

## 2600 perform 'darshan' at Budha Amarnath

## 6 hurt in road mishap

KATHUA, Aug 20: Six pedestrians were injured two of them seriously after a passenger bus hit them at Shetal Nagar 25 kilometres ahead of Basholi this morning.

According to police the bus bearing number JK02 B 0757 was on its way from Basholi to Bani early this morning. On reaching, Shetal Nagar driver stopped the bus and got down from it putting

the vehicle in neutral gear with the result the bus moved backwards injuring six pedestrians.

Four pedestrians who had received minor injuries were discharged after giving first aid while two seriously injured persons Mohammed Sharief and Showkat Ali were referred to GMC Jammu for treatment. Their condition is stated to be critical. The driver of the bus is absconding and the Basholi police has registered a case against him.

Lok Sabha Speaker Meira Kumar, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kamal Nath, Finance Minister P Chidambaram, External Affairs Minister Salman Khurshid,

Road Transport Minister Oscar Fernandes and Delhi Chief Minister Sheila Dikshit were among the other leaders who paid tributes to the departed leader.

Devotional music was played throughout the programme. Scores of National Students Union of India (NSUI), the student wing of Congress, members were also present on the occasion.

## Death of Govt employee does not entitle family for job: SC

NEW DELHI, Aug 20:

The Supreme Court has held that death of a Government employee in harness does not entitle the family to claim compassionate employment and the person seeking appointment must possess the eligibility for the post.

A bench of justices B S Chauhan and S A Bobde also said that the competent authority should examine the financial condition of family of the deceased and job should be offered to the eligible family member only if it is satisfied that they would not be able to cope up with the crisis.

"Mere death of a Government employee in harness does not entitle the family to claim compassionate employment.

"The competent authority has to examine the financial condition of the family of the deceased employee and it is only if it is satisfied that without providing employment, the family will not be able to meet the crisis, that a job is to be offered to the eligible member of the family. More so, the person claiming such appointment must possess required eligibility for the post," it said.(PTI)

## Nowshera people protest against PHE, PDD

NOWSHERA, Aug 20: A large number of people from several villages assembled at Gujral Chowk here and held protest demonstration against PHE and PDD authorities for failure of water and electricity supply.

The people from Manpur, Bajnoa, Breri and several adjoining hamlets reached Nowshera and sat on dharna on Nowshera-Janggar road. They disrupted movement of traffic for about one and half hour. The villagers alleged that water and power supply to

these villages has been affected for the last more than two weeks and the concerned officials are least bothered about the plight of the public. They shouted slogans against Omar Government, concerned ministers and the top officers.

Later, SDM and ASP Nowshera rushed there. They summoned the concerned PDD and PHE officials concerned on the spot. Later, on the assurance of restoration of water and power within two days, the villagers lifted dharna.

A large number of vehicles remained stranded on the road.

## Railways blames Bihar Govt for train accident

PATNA, Aug 20:

The Railways today blamed the Bihar Government for the train disaster at Dhamara Ghat in Khagaria district and said that actually 28 persons died in the accident, instead of 37 put by Chief Minister Nitish Kumar, and nine others were injured.

"Probably he (Nitish Kumar) mixed up the figures of death and injured to say that 37 persons died in the mishap at Dhamara Ghat in between Saharsa and Mansi section of Samastipur division yesterday," Minister of State for Railways Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury told reporters at Patna airport.

Chaudhury had visited the accident site past midnight last night and also met the injured in the hospital at Khagaria this morning before returning to Delhi via Patna.

Asked who is to blame for the Rajyarnai Express mowing down the pilgrims, the minister put the blame on the state administration.

"The local administration did not alert the Railways about the large congregation of pilgrims for the mela (fair) at the Katayani temple so that we could have taken some measures," Chaudhury said.

"There was no proper coordination with the Railways for making the necessary arrangement in view of the fair at the temple on the last Monday of Shrawan," he said.

The minister said that the state government gets so much of funds from the Centre under the Prime Minister Gramin Sadak Yojna (PMGSY) from which it could have constructed a road to this remote place, which is non-existent now.(PTI)
