

## PM Office's denies share details of three classified files related to widows, daughter of Netaji

NEW DELHI, Aug 23:

Prime Minister Office's denial to share details of three classified files related to widows and daughter of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose today had its echo in Rajya Sabha with a member asking about the "exact nature of threat" from the disclosure.

Raising the issue during Zero Hour, Kunal Ghosh (Trinamool Congress) said the Prime Minister's Office has recently refused to share details of three files related to widows and daughter of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose to an applicant Chandrachur Ghose under the RTI Act of 2005.

He said the PMO refused the request to share file numbers -- 2/67/56-71 (volume I), 2/67/56-71 (volume II) and, 2/67/78 on the ground that this would prejudicially affect relation with foreign countries and also the sovereignty and integrity of India.

"Could the honourable Prime Minister and Home Minister kindly inform the House as to the exact nature of the threat to our sovereignty, national integrity and relationship with foreign countries that the government is apprehensive of on account of information on a national hero....," he asked.

Ghosh noted that the PMO had earlier submitted to the Central Information Commission that it holds 33 classified files including these three.

"Even earlier, in 2007, despite an order of the CIC, the Ministry of Home Affairs refused to disclose all documents pertaining to the Shah Nawaz Committee (1956), and

the G D Khosla Commission (1970-74), which investigated the mysterious disappearance of Netaji on the ground that it would lead to "serious law and order problem in the country, especially in West Bengal," the TMC member said.

Ghosh also rued that even six decades after Independence, India does not have a proper declassification policy for historical documents and hence the declassification exercise remains ad hoc and depends on whims of concerned ministries. "We have no information about last days of Netaji," he said.

Turning down an RTI appeal, the Prime Minister's Office had said that releasing secret files about Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's widow Emilie Schenk and daughter Anita Bose may upset relations with foreign countries.

Ghose who runs website www.Subhaschandrabose.Org had appealed under the RTI Act to provide access to letters written by Netaji's widow and daughter to the government.

When under house arrest by the Britishers, Netaji had escaped from India in 1941 to seek international support for India's freedom struggle. After organising the Indian National Army with Japanese help he went missing in 1945, giving birth to India's most debated and puzzling mystery.

The Mukherjee Commission had rejected the opinion that he died in a plane crash in Taiwan on August 18, 1945. (PTI)

## Govt seeks Par nod for additional expenditure of Rs 7,500 cr

NEW DELHI, Aug 23:

The Government today sought Parliament's nod for an additional expenditure of Rs 7,500 crore, which will include Rs 1,000 crore towards 'Nirbhaya Fund' for safety of women and a similar amount for setting up the all-women bank.

However, the net cash outgo on account of these spendings will only be Rs 127.14 crore as bulk of the additional expenses would be met by savings in other government schemes and will not impose any significant burden on the overall fiscal deficit target.

As per the first batch of supplementary demands for grants tabled in the Lok Sabha by Finance Minister P Chidambaram, Rs 1,830 crore has been sought for India's contribution towards the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Also, Rs 500 crore would be

provided to the Small Industrial Development Bank of India (SIDBI) to set up a Credit Guarantee Fund, while Rs 100 crore has been proposed to be given to India Microfinance Equity Fund of SIDBI to provide equity and quasi-equity to micro finance institutions.

The net cash outgo, however, will only be Rs 127.14 crore as "gross additional expenditure, matched by savings of the Ministries/Departments or by enhanced receipts/recoveries aggregates to Rs 7,372.55 crore," according to the statement of supplementary demands for grants.

The additional spendings include Rs 1,000 crore for setting up of 'Nirbhaya Fund' for safety of women and a similar amount will be provided to National Skill Development Corporation to extend skill trainings to youth.

Besides, Rs 1,000 crore has been provided for initial capital for establishment of women's bank.

Also, Rs 100 crore each has been provided as grants to Aligarh Muslim University and Banaras Hindu University while Rs 200 crore has been provisioned for Rajiv Gandhi Panchayat Sashaktikaran Abhiyan.

The Government comes out with several batches of supplementary demands for grants to meet expenditure above and over the budgeted expenditure during the course of the year. (PTI)

## New technique may help treat heart disease

WASHINGTON, Aug 23:

Scientists, including one of Indian-origin, have developed a new technique that can be used to convert cells from heart disease patients into heart muscle cells to act as a personalised treatment for their condition.

Researchers have previously reported the ability to convert scar-forming cells in the heart (called fibroblasts) into new, beating muscle in mice that had experienced heart attacks, thereby regenerating a heart from within.

They accomplished this by injecting a combination of three genes into the animals' fibroblast cells.

"This gene therapy approach resulted in new cardiac muscle cells that beat in synchrony with neighbouring muscle cells and ultimately improved the pumping function of the heart," said senior author Dr Deepak Srivastava of the Gladstone Institutes and its affiliate, the University of California, San Francisco.

In the new study, Srivastava

and his colleagues coaxed fibroblasts from human foetal heart cells, embryonic stem cells, and newborn skin grown in the lab to become heart muscle cells using a slightly different combination of genes, representing an important step toward the use of this technology for regenerative medicine.

The team envisions that introducing these genes into damaged hearts by gene therapy might convert fibroblasts into new muscle, thereby improving the function of the heart.

"Over 50 per cent of the cells in the human heart are fibroblasts, providing a vast pool of cells that could be harnessed to create new muscle," said Srivastava.

However, additional research is needed to improve the process of reprogramming adult human cells in this way.

The research was published in the journal of the International Society of Stem Cell Research, Stem Cell Reports, published by Cell Press. (PTI)

## Paternity row: Delhi HC closes Tiwari's right to lead evidence

NEW DELHI, Aug 23:

Veteran Congress leader N D Tiwari was today barred by the Delhi High Court from leading any evidence in the paternity suit filed by a youth seeking to declare him as his biological father.

Justice Vipin Sanghi considered a report of a local commissioner that the Congress leader has failed to file his evidence by way of an affidavit in the paternity case despite opportunities granted to him.

"The right of defendant no.1

(Tiwari) to lead evidence has been closed. Put up the case on September 18 for further proceedings," the court said.

S M Chopra, a former additional district judge, was appointed as a local commissioner by the high court for recording evidence on day-to-day basis in the case.

He has filed a report to the judge that 88-year-old Tiwari neither filed his evidence within the stipulated time nor appeared before him for cross-examination on August 21. (PTI)
