate honchos, politicians and others, saying it is "not a happy situation".

A bench of justices G S Singhvi and V Gopala Gowda said the conversations were tapped five years back but government authorities remained idle and questioned whether they were waiting for the court's order to act.

"The tapping was done five years ago, what have they (government authorities) done so far? Were they waiting for court's order?," the bench asked.

"It is not a happy situation that action will be taken only after court's order," the bench said. It asked the IT department to place before the bench all original records pertaining to authorisation of tapping of Radia's phones.

The court directed the IT department, which had tapped Radia's phones, to apprise it whether the officers entrusted with the task of tapping had informed their seniors about the

contents of the recording and whether CBI was informed about criminality with regard to matters referred to in the conversations.

The bench directed the IT department to comply with its order by August 6 when the matter will be taken up for further hearing.

The conversations were recorded as part of surveillance of Radia's phone on a complaint to the Finance Minister on November 16, 2007 alleging that within a span of nine years she had built up a business empire worth Rs 300 crore. (PTI)

Protest against Health Deptt

RAJOURI, Aug 1: The people held protest demonstration against the Health Department outside District Hospital here today.

The people led by Awami National Conference district president, Mushtaq Bhat and some party workers assembled at the main gate of the hospital here during the day and held protest demonstration against the State Health Department. They alleged that with the supply of spurious drugs and sub-standard glucose, there was great risk to the lives of the patients.

They pointed out that a youth hailing from Thanamandi died and many suffered reaction due to glucose in hospital here. The people at the helm of affairs are playing with the lives of the people but Government was sleeping over the matter. They also raised slogans against the Health Minister and demanded high level inquiry into the matter.



In pursuance to the approval conveyed by the Administrative Department vide letter No. ME/Gaz/228/2013 dated 17.7.2013, applications on the prescribed form to the tenure post of Demonstrator Community Dentistry (Public Health Dentistry) which can be had from the office of the undersigned on cash payment of Rs. 300/- (Rupees three hundred only) are invited from the permanent residents of J&K State by selection from the Jammu and Kashmir Health and Family Welfare (Gazetted) Service on merit basis OR from the candidates not in Government service having requisite qualification in the speciality as recognized by the Dental Council of India by engagement, to the tenure post of Demonstrator in the Department of Community Dentistry (Public Health Dentistry) of this college for a period of one year in the first instance further extendable upto 3 years with satisfactory work and conduct.

CONDITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant should be in-service Dental Surgeon in J&K Health Department and should have rendered minimum two years service in Health Department as per the policy/guidelines issued by the Govt. vide order No. 164-ME of 2012 dated 2.3.2012. The pay scale of the post is Rs. 9300-34800 with grade pay of Rs. 5400 for inservice doctors.
2. The doctors who are not in government service shall be paid consolidated pay equal to basic pay for the post of Dental Surgeon in the Health Department as per SRO 93 of 2009 dated 15.04.2009 plus the dearness allowance.
3. The applicant should be B.D.S./M.D.S. or equivalent as recognized by the Dental Council of India.
4. The applicant having Post Graduate (MDS) qualification in the concerned discipline as recognized by Dental Council of India will be given preference in pursuance to Govt. order No. 706-HME of 2007 dated 11.1.2007.
5. The in-service applicant has to forward his/her application form through proper channel.
6. The in-service doctors shall be allowed to participate in the selection process only with the prior permission of the Administrative Department as per the policy/guidelines issued by the Govt. vide order No. 164-ME of 2012 dated 2.3.2012.
7. The applicants who have already worked as Registrar / Demonstrator / Tutor in any discipline are not eligible and their applications shall not be considered and will stand rejected.
8. The applicants who have earlier been appointed as Registrar / Demonstrator / Tutor in any discipline but have left the same before completing the tenure shall not be considered.
