MEMORANDUM

The Chief Electoral, Officer, J&K proposes to hold an inquiry against Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, Senior Assistant, under Rule 33 of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The substance of the imputations of unauthorised absence in respect of which the inquiry is proposed to be held is set out in the enclosed statement of article of charge Annexure-I. A statement of the imputations of unauthorised absence in support of the article of charge is enclosed as Annexure-II.

2. Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, Senior Assistant, is directed to submit within 21 days of the receipt of this memorandum a written statement of his defense and also to state whether he desires to be heard in person.

3. He is informed that an inquiry will be held only if the article of charge is not admitted. He should, therefore, specifically admit or deny the articles of charge.

4. Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, Senior Assistant, is further informed that if he does not submit his written statement of defense on or the date specified in para 2 above, or does not appear in person before the inquiring authority or otherwise fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of Rule 33 of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (CC & A) Rules, 1956 or the orders/directions issued in pursuance of the said rule, the inquiring authority may hold the inquiry against him ex-parte.

5. Attention of Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, Senior Assistant, is invited to Rule 17 of Jammu and Kashmir Government Employees (Conduct) Rules, 1971, under which no Government servant shall bring or attempt to bring any political or outside influence to bear upon any superior authority to further his interest in respect of matters pertaining to his service under the Government. If any representation is received on his behalf from another person in respect of any matter dealt with in these proceedings it will be pursued that Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, Senior Assistant, is aware of such a representation and that if it has been made at his instance and action will be taken against him for violation of Rule 17 of Jammu and Kashmir Government Employees (Conduct) Rules, 1971.

Annexure-I
Article of charge framed against Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma Senior Assistant

That you have left the office on 5th November, 2012 at 4:00 PM without prior permission and placed leave application for 04 days w.e.f 06-11-2012 to 09-11-2012 in the attendance register without sanction from Head of the Office.

That as per your leave application you had to resume your duty on 12th November, 2012 (Monday), but you have not reported for duty.

That an explanation was called from you vide No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2012/783-84 dated 27-11-2012 regarding your absence from duty.

That no reply has been furnished by you till date and instead of furnishing reply you have submitted joining report on 17-12-2012 and after 27-12-2012 you again left the office and remained absent from duty and submitted an application for earned leave from 06-11-2012 to 14-12-2012 which was also not sanctioned in your favour due to non receipt of your reply to the explanation already issued vide this office letter No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2012/783-84 dated 27-11-2012 and also due to non resumption of duty by you.

That on 28th December, 2012 this office received another application from your father requesting for grant of five days leave on the plea that you are suffering from a disease.

That even after completion of five days you were duty bound to attend the office on 4th January, 2013 but till today you have not resumed your duty and you whereabouts are also not known to this office.

That vide this office notice No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2013/1028-31 dated 14-02-2013 published in "Daily Excelsior" Newspaper dated 18-02-2013 you were directed to resume your duty within 07 days from issuance of above mentioned notice, but instead of reporting for duty, your brother has again submitted an application for leave for extension on medical grounds without medical certificate therefore, your leave application was not accepted.

That vide this office communication No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2013/1118 dated 12-03-2013 you were directed to produce a medical certificate from Board of Doctors within a week from issuance of said communication to enable this office to sanction your earned leave on medical grounds.

That despite repeated communications and directions from this office regarding resumption of duty by you, you have shown no interest to join duty and this act on your part amounts to unauthorised absence in light of Article 128 of the J&K Civil Service Regulations.

Statement of imputations against Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma Senior Assistant

Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, Senior Assistant had left the Office on 5th November, 2012 at 4:00 PM without prior permission and submitted leave application for 04 days w.e.f 06-11-2012 to 09-11-2012 in the attendance register without sanction from Head of the Office. As per the leave application Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma had to resume duty on 12th November, 2012 (Monday), but he did not report for duty.

An explanation was called from Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma vide No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2012/783-84 dated 27-11-2012 regarding absence from duty.

Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma has not furnished a reply till date and instead of furnishing reply he submitted joining report on 17-12-2012 and attended the office from 17-12-2012 to 27-12-2012 and after 27-12-2012 Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma again left the office and remained absent from duty and submitted an application for earned leave from 06-11-2012 to 14-12-2012 which was also not sanctioned in his favour due to non receipt of reply to the explanation already issued vide this office letter No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2012/783-84 dated 27-11-2012 and also due to non resumption of duty by Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma.

On 28th December, 2012 this office received another application from father of Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma requesting for grant of five days leave on the plea that he is suffering from a disease.

Even though the leave was not sanctioned, Shri Pawan Kumar was duty bound to attend the office on 4th January, 2013 after completion of five days but till today he has not resumed his duty and his whereabouts is also not known to this office.

Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma vide this office notice No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2013/1028-31 dated 14-02-2013 published in "Daily Excelsior" News Paper dated 18-02-2013 was directed to resume his duty within 07 days from issuance of above mentioned notice, but instead of reporting for duty, his brother has again submitted an application for leave for extension on medical grounds without medical certificate therefore, his leave application was not accepted.

Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma vide this office communication No. 4270/Estt/PFC/2013/1118 dated 12-03-2013 was directed to produce a medical certificate from Board of Doctors within a week from issuance of said communication to enable this office to process his application for earned leave on medical grounds.

However despite repeated communications and directions from this office regarding resumption of duty, Shri Pawan Kumar Sharma, has shown no interest to join his duty and this act on his part is a violation of the J&K Civil Service Regulations.

Subject: Tentative seniority list of ETO/CTOS. Circular

Whereas vide Government Order No. 05-F of 2006 dated: 03.01.2006, the Final Seniority List of 81 members of the Jammu & Kashmir, Excise & Taxation (Gazetted) Service as it stood on 01.08.2005 was notified;

Whereas the Seniority of the Officers mentioned at Serial No. 70 to 79 was subject to their successful completion of probation;

Whereas, the said Seniority List was challenged in the Hon'ble High Court by some members of the service figuring at Serial No. 70-79 with regard to assigning them the position ahead of the members from Serial No. 55 to 69;

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court in SWP No.2356/2009, titled Rakesh Kumar and others Vs. State and others vide judgment dated 07th of May, 2013 disposed of the writ petition. The operative part of the said judgment is as under:-

"The outer time limit for throwing challenge to the final seniority list as laid down in the case law notified above is four year from the date of issuance/publication of the final seniority list. Though four years is not a legislatively fixed period for questioning final seniority list, yet the case law on the subject is suggestive of adherence to such time limit in other words, challenge to final list after a period of four year should not ordinarily be entertained unless there are cogent and convincing reasons to justify the delay, in questioning such list in the present case, petition in view of the facts and circumstances discussed cannot be said to be hit by delay and laches. For the reasons discussed, there is merit in the writ petition. The petition is, accordingly allowed. The order No.232-F of 2004 dated 6th December 2004 is quashed to the extent it give retrospective effect to the promotion of private respondents with effect from the date(s), the Excise and Taxation vacancies in promotional quota were available. The final seniority list bearing No.05-F of 2006 dated 3rd January, 2006, is also quashed to the extent, it places the respondents (6-15) ahead of petition in the final seniority list. The official respondents are directed to reframe the final seniority list taking date of appointment by promotion of private respondents affective from the date of order, where by they were so appointed was acted upon and not the date when the posts become available or were left vacant. The official respondents shall proceed further on the basis of final seniority list so drawn.

Whereas, the judgement dated 07.05.2013 has been challenged in LPA (SW) No.91/2013 and the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 10.05.2013 directed as under:-

"Meanwhile, subject to objections and till next date before the Bench, the process of re-drawing of Seniority List may continue, but shall not be acted upon."

Whereas in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court dated 07.05.2013 read with directives dated 10.05.2013, the Seniority List of the members of the service figuring at Serial No. 55 to 79 is required to be reframed;

Dry, therefore the tentative Seniority List of the members of the Jammu & Kashmir, Excise & Taxation (Gazetted) Service as it stood on 01.08.2005 in respect of member of the services figuring from Serial No. 55 to 79, is hereby notified as Annexure 'A' to this Circular.

Objections if any in this regard should reach the Finance Department within 15 days from the date of issuance of this circular failing which, it will be presumed that the members of the services have no objections with respect to the assigned positions and the seniority shall be finalized accordingly.
