JBT scam: Chautala moves HC seeking extension of interim bail

NEW DELHI, July 1: The Delhi High Court today sought CBI's response on former Haryana Chief Minister Om Prakash Chautala's plea seeking extension of his interim bail on medical grounds. Justice Siddharth Mridul issued notice to CBI and sought its response by July 4 on Chautala's application for extension of his interim bail, saying his pacemaker implantation was done on June 3 and the doctor had advised him to come for regular checkups for three months.

He was granted interim bail on May 21 and it expires on July 4. In his application, Chautala said, "He continues to be in a fragile state of health, besides being severely handicapped by various disabilities. He required constant extra care during the period of three months and constant follow up. He requires a clean and stress free environment." Chautala, chief of Indian National Lok Dal (INLD), along with 54 others, was awarded jail term in the 2000 teachers' recruitment scam and was later granted interim bail for six weeks by the high court to undergo the pacemaker implant. The 78-year-old leader also sought court's permission to visit his native village Chautala in Haryana. "It is prayed that the interim bail granted to appellant (Chautala) be suitably extended and he may be permitted to reside with his family at his native village Chautala in Sirsa district of Haryana after discharge from the hospital," he said in the plea. 2G: SC dismisses Essar, Loop plea on special court jurisdiction

NEW DELHI, July 1: The Supreme Court today dismissed the pleas of Essar Teleholdings Ltd and Loop Telecom challenging the special CBI court's jurisdiction to hold trial against them and their officials in the 2G spectrum case. Over a year after the judgement was reserved, a bench of justices G S Singhvi and S J Mukhopadhyaya rejected the pleas of the telecom companies which pleaded that they be tried in a magisterial court unlike other accused in 2G cases as they have not been charged under Prevention of Corruption (PC) Act. The bench, which had reserved its judgement in May 2012, said there was no merit in the plea and dismissed the same. The companies and their officials are facing trial before the special CBI court constituted specially to hold trial in 2G scam case as the apex court had earlier refused to stay the proceedings against them. The two telecom firms had said they have been named in the charge sheet under section 420 (cheating) and 120B (criminal conspiracy) of the IPC and the charges were triable by a magistrate and not by the special court constituted for hearing the 2G

case. Other accused named in the third charge sheet in 2G case are Essar Group promoters Anshuman and Ravi Ruia along with Loop Telecom promoters Kiran Khaitan, her husband I P Khaitan and Essar Group Director (Strategy and Planning) Vikash Saraf.(PTI)

Five bovine animals rescued

SAMBHA, July 1: Police today rescued five bovine animals and also seized the vehicle bearing number JK 19-1508 which was carrying them to Kashmir Valley. A spokesman of the police said that a team of Vijaypur Police during a routine Naka Rak Barootian intercepted vehicle and on the checking it found that five bovine animals were being carried in it. However, the driver of the vehicle and his accomplice managed to escape. The Vijaypur Police has registered a case in this regard.

Police produces challan in Sanaullah's killing

JAMMU, July 1: Police today produced challan against a dismissed Army jawan in connection with the killing of Pakistani Sanaullah, who was done to death inside Kot Bhalwal Central Jail on May 3 in retaliation to the killing of Sarabjit Singh, an Indian prisoner. Sarabjit was killed a day before the killing of Sanaullah in Kot Lakhpat Rai jail at Lahore. Sanaullah son of Ashiq Hussain R/o Daluwalli, Sialkot in Pakistan was facing life imprisonment in the jail for his involvement in militant activities. He was attacked by a dismissed Army jawan Vinod Kumar son of Mahitab Singh R/o Siku, Pouri Garhwal, Uttarakhand, who was also facing life imprisonment in the same jail. Sanaullah had succumbed to his injuries at PGI Chandigarh few days after being injured. Police had registered murder case against Vinod Kumar at Gharota police station. Investigations in the case were conducted by Rajesh Kumar Sharma, SP Rural, Abdul Rouf Lone, DySP Headquarters, Rayees Mohammad Bhat, SDPO Akhnoor and Inspector Jatinder Samyal, SHO Gharota.

Ishrat case: Kumar not be named in first charge sheet

NEW DELHI, July 1: Special Director of Intelligence Bureau Rajendra Kumar will not be named in the first charge sheet to be filed by CBI on July four as the agency will be seeking more time from court to probe the conspiracy angle in the fake encounter case of Ishrat Jahan and others. "We have promised the Gujarat High Court that we will file a charge sheet on July 4 in this case and we will maintain our time limit. We will file a preliminary charge sheet," CBI Director Ranjit Sinha told reporters on the sidelines of an Interpol conference here. The case pertains to killing of four people including 19-year-old Ishrat from Mumbai and the allegation is that the four were in detention of Gujarat Police before they were killed in a stage-managed encounter in 2004. CBI was entrusted with the investigations of the case by the Gujarat High Court and the agency managed to get one of the accused as an approver in the case, who named Kumar, a 1979 batch IPS officer posted as Joint Director of Intelligence Bureau in Ahmedabad at that time. The sources in the agency will seek more time from the court under 173 Criminal Procedure Code to probe conspiracy angle in the case. The sources declined that CBI required any sanction to prosecute Kumar and said his role was being further probed in the case and that he may be called for questioning again. The senior Intelligence Bureau officer will retire on July 31 this year. Sinha said, "We have asked Home Ministry and Maharashtra government to provide security to our officers probing the case." His remarks come in the backdrop of reports that the agency's Nagpur-based Superintendent of Police, Sandeep Madhukar Tamgadge, an IPS officer of 2001 batch from Nagaland cadre, has been receiving threats. Kumar, who has been handling sensitive departments within the Intelligence Bureau, was later called to Ahmedabad for questioning where he had claimed that he did not remember finer details pertaining to the case. CBI was also looking for the then Joint Commissioner of Police (Ahmedabad) P.P.Pandey, who has been absconding ever since the agency called him for questioning.(PTI)

NEW DELHI, July 1: Union Minister for Health, Ghulam Nabi Azad today called for all countries to harmonise their national standards with those of the Codex to implement food safety systems and good agricultural and manufacturing practices, as Codex had developed several standards and guidelines for various kinds of food products. The Codex Alimentarius (Latin for "Book of Food") is a Commission has grown from 30 countries to 150 countries over the last 50 years. He said the benefits of Codex Trust Fund were available to eligible countries since 2003, and this helpful initiative had supported countries in their participation in Codex meetings so that Codex is able to create truly international standards. The Codex Commission is programme of the 36th Session shouldering the responsibility of Codex Alimentarius laying down the global parameters of quality and safety of food products for human consumption. Sessions in Rome, Mr Azad said This ensures the health of the shrinking of the world due to consumers and fair practices in faster means of travel and communication has led to globalisation products.
