

Protests over shortage of drinking water in Kishtwar

Agitating people ransack XEn office, several injured in police lathicharge

 JAMMU, July 15: Protests broke out in Kishtwar town this morning against acute shortage of drinking water in several areas with enraged people ransacking the office of the Executive Engineer of the Public Health Engineering Department. In order to control the mob, police resorted to lathicharge in which several protesters sustained injuries. Reports said that large number of people from different areas gathered in the main town and held protest demonstration against the PHE Department for its failure to provide drinking water for days together. They also staged dharna at two different places and blocked the vehicular traffic. As none from the civil administration visited them to listen to their grievances for four hours, the agitating people marched towards the office of PHE Executive Engineer, who instead of giving patient hearing to the protesters and redress their grievances, reportedly told them that by staging protest they (protesters) would not achieve anything. Enraged over the remarks of the Executive Engineer, people brought out some furniture from his office and put the same to flames amidst slogans against him as well as district administration. In order to control the mob, police resorted to lathicharge in which several protesters sustained minor injuries. In the meantime, another group of the agitating people reached the office of Deputy Commissioner and staged massive demonstration there. A representative of the Deputy Commissioner told the protesting people that the Deputy Commissioner would talk to Executive Engineer in order to redress the grievances of the people. Following this, the protest demonstration came to end. When contacted, Deputy Commissioner admitted acute shortage of drinking water. He, however, termed as uncalled for the ransacking of furniture of Executive Engineer by the mob. "This is not the way to agitate for the problem", he said adding "there are peaceful means to protest". He further said that steps would be taken to redress the problems of the people. "I have called the necessary information from the Executive Engineer in this regard", the Deputy Commissioner added.

Police solves teenager kidnapping case in a day

KATHUA, July 15: Police has claimed to have solved a teenager kidnapping case by recovering the girl and arrest of accused kidnaper from forest belt of Ramkote in Billawar tehsil of Kathua district within a day. As per reports, on Saturday evening Makhlan Lal resident of Arnot village informed the police about kidnapping of his 15 year old daughter. After registering the case under section 363 at Police Post Ramkot, police party swung into action and raided various places to recover the girl. "A team led by Incharge PP Ramkote, Chandler Bushan Sharma, under overall supervision of SSP Kathua, Mohal Lal, SDPO Basoli, Rafiq Manhas and SHO Billawar, Ashwani Sharma launched a massive search operation and recovered the girl within 24 hours from forest area," said police, adding that the team also arrested the accused kidnaper namely Mohammad Sultan (21) resident of same village. Police further said that accused was today produced before the Magistrate and remanded to eight days of police custody till July 22.

3 killed in WB Panchayat polls

KOLKATA, July 15: At least 12 people were injured in violence in sporadic violence in several parts of the Burdwan and East Midnapore districts. CPI(M) candidate, Siddhartha Banerjee, for the Panuria Gram Panchayat in Burdwan was beaten up allegedly by ruling Trinamool Congress supporters, while a CPI(M) woman candidate, Suptava Karpah, was arrested at Rayan in the same district on the charge of influencing voters, the police said. Polling was peaceful in Hoogly district, in which Singur falls, barring an incident when a local Trinamool Congress leader Bocha was seen allegedly interfering inside a booth when voting was on. SEC sources said it was contemplating repolling in some booths of Burdwan and Hoogly districts but did not elaborate. The sources said an average 75 per cent polling was recorded till 5 pm in the three districts. The percentage will increase as queues of voters were still waiting outside the booths to exercise their franchise. (PTI)
