Samsung plans Rs 500 cr investment to ramp up mobile production

NEW DELHI, June 30:

South Korean electronics major Samsung is planning to invest over Rs 500 crore to ramp up its mobile production capacity in India, industry sources said.

"Samsung is working to invest Rs 500 crore in its mobile production facility in India. It had approached government in this regard to take benefit of policy announcements and other incentives. The investment proposals have been cleared at Department of Electronics and IT (DEITY) level," a source told.

When contacted, Samsung India spokesperson said: "We are looking at strengthening our manufacturing presence in the country, to fulfil our growing needs in the market. However we are not able to provide further details at this stage."

Noida facility manufactures about 3.5 to 4 crore phones annually, including 12 smartphones models such as Galaxy S3. (PTI)

Over 3 dozens biz entities to seek bank licences

NEW DELHI, June 30:

About three dozens entities, including Aditya Birla Group, Tata Capital, Religare, Reliance Capital, are applying for bank licences, the deadline for which expires tomorrow.

Entities which have taken board approval for applying to for bank licence from the Reserve Bank include country's oldest financial institution IFCL, IDFC, India Infoline, Videocon Industries, SREI Infrastructure Finance etc and the Department of Posts. (PTI)

Mercedes Benz to come up with traffic alert system

HYDERABAD, June 30:

Mercedes Benz is all set to introduce a technology that would enable communication between two cars and also between driver and manufacturer, a top official of the German Luxury car maker said.

"You get more and more connectivity between cars as well as between manufacturer and driver. We are developing an integrated system called 'My Mercedes'. This system gives all participants using an automobile a possibility to communicate (with one another).

"There will be more and more communications coming up," Eberhard H Kern, Managing Director and CEO, Mercedes Benz India told during his recent visit here.

Kern added that their Research and Development centre in Bangalore would play a key role in developing the technology. According to a press release issued earlier this month by the company, each vehicle will be fitted with Car-to-X communication and it can transmit information on dangers to other road users and therefore contribute to enhancing the road safety.

Mercedes Benz passenger cars are able to detect many of these dangers automatically and without the driver being required to take any action. For dangers which are not detected automatically, an efficient manual notification option has been created. (PTI)
