

# Musharraf indicted in Bhutto murder case

ISLAMABAD, Aug 20: Former Pakistani military ruler Pervez Musharraf was today indicted by an anti-terrorism court in the 2007 assassination of ex-Prime Minister Benazir Bhutto.

Musharraf, who has been under house arrest for last four months, was charged with murder, conspiracy to commit murder and facilitation of murder, said state prosecutor Chaudhry Muhammad Azhar.

The 70-year-old former president was brought under heavy security to the anti-terrorism court of judge Habibur Rehman in Rawalpindi.

If convicted, Musharraf can be sentenced to death or life imprisonment.

Musharraf denied the allegation today in the court and his legal team will continue to defend him in the case in which he has been falsely implicated, the information secretary of his All Pakistan Muslim League, Aasia Ishaq, told PTI.

"He was not in the list of accused till 2008 but later his name was included on the basis of an email by Benazir to the US journalist Mark Segal," said Ishaq.

# High-flying pilots at increased risk of brain lesions

WASHINGTON, Aug 20: Pilots who fly at high altitudes may be at an increased risk of developing brain lesions, a new study claims.

Pilots who fly at altitudes above 18,000 feet are typically exposed to a type of illness called "decompression sickness" that results from quick changes in environmental pressure, researchers said.

For the study, 102 U-2 US Air Force pilots and 91 non-pilots between the ages of 26 and 50 underwent MRI brain scans.

The scans measured the amount of white matter hyperintensities, or tiny brain lesions associated with memory decline in other neurological diseases. The groups were matched for age, education and health factors.

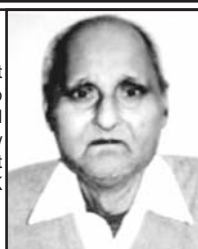

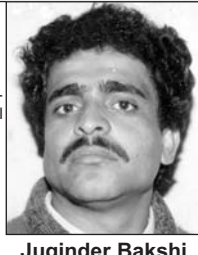

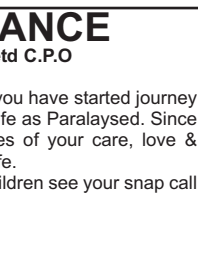

# Bill in LS to replace DGCA by new regulator

NEW DELHI, Aug 20: A bill to replace the DGCA by a new regulator for the Indian aviation sector, the **Civil Aviation Authority (CAA)**, was introduced in the Lok Sabha today.

The Civil Aviation Authority of India Bill 2013, which was introduced by Minister of State for Civil Aviation K C Venugopal, would provide the CAA full operational and financial autonomy to regulate all issues concerning civil aviation safety and protect the interests of consumers in a fast-changing aviation scenario.

It would be empowered to levy fees and charges under the Aircraft Act 1934 and undertake its own recruitment of professionals, which is currently carried by the UPSC for the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA).

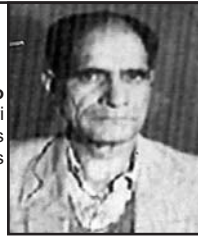
The bill was brought by the government after the UN-body International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) and the US regulator Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) carried out audits of the DGCA last year and pointed towards the "unsatisfactory situation" faced by it.

The ICAO and FAA had made observations relating to "severe deficiencies" in the DGCA set-up,

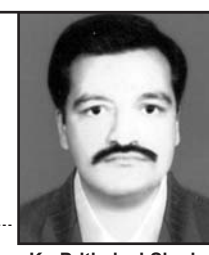
