## 2 killed, 182 injured in Asiana plane crash in San Francisco

SAN FRANCISCO/WASHINGTON, July 7:

Two Chinese students were killed and 182 others injured when an Asiana Airlines plane with three Indians among 307 on board hit the runway, smashed into pieces and engulfed by flames while landing at San Francisco airport.

Over 300 people on flight OZ214, however, miraculously escaped from the burned-out wreckage of the South Korean airlines' long-range Boeing 777-200, using evacuation slides.

Asiana, second in size to national carrier Korean Air, has confirmed two female Chinese teenagers have died.

Yoon Young-doo, the president of Asiana Airlines, said the two passengers were in their teens and were believed to have been seated toward the back of the plane.

China's state-run Xinhua news agency, quoting a preliminary report said two students from east China's Zhejiang Province died in the plane crash.

Based on information obtained from their boarding passes, two female middle school students from Jiangshan City, Zhejiang Province, died in the accident, a reply from Asiana Airlines' head office in China to the Jiangshan municipal Government said.

But the identities of the dead have not been confirmed by DNA tests yet, the report said.

San Francisco fire chief Joanne Hayes-White said 182 people were injured and 123 were unhurt.

As per reports, 15-years-old Neha Kumari, daughter of Bachan Lal of Trikuta Nagar, 16-year-old Babli Jamwal, daughter of Kulbir Singh of Aghore and 43-year-old Rama Devi, wife of Gara Ram of Shakti Nagar, received burn injuries at their respective homes.

The trio were shifted to Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), where their condition was stated to be stable, when last reports poured in.

Police has taken the cognizance.

## Chinese firms in PoK projects

BEIJING, July 7: Chinese firms engaged in big infrastructure projects in Pakistan today expressed their willingness to take up more ventures in the country, including PoK.

State-owned Gezhoubu company, which is constructing Neelum-Jhelum Hydropower Project in Pakistan occupied Kashmir (PoK), told Pakistan Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif that it would like to take part in the construction of Diامر Bhasha Dam, designed to generate 4,500 MW of power in Gilgit-Baltistan in PoK.

The company also said it would strive to seek financial support from the Chinese monetary institutions, Pakistan's official news agency APP reported.

Sharif, who arrived in China on July 3 on a six-day visit, has said that with support of China, Pakistan will overcome its energy challenges which would also lead to complete strengthening of its economy.

He said he was happy that a large number of Chinese enterprises have expressed their keen interest in energy and infrastructure development.

During a meeting with Sharif, Executive President of Gezhoubu company, Yang Yisheng, expressed willingness to execute power, infrastructure and high speed train projects in Pakistan.

The company is constructing the Neelum-Jhelum project which was expected to be ready by 2016.

Sharif invited Gezhoubu company's head to visit Pakistan along with the project proposals of their interest for the onward discussion on those projects.

Besides Beijing where he held talks with top Chinese leaders, Sharif visited Shanghai and Guangzhou scouting for more investment.

During Sharif's visit, Pakistan and China have signed eight agreements, including a whopping USD 18 billion deal to build a 200 km-long strategic tunnel through the rugged PoK, as the two all-weather allies sought to boost economic ties and supply critical oil to the energy-hungry Communist giant.
