Antony retracts statement, blames Pak for killings

Under sustained attack from the Opposition over his statement on the killing of five uphold the sanctity of the LoC ever be doubted," the Minister soldiers in Poonch sector, **Defence Minister A K Antony** today retracted from it and squarely blamed the Pakistan Army for the "brutal" act.

He also warned that the Tuesday incident will have "consequences" on India's behaviour on the Line of Control and on relations with Pakistan.

"It is now clear that the specialist troops of Pakistan Army were involved in this attack when a group from Pakistanoccupied Kashmir (PoK) side crossed the LoC and killed our brave jawans," he said in the statement aimed at controlling the damage by his Tuesday's version

The fresh statement by Defence Minister A K Antony in the Lok Sabha, amending his earlier controversial version, ensured peace with the main Opposition which expressed happiness that he has "accepted his mistake" and rectified it.

Sharif sad over LoC killings ISLAMABAD, Aug 8:

Govt directs HoDs, DCs not to leave Hqrs **Excelsior Correspondent**

JAMMU, Aug 8: The State Government today reiterated its direction to all Heads of Departments (HoDs), District Development Commissioners and other divisional and district level officers not to leave their Headquarters without prior permission of designated authorities.

A Government Order issued today by GAD Secretary MA Bukhari said these instructions of the Government were being reiterated to all concerned officers for strict compliance.

The matter has been further reviewed and it has been decided to direct all District Development Commissioners not to leave their Headquarters in the eve of Eid," the Order said.
