Retail inflation for farm and rural workers eases marginally

NEW DELHI, Aug 21:

Retail inflation for farm and rural workers has come down marginally to 12.80 per cent and 12.61 per cent respectively in July, even as prices of food items and cloth remained high. Rate of inflation based on CPI-AL and CPI-RL decreased from 12.85 per cent and 12.65 per cent in June to 12.80 per cent and 12.61 per cent in July, a Labour Ministry statement said.

According to the data released by the Labour Bureau, the inflation based on food index of Consumer Price Index-Agriculture Labour (CPI-AL) and Consumer Price Index-Rural Labour (CPI-RL) stood at 13.84 per cent and 13.80 per cent, respectively, during July this year. (PTI)

Maruti launches Stingray with prices starting at Rs 4.1 lakh

NEW DELHI, Aug 21:

Looking to beat the slowdown blues, country's largest carmaker Maruti Suzuki India (MSI) today launched a compact car Stingray, priced between Rs 4.1 lakh and Rs 4.67 lakh (ex-showroom Delhi).

With the Stingray, which will be more expensive than the existing WagonR by about Rs 20,000, MSI is hoping to attract young customers and make the most out of the upcoming festive season. "The launch of Stingray is in line with our strategy to provide new and refurbished models to our customers to create excitement in the market place. Indian auto industry has been going through a slowdown, but despite this customers continue to buy Maruti cars," MSI Managing Director and CEO Kenichi Ayukawa told reporters here.

With this, the company will have nine models in its compact car portfolio, he said, adding that the WagonR would continue to be in the market.

"We have sold around 1.3 million units of the WagonR since its launch in December 1999. We are doing on an average of about 12,000 units a month," he added.

Stingray, which is powered by a 998 cc petrol engine, is available in three variants and the company will also roll out a CNG model soon.

The launch comes when the auto industry is gearing up to boost sales in the upcoming festive season. (PTI)

Vodafone launches M-Pesa

NEW DELHI, Aug 21:

Vodafone India along with ICICI bank today launched its mobile money transfer and payment service 'M-Pesa' in Delhi, expanding the footprint in the Capital.

The company plans to roll-out the service in Mumbai and Lucknow in the next couple of days, in a bid to tap the migrant population.

"We expect a small number of people to adapt this initially...If classical marketing theory is anything to go by usually about half to one per cent of people adopt a new product," Vodafone India Business Head (Delhi) Subrat Padhi said. (PTI)
