

## BCCI moves SC against HC order declaring probe panel illegal

NEW DELHI, Aug 5: BCCI today approached the Supreme Court challenging Bombay High Court's order that held as illegal and unconstitutional the two-member probe panel constituted by it to look into spot-fixing and betting charges in the IPL tournament as illegal.

The Board sought immediate stay of the High Court's order while submitting that the panel was constituted according to rules and was legal.

In a severe blow to BCCI and its president-in-exile N Srinivasan, the High Court on July 30 that the two member commission was constituted in violation of the rules framed by the BCCI.

"The (probe) Commission was not duly constituted and was contrary to and in violation of the provisions of Rules 2.2 and 3 of Section 6 of the Operational Rules (of BCCI)," the High Court had said and also rejected Srinivasan's plea for a

stay on its order to enable him move a higher court in appeal.

The High Court order came just two days after the panel, comprising two former judges of the Madras High Court Justices T Jayarama Chouta and R Balasubramanian, submitted its report on July 28 giving a clean chit to all those against whom the probe was conducted.

The Commission had gone into the charges against India Cements Ltd, owners of IPL franchise Chennai Super Kings, its former Team Principal Gurusath Meiyappan, son-in-law of BCCI's President-in-exile N Srinivasan, and Raj Kundra, co-owner of Rajasthan Royals.

The commission was set up by BCCI and IPL Governing Council after surfacing of the betting and fixing scandal.

The High Court had said rule 2.2 of the Operational Rules mandated presence of at least one member of the IPL Code of Behaviour Committee on the Commission. (PTI)

## Ajay stuns Wong, Kashyap too wins in World Championship

GUANGZHOU (CHINA), Aug 5: Shuttler Ajay Jayaram notched up a stunning victory over higher-ranked Wing Ki Wong of Hong Kong, while Parupalli Kashyap survived a scare in the opening round of the men's singles competition in the 2013 BWF World Championships here today.

The 25-year-old Ajay, ranked 24th, was good in his attack as well as defence and played a patient game to beat world number 12 Wong 22-20 17-21 21-15 in a 64-minute duel. He will next take on Pablo Abian of Spain in the second round.

However, world number 13 Kashyap had an unexpectedly tough encounter against 98th ranked Raul Must of Estonia. Raul troubled the Indian early in the match but ran out of steam as Kashyap managed a 19-21 17-21 21-9 win in 56 minutes.

But it was a bad day in office

for India's doubles and mixed doubles pairs as they failed to cross the first hurdle.

While the combinations of Aparna Balan and Arun Vishnu lost to Chinese Taipei's Min Chun Liao and Hsiao Huan Chen 15-21 17-21 in the mixed doubles, Ashwini Ponnappa and Tarun Kona suffered a 18-21 21-12 19-21 defeat to Japan's Hirokatsu Hashimoto and Miyuki Maeda in the opening round.

In the women's doubles, Aparna and Siki Reddy N too lost in the opening round, going down to England's Lauren Smith and Gabrielle White 15-21 17-21 in 34 minutes.

In another match, Dane pair of Line Damkjaer Kruse and Marie Roeske ended the campaign of Pradnya Gadre and Ashwini Ponnappa with a 21-23 21-18 21-17 victory over the Indian pair in the women's doubles event.(PTI)

## Somdev zooms up to 115 in latest singles rankings

NEW DELHI, Aug 5: Somdev Devvarman today jumped 14 places to 115 in the latest ATP singles rankings, courtesy his pre-quarterfinal appearance at the Citi Open.

Somdev had lost to American John Isner in the round of 16 at the Washington ATP 500 event, last week, earning 55 ranking points.

In the doubles, Rohan Bopanna maintained his third rank. Mahesh Bhupathi's position was unchanged at number seven while Leander Paes lost a place to be 10th.

Left-hander Divij Sharan slid to 72, having lost four positions while his partner Purav Raja gained two places to be 86th on the list.
