- e) Bidders are advised not to make any change in BOQ (Bill of Quantity) contents or its name. In no case they should attempt to create similar BOQ manually. The BOQ downloads from the site should be used for filling the rates and it should be saved with same name.
3. Bid must be accompanied by bid security (EMD) as specified above payable at Jammu pledged to Chief Accounts officer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu. Bid security (EMD) will have to be in the form of CDR/ FDR of any Nationalized Bank. The cost of the Tender fee in the form of Demand Draft (DD) in the name of Chief Accounts Officer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu should be in a separate envelope with cover marking cost of tender fee addressed to Chief Engineer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu.
- a) The original documents in respect of cost of documents, EMD and relevant technical bid documents etc., must be delivered to the Chief Engineer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu on or before 22-07-2013 upto 1400 Hrs, if the office happens to be closed on the date of receipt as specified, the same will be received on the next working day upto 1200 Hrs at the same venue.
- b) Technical bids shall be opened on 23-07-2013 at 1200 Hrs in the office of the Chief Engineer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu and the date of opening of financial bid shall be communicated to the successful bidders. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of price bids or is not convenient to the opening authority, due to some urgent engagements, the next date for opening of price bid shall be communicated to the bidders through website & email.
4. The bid for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of price bid.
5. All other terms and conditions can be seen in the Tender Documents.
6. Instructions to the bidders regarding e-tendering process :-
a) To participate in on line bidding process, bidders have to get (DSC) "Digital Signature Certificate" as per information Technology Act-2000. This certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. Bidders can get above mentioned DSC from any approved vendors. The bidders who have already possess valid DSC need not to procure new DSC.
b) The bidders have to submit their bids on line in electronic format with Digital signature. The bids cannot be uploaded without digital signature. No proposals will be accepted in physical form.
c) Bids will be opened on line as per time and schedule mentioned in 2(d) & 3(b) above.
d) Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all necessary documents have been attached with the bid and serially numbered.
e) The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
f) All the required information for bids must be filled and submitted online.
g) Bidders should get ready with scanned copies of DD as cost of Document and EMD as specified in the NIT/Tender Documents. The original Documents in respect of cost of documents, EMD and relevant documents be submitted to the office of the Chief Engineer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu by registered post/speed post as per time and schedule as specified. The department shall not be responsible for non-receipt of the documents as per time and schedule specified above.
h) Bidders are required to quote net rate inclusive of all taxes/carriages in BOQ (xls) format.
i) The tenders/bidders who have the following qualification certificates are eligible for the work :-
1. The gross average annual turnover of the intending tenderer should not be less than Rs 5.00 crore during the last three years duly certified by the Chartered Accountant who is an empanelment of CANAL.
a) The Contractor should have executed one similar nature of work like such as canals/X-drainage works/ Aqueducts/Bridges, Intake Structure, Pump Room and similar nature of works costing not less than 80% of the advertised amount.
b) Two No. similar works as stated above costing not less than 50% of the each value of the works.
c) Three No similar works as stated above costing not less than 40% of the each value of the works.
2. The tenderer should have sufficient manpower (both technical and skilled) with sufficient construction/Mechanical equipments.
3. The Contractors past experience in similar nature of work should be supported by the certificates issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent from a Government or Semi-Government of State or Central Department. No experience issued/signed by any executing agency of private firm/company shall be accepted/entertained.
4. Sales tax clearance certificate from Commercial Taxation Department/Tin registration from Sales Tax Department for the year 2012-13.
5. The tenderer shall have to produce Bank Guarantee limit of 2% equal to Advertised amount of work with the Technical Bid.
The firm shall be responsible for soil investigation, designing of structure and its vetting by the Design Directorate, J&K, Jammu, before starting the execution. The charges on this account if any has to be paid by the firm/contractor itself.
The tender of only those firms/contractors shall be considered who have deposited the requisite demand draft as well as EMD as mentioned above. No Joint venture firms/Contractors can participate in the bidding process. The Chief Engineer Irrigation & F.C. Department Jammu reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders in part or in full without assigning any reasons therefor.
The firms/Contractors is advised to visit the site and acquaint himself of the proposed upcoming structure before quoting the cost.
The contractor should quote his rates keeping in mind all the expected escalations. No price escalation in respect of material, machinery, equipment, labour, POL etc., shall be entertained to the successful tenderer during the period of execution of works.
In case the work is not started with in time fixed for completion of the work, will automatically be treated as cancelled and no correspondence shall be made for the same and CDR will be forfeited without any information. Food Min in favour of 7.5 pc import duty on pulses

NEW DELHI, July 8: The Food Ministry is in favour of a 7.5 per cent import duty on pulses as against 10 per cent suggested by the Commission for Agriculture Costs and Prices (CACP) to boost domestic production.

India, the largest producer of pulses, imports about three million tonne of lentils every year to fulfil its domestic demand. Pulses imports are being permitted at zero duty since 2006 to ensure availability here.

According to industry data, traders are importing tur at Rs 3,300-3,500 per quintal from Myanmar currently, while domestic prices are ruling at Rs 4,300 per quintal.

The official further observed that the other reason for proposed restriction in shipments is that cheap imports are encouraging some traders to push the same for sale at an MSP rate to government body NAFED's support price programme.

CACP, which recommends support price for agriculture commodities, had recommended 10 per cent import duty on pulses in its report on kharif 2013-14 crops to boost local output. (PTI)

Govt to select among 10 merchant bankers for NHPC stake sale

NEW DELHI, July 8: The Government will tomorrow finalise merchant bankers for managing the disinvestment of hydel power producer NHPC, which is expected to fetch over Rs 2,200 crore to the exchequer.

As many as 10 merchant bankers, including Credit Suisse, ICICI Securities, SBI Cap and HSBC have evinced interest in managing the stake sale.

The bankers are scheduled to make their presentation before the disinvestment department tomorrow.

The government plans to sell 11.36 per cent of its stake, or its 120 crore shares of NHPC through Offer For Sale (OFS) in the domestic market.

At the current market price of Rs 18.65 apiece, the stake sale could fetch around Rs 2,238 crore to the exchequer.

Government currently holds 86.36 per cent stake in NHPC. The hydro-power company got listed on bourses in 2009 after the promoter divested 5 per cent stake while company issued 10 per cent fresh equity.

The paid-up equity capital of the company, as on March 31, 2012 was Rs 12,300.74 crore.(PTI)

Coal stocks at thermal power plants improve in June: CEA

NEW DELHI, July 8: Coal stocks at thermal power stations in the country have shown an increase, mainly due to improved supplies of the fuel and lower demand for electricity.

Only five plants had less than four days of coal stocks at their disposal as of June 27, according to Central Electricity Authority (CEA) data. Comparatively, as many as 13 power stations had on average less than four days of fuel inventory in May.

"The overall fuel supplies have increased, a prime reason for improved coal storage at plants. Also, another reason is that the PLF or plant load factor of stations is declining due to less demand from the states," a Power Ministry official told. PLF is a measure of a plant's efficiency.

Three of the plants with less than four days of coal being to NTPC, the country's largest power producer -- the 2,980 MW Sipat project in Chhattisgarh, and the 2,600 MW Ramagundem and 2,000 MW Simhadri units in Andhra Pradesh. The three plants also had supercritical stocks in May. (PTI)
