**Yaar Mohd, Kanmat, Manbinder emerge winners in shot-put**

 POONCH, Aug 12: Yaar Mohammad, Kanmat Hussain and Manbinder Singh secured first, second and third positions respectively in the shot-put event organized during two day long District Athletic Championship by District Athletic Association under the aegis of J&K Amateur Athletic Association at Gulpur ground today.  
 In Discus Throw, Ishtiaq Ahmed claimed first position, whereas Sarfraz Ahmed and Gurpreet Singh claimed second and third positions respectively.  
 In under 19 girls (100 meter), Majeeda Begum, Ruksana Kouser and Iram Banoo secured first, second and third positions respectively.

In 800 meters, Nagdh Tubassm, Riya Sharma and Ravneet Kour bagged first, second and third positions respectively, whereas in 1500 meters, Nagdh Tubassum, Nazira Bi and Hanifa Bi bagged first, second and third positions respectively.  
 In under 16 boys (100 meters), Nawab Ahmed, Mohammad Sajad and Navdeep Ahmed claimed first, second and third positions respectively, whereas, in 200 meters, Manbinder Singh, Mohammad Shakil and Imran Khan emerged winners.  
 In 400 meters, Mohammad Javid, Fareed Ahmed and Sajad Ahmed claimed first, second and third positions respectively, whereas in 800

meters, Nawab Ahmed, Nazir Hussain and Manpreet Singh emerged winners.  
 In under 19 boys (100 meters), Yaar Mohammad secured first position, whereas Nazir Hussain and Iftikhar Hussain bagged second and third positions respectively.  
 In 200 meters, Yaar Mohammad claimed first rank, while the second and third ranks were secured by Cham Kour Singh and Harpreet Singh respectively.  
 In 400 meters, Rihal Ahmed, Vasit Ali and Gurpreet Singh secured first, second and third positions respectively, whereas in 800 meters, Navdeep Singh, Mohammad Sarfraz and Zaffer Ahmed emerged winners.  
 In 1500 meters, Ishtiaq Ahmed claimed first position, whereas the second and third positions were bagged by Iftakhar Ahmed and Manu Sharma.  
 In 3000 meter, Zakir Hussain, Sajad Ahmed and Mohammad Alyias secured first, second and third positions respectively.  
 On the occasion, Prof Bagh Hussain, HoD, Zoology Department, Government Degree College was the chief guest, while Manzoor Hussain, Sarpanch, Kharikarma was the guest of honour.  
 The matches were officiated by Rajinder Singh, PEM, Lovinder Singh, Sourab Sharma and Nirdoush Kumar, PETS, Jarnail Singh teacher, and Harsimran Kour, BPed.  
 The championship was organized under the supervision of Gurmeet Singh, Organizing Secretary, District Athletic Association.

**Dhawan's historic effort takes India A to tri-series final**

PRETORIA, Aug 12: Shikhar Dhawan smashed his way to the record books with a breathtaking 248-run knock as he singlehandedly guided India A to a 39-run victory over a fighting South Africa 'A' and into the tri-series final, here today.  
 The 27-year-old Delhi left-hander blasted a 150-ball-248, which is only the second highest individual List A score behind former Surrey batsman Alistair Brown's 268 against Glamorgan at the Oval, back on July 19, 2002.  
 Riding on Dhawan's brilliance and some solid support from skipper Cheteshwar Pujara (109 not out), India A amassed a mammoth 433 for three in 50 overs.  
 The target was a tall-order for the home team but their batsmen fought hard before being bowled out for 394 in 48.4 overs.  
 Reeza Hendricks (102, 78 balls, 12x4, 2x6) and Vaughn van Jaarsveldt (108, 91 balls, 7x4, 5x6) centuries were not good enough to take the hosts past the finishing line.  
 India A will meet Australia A in the final on Wednesday.  
 The day undoubtedly belonged

to Dhawan, who hit 30 boundaries and seven sixes in his innings during which he surpassed Sachin Tendulkar's 200 not out against South Africa in 2010 at Gwalior and Virinder Sehwag's 219 against West Indies in Indore back in 2011.  
 If Dhawan's first 100 came off only 86 balls, the second hundred came off only 46 balls as he raced to his maiden List A double hundred in only 132 balls with a push off left-arm seamer Beuran Hendricks' bowling at the LC de Villiers Oval.  
 Just when it looked that he would eclipse the world record, he was caught by wicketkeeper Dane Vilas of Rusty Theron's bowling trying another slog shot.  
 Such was his domination that out of his 162 out of his 248 runs came in only 37 scoring strokes.  
 Dhawan added 285 runs in only 33.5 overs with his skipper Pujara, who also helped himself to a three-figure mark having faced 97 balls and hit eight boundaries.  
 Dhawan started smashing bowlers from the word 'go' as the first ball of the match bowled by seamer Hardus Viljoen was driven towards long-on for a boundary.(PTI)

**Negi crushes Kryvoruchko to go one up in World Chess Cup**

NORWAY, Aug 12: World's second youngest ever Grandmaster Parimarjan Negi of India outplayed higher-ranked Yuri Kryvoruchko of Ukraine in the first round of the World Chess Cup which began here.  
 Fresh from some strong performances including a recent victory in the Politiken Cup with a whopping 9/10 score, Negi proved that his warm up tactics before the World Cup were perfect as Kryvoruchko proved no match.  
 It turned out to be a mixed day for the Indians in the first round of this knockout event as B Adhban held higher ranked Grandmaster Evgeny Alekseev to a draw while Krishnan Sasikiran drew easily as black against

Romanian Grandmaster Constantin Lupulescu. Indian champion G Akash, however, lost his first game of the two-game mini-match against Fabiano Caruana of Italy. Akash now needs a victory in the return game to stay in the hunt in the 128-players event.  
 Negi was the star of the day as he almost effortlessly outplayed Kryvoruchko in all departments of the game. Playing the black side of a Sicilian Scheveningen, Negi used a new idea that unsettled the Ukrainian early and showed precise technique to go one up.  
 Kryvoruchko now faces a daunting task to make a comeback as he has to win with black pieces. (PTI)

**Gowda qualifies for final round in World Athletics**

MOSCOW, Aug 12: India's Vikas Gowda today advanced to the men's discus throw final in the 14th IAAF World Athletics Championships after finishing seventh overall in the qualification round here.  
 National record holder and reigning Asian champion Gowda finished fourth in qualification round A with a best throw of 63.64m which he came up in his first attempt on the third day of the competition at the Luzhniki Stadium.  
 Reigning world and Olympic champion Robert Harting of

Germany was the lead thrower going into the final round with an effort of 66.62m.  
 Piotr Malachowski of Poland was second overall in the qualification with 66.00m while London Olympics bronze medallist Gerd Kanter of Estonia was third with 65.54m.  
 Gowda has a personal best and national record of 66.28m against his name.  
 The 12-athlete final round will be held tomorrow.  
 Women's 20km Race Walker Khushbir Kaur will also compete tomorrow. (PTI)

**Pankaj qualifies for Indian Open**

NEW DELHI, Aug 12: Eight-time World Champion Pankaj Advani today blanked Briton Matthew Selt 4-0 to qualify for the Indian Open, a premier championship.  
 Pankaj, India's highest-ranked professional snooker player at 73, was put under pressure in the very first frame as Selt opened with a 53 break at the Doncaster Dome in Sheffield, UK.  
 Responding well to the deficit, the Indian cleared the

table with a fine run of 62. From there on, there was no stopping Pankaj. With fluent breaks of 44, 54 and 65 in each subsequent frame, the Indian completed the whitewash in under two hours with flawless potting.  
 Pankaj is the first Indian to qualify for the Indian Open, slated for mid-October in New Delhi.  
 All eyes are now on the other Indian Aditya Mehta (ranked 74) to qualify. He is pitted against China's Xiao Guodong. (PTI)

**Traffic restrictions on the eve of Independence Day, 2013 on 15-8-2013 in Jammu city**

In view of forthcoming Independence Day, 2013, the following traffic restrictions are hereby imposed in Jammu city for the convenience of general public.

**A. Routes to be adopted by the Private Vehicles and Two Wheelers Carrying General Public for Witnessing the Independence Day Celebrations other than Invitees :**

- CPO Chowk- Amphalla-BC Road-Shakuntla-KC Crossing Indira Chowk-Shalamar-Ranbireswar Temple/JDA Parking.
- Bikram Chowk-Dogra Chowk-JP Chowk -Indira Chowk-Shalamar-Ranbireswar Temple-JDA Parking
- Canal Head-Jewel Chowk-Dogra Chowk-JP Chowk-Indira Chowk-Shalamar-Ranbireswar Temple/JDA Parking

**C. No Entry for Heavy Vehicles**

- All Passenger buses coming from Banihal/Doda Udhampur/Katra towards Jammu shall adopt Sidhra-Narwal route or Sidhra, Mandi, BC Road, No bus/truck should adopt Sidhra-Radio Station route.
- Similarly, passenger buses coming from Rajouri/Poonch/Akhnour shall terminate at Bakshi Nagar Pulli and will operate from there for return Journey till function is over.
- Passenger buses coming from Kathua, Samba and outside state shall adopt BC Road or Narwal Bye-Pass Sidhra Nagrota route.
- No heavy vehicles which include Trucks, Tippers, Tankers, Tractors, Load Carriers shall be allowed to enter City Jammu till the function is over. However they can adopt Sidhra Bye-Pass route for their onward journey towards Udhampur etc and vice versa for vehicles coming from Udhampur, Katra, Doda, Srinagar.
