

EC should have powers to derecognise parties for code violation: RS panel

NEW DELHI, Aug 26:

A Rajya Sabha panel on Electoral Reforms has today recommended that Election Commission (EC) should be given power to de-register political parties for violation of Model Code of Conduct under Representation of People Act (RPA), 1951.

The EC register's political parties under the RPA.

The parliamentary standing committee, under the Chairmanship of Shantaram Naik (Congress Rajya Sabha MP from Goa) recommended that 'the power to derecognise political parties on account of violation of Model Code of Conduct may be incorporated in the RPA itself.'

The committee also said that the ceiling limit on election expenditure should be increased 'substantially'.

"The committee feels that the actual expenditure by candidates on the election has been more than the ceiling fixed by the Election Commission and it is alleged that candidates have been concealing election expenditure to escape the obligation laid in the RPA."

"The Committee recommends that the election expenditure needs to be substantially enhanced and the Rule 90 of Conduct of Election Rules, 1961 may be periodically reviewed to increase or decrease election expenditure for candidates in Parliament or Assembly seats," it said.

The panel also proposed the simplification of nomination papers and valuation of candidate assets in the same to be done at the rate when it was inherited or acquired.

Lower women age to 60 to avail concession in national carriers

NEW DELHI, August 26:

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has written to the Civil Aviation ministry asking for lowering the eligibility age of women travellers for concession from 63 to 60 years in national carriers.

"Senior citizen women are already getting concessions in railway fare. I have requested the Ministry of Civil Aviation to reduce the eligibility age for women getting concession in national carriers from 63 to 60," said Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment Kumari Selja.

She was speaking at a conference "Ageing Women Critical Challenges and Concerns" here.

Currently, the age to avail 50 per cent concession in the basic fare in normal economy class fare is 63 years. (PTI)

The recommendations also included fast-track courts to deal with election petitions. The panel also wanted candidates to get a chance to immediately appeal a decision after his or her nomination papers have been rejected by a returning officer. Currently, candidates can appeal the decision only after the election results are announced. Candidate can then approach a high court through an election petition.(UNI)

One in four Indians skip breakfast: Study

MUMBAI, Aug 26:

Even as Food Security Bill for ensuring foodgrain supply to poor in the country gets debated in Parliament, a study by cereal maker Kellogg's India has found that one out of four Indians in metro cities, skip breakfast, which could lead to chronic diseases.

With reasons ranging from paucity of time to fears of weight gain, the study conducted by College of Home Science, Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai, found 27 per cent respondents saying they skipped breakfast. Only three per cent respondents said they considered breakfast

as essential part of the day, it added.

The study conducted over years, starting 2009, covered 3,619 respondents from Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Chennai.

"Even among those who are having breakfast, we found glaring deficits in nutrients as per the Recommended Dietary Allowance (RDA). About 72 per cent of the subjects are having nutritionally inadequate breakfast, especially in terms of iron and fibre intake," Malathi Sivaramkrishnan, Research Director at the institute told reporters here.(PTI)
