

India needs vibrant ecosystem to attract investments: Pilot

NEW DELHI, July 18: Emphasising the need for a better business environment, Union Minister Sachin Pilot today said the country needs a vibrant ecosystem that enables both foreign and domestic investments.

against the backdrop of sluggish economic growth and companies scrapping proposed multi-billion dollar projects. "The need for India today is to create an ecosystem that is vibrant and enables investment not just foreign but also domestic investments," Pilot, who is

in charge of Corporate Affairs Ministry, said at a conference organised by industry body Assocham. In the last two days, two global steel majors — ArcelorMittal and Posco — have said that they have scrapped their multi-billion

dollars worth projects. Yesterday, world's largest steel maker ArcelorMittal scrapped its USD 12 billion (Rs 50,000 crore) steel plant in Odisha over inordinate delays, problems in acquiring land and securing iron ore linkages. On Tuesday, South Korean steel major Posco pulled out of its Rs 30,000-crore steel mill in Karnataka. The developments amid the Government making efforts to lure more foreign investments to bolster economic growth.(PTI)
