

Govt committed to create better basic infrastructure: Sham

JAMMU, Aug 8: Minister for PHE, Irrigation and Flood Control, Sham Lal Sharma today said that Government is committed to create better basic infrastructure in every nook and corner of the state particularly in rural and far-off areas.

The Minister was addressing the monthly public meeting at Akhnor which was attended by large number of people, local sarpanchs and Panchs besides senior officers of various departments.

Addressing the gathering on the occasion, Mr. Sham said that Government was keen to reach out to people in every area to address their grievances and accommodate the demands in a phased manner. He said that during past more than four years, unprecedented development has been witnessed in the state. He said that during the period several projects pertaining to PHE, irrigation, education, health and

power have been taken in hand in Akhnor constituency. He asked the executive agencies to make optimum use of funds and complete the projects in a time bound manner.

He urged the people particularly local representatives to personally monitor the development works being executed in their respective areas. He said that faster development of unattended areas was on the top priority on the government agenda.

Meanwhile, Sham inaugurated a slit lamp machine in Sub District Hospital, Akhnor which was provided by the Rotary Club of Akhnor. Later, the Minister also chaired the Rogi Kalyan Samiti meeting and reviewed healthcare services being extended to the patients of Akhnor and Chowki Choura blocks. He asked for maintaining cleanliness in the hospital.

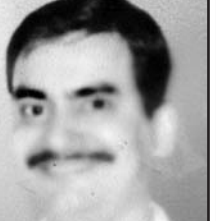

Aadhaar not mandatory to avail Govt services: Rajeev Shukla

NEW DELHI, Aug 8:

Aadhaar card is not a must for availing services like opening bank accounts, admission in school and obtaining passport, Parliament was informed today.

"Aadhaar card is not mandatory to avail government services like opening basic (bank) accounts, admissions in schools, obtaining passport etc by any individual," Planning Minister Rajeev Shukla said in written reply to Rajya Sabha.

However, according to the Minister, the consumers would be required to seed their Aadhaar number with their bank account to avail subsidy on domestic cooking gas (LPG) after three months from the launch of Direct Benefit Transfer (LPG) in their area.

The government has launched the DBT for LPG consumers in 20 districts in the country. There are plans to launch the DBT in other parts of the country.

The Minister clarified that Aadhaar is not mandatory for receiving domestic LPG cylinder at market determined price.

Meanwhile, in another written reply to the upper House, Shukla informed that as on July 26 this year, the total number of Aadhaar enrollments generated was 39.36 crore and the number of enrollment packets under process was 42.65 crore.

Shukla also said that about 1.44 crore Aadhaar numbers have been generated in Delhi as on July 26, 2013.

He assured the House that there is no possibility of enrollment agencies misusing the collected data as the moment enrollment process in respect of an individual is completed, the data captured by the agency is encrypted and stored in a digitally encrypted format.

The Minister also informed the House that as many as 1,051 permanent enrollment centres were there in the states where UIDAI is enrolling residents.

The facilities available at these centres include new enrollment, biometric updates, demographic updates, e-aadhaar letters printing, status check, lost EID/UID enrollments and re-enrollments.

Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), implementing Aadhaar project, has plans to increase the number of these centres to about 2,000 in 18 states and union territories by March 2014. (PTI)

Govt website gives access to 3,500 data banks

NEW DELHI, Aug 8:

General public can now access over 3,500 government data banks on a single website having a wealth

of information, ranging from beneficiaries under various schemes to industrial output numbers. Launching the website www.Data.Gov.In, Telecom and IT Minister Kapil Sibal said: "Ever since the UPA government came to power, information revolution started with the Right to Information Act that has got up to a stage where we are willing to share data with everybody. We realise that in absence of data you can not take appropriate decision." The website carries over 3,500 government data banks, according to an official release. People in government must change their mindset and be willing to share more information barring those piece of information that can have security implications, he said. (PTI)
