

### Police foils new modus operandi of bovine smuggling

UDHAMPUR, Aug 24: Continuing its drive, Udhampur Police foiled new modus operandi of bovine smuggling in passenger vehicles and rescued 12 animals, which were tightly packed in a Tavera.

Police have also arrested three bovine smugglers and seized the vehicle, which was on way to Kashmir.

According to SSP Udhampur Anil Magotra, based on a reliable information a Police party of Police Station Kud laid surprise naka on the National Highway last night and intercepted two passen-

ger vehicles Tavera bearing registration number JK05B-0892 and JK03D/0843.

During the thorough search of these passenger vehicles, six bovine animals were found brutally packed inside after removing their back seats.

Besides rescuing the animals, all the accused smugglers namely Murad Ali of Miran Sahib Jammu, Rafiq Ahmed of Uri and Rafiq Ahmed Hazam of Kokernag were arrested on the spot.

Both the vehicles were also seized and a case under Section 188/RPC 3 PCA Act was registered in this connection at Police Station Kud.

In another similar case, a police party from Police Station Udhampur led by SHO Udhampur Inspector Deepak Jasrotia laid a surprise naka at NHW near Jakhani in the early hours yesterday and intercepted one Mahindra Load carrier bearing registration number JK02AX-8655 which was on its way from Jammu towards Kashmir. During the thorough search of the vehicle, six bovine animals were found tightly packed inside the vehicle. Accused person namely Shabir Ahmed of Khanpur Nagora Jammu was arrested on the spot. Bovine animals were rescued and vehicle got seized.

### Prosecution failure leads to acquittal of 5 accused in murder case

JAMMU, Aug 24: Principal Sessions Judge Jammu, Kartar Singh has acquitted five persons allegedly involved in murder case because of material contradictions in the prosecution evidence and concealing of facts from the court.

According to the police case, on May 5, 2005 one Suram Singh lodged a written report against Dilbagh Singh, Kewal Singh, Kulwant Singh, Avtar Singh, Dhananter Singh, Suraj Singh, Ramesh Singh, Kamla Devi, Chinta Devi and others stating

therein that they had killed one Gopal Singh over a land dispute.

On this, police registered a case for the commission of offences falling under Sections 302/307/148/149/323/427 RPC and after completion of investigation presented challan in the court of law.

After hearing Special Public Prosecutor Senior Advocate Sunil Sethi for the State whereas Senior Advocate R S Thakur for the accused persons, Principal Sessions Judge observed, "the conclusion is inevitable that the prosecution evidence is replete with material contradictions, embellishments and improvements and the genesis of the occurrence has been intentionally and deliberately suppressed by the prosecution by concealing the material facts from the court".

"Had the investigating officers tried to investigate the case properly and find out the truth, it would have gone against the prosecution version and for the said

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### KPs opposed to dilution in Temples, Shrines Bill

JAMMU, Aug 24: Kashmiri Pandits today resolved that community is totally opposed to dilution in Shrines and Temples Bill and warned that the same will not be acceptable to the community and any move in this regard will be resisted by the community.

The KP leaders of various organizations who met here this evening reiterated their demand of bringing all the shrines and temples of the Valley under the ambit of the Shrine Board to be formed by the Government and no religious shrine or temple should be left out.

The meeting, which was organized by Pt. Prem Nath Bhat Memorial Trust a nodal organization of KPs for passage of the Bill passed a resolution in this regard which said that all the Hindu shrines and temples in Valley be brought under the ambit of the Bill.

The meeting further resolved that the community will fight all attempts to limit the reach and scope of the Bill

to protect, manage and maintain all shrines and temples.

The resolution, which was passed with the voice vote stressed on immediate passage of the Bill in the same form in which the community has put forth its demand. It said a comprehensive legislation for protection, preservation and maintenance of the huge temple and shrine heritage of Kashmir has been the lasting consensus demand of the exiled Hindus of Kashmir. This concurrence was shown on April 24, 2011 when the community unanimously selected the PNB Trust as the nodal organization to spearhead agitation for the Bill.

Addressing the meeting Dr K L Choudhary a well known writer and physician who presided over today's meet said that entire community has consensus on the issue and fully support the demand regarding formation of Shrine Board to protect the centuries old heritage centers in the form of Hindu shrines and temples in Kashmir for the posterity.
