

## Federer struggles to win Hamburg opener

HAMBURG, July 18: Roger Federer struggled in his first match since his Wimbledon humiliation when he had to come back from a set down to defeat Germany's Daniel Brands in his Hamburg opener on Wednesday.

The 31-year-old, top-seeded Federer won 3-6, 6-3, 6-2 against the World No. 58, who was celebrating his 26th birthday, to reach the third round of a tournament he last played in 2008.

It was his 30th career win at the tournament.

"I think it was good for me to have a tough match like this and come through at the end," said Federer.

## Gavaskar buys stake in IBL's Mumbai franchise

NEW DELHI, July 18: The Indian Badminton League's glamour quotient has gone up by quite a few notches with a consortium involving former cricket captain Sunil Gavaskar and Telugu actor Nagarjuna buying the event's Mumbai franchise.

The consortium also includes former manager of the Indian cricket team and businessman Vankar Chamundeswarathan. The team will be called Mumbai Masters.

"I am proud to be associated with badminton which I've always admired and passionately followed and played a bit as a fan. The sport has produced legends and recorded many milestones for India and I hope my association with the Indian Badminton League proves to be a worthy contribution to the great sport of badminton," Gavaskar said in a release.

The USD one million league is set to launch on August 14 with some high-voltage action expected between PVP's Hyderabad Hotshots and BOP Group's Banga Beats.

A total of 90 matches will be played in the IBL which will feature six franchises.

The IBL will be held in six cities from August 14-31. The tournament will feature some of the top-50 players in the world and will be played under the Sudirman Cup format and televised LIVE to more than 100 countries.

Mumbai, Pune, Hyderabad, Delhi, Bangalore and Lucknow are the six cities that will feature in the first edition of IBL.

Each franchise will host a two-day leg and the top four franchises will clash in the semifinals and the winners will meet in the grand final on August 31 in Mumbai. (PTI)

## JKCA to organize U-14, U-16 boys fitness camp from July 23

JAMMU, July 18: The Jammu wing of Jammu and Kashmir Cricket Association (JKCA) is holding fitness-cum-coaching camp for Under-14 and Under-16 boys at Science College Hostel Ground from July 23, 2013.

According to an official handout issued by Hardev Singh, joint secretary Jammu wing, the Under-14 boys born on or after September 1, 1999 will have to report to Harsh Nayar, camp incharge cum coach alongwith their date of birth certificate, while Under-16 boys born on or after September 1, 1997 will have to report to Saleem-ur-Rehman, camp incharge cum coach alongwith their original date of birth certificates.

The reporting time for the camp is 3:30 pm sharp.

## Srinivasan not to attend BCCI working committee meeting

KOLKATA, July 18: Under-fire BCCI president N Srinivasan will not attend the Board's working committee meeting here on July 28, interim chief Jagmohan Dalmiya said.

Dalmiya, who has been made the interim president after Srinivasan stepped aside because of the spot fixing probe, said the Tamil Nadu strongman The Syed Mushtaq Ali Twenty 20 meet will also be held here, while the zonal leg will be played from April 1-5, the super league-cum-knockout stage will be from April 8-13. ## Statistics suggest Tendulkar bigger match-winner than Lara

NEW DELHI, July 18: In former Australia captain Ricky Ponting's view West Indian legend Brian Lara was a bigger match-winner than India's Sachin Tendulkar but contrary to his belief, statistics of the two batting greats tell a totally different story.

"Sachin and Lara were two stand-out batsmen for me. Lara won more games for his team than Sachin probably has. I'd lose more sleep as captain knowing Lara was coming into bat next day than I would with Sachin," Ponting told a newspaper recently.

Tendulkar, who has played 198 Tests, is far ahead of his once contemporary West Indian (131) when statistics of the two are compared.

The statistics of Tests show that West Indies, in Lara's presence, have won 24.42 per cent matches while with Tendulkar in the side, India have tasted victory in 35.35 per cent of their games.

If the performance in these matches is considered, Lara's contribution to his side's victories have been 24.50 per cent of his total Test runs (11953) while Tendulkar's 37.01 per cent career runs (15837) have benefited India.

Out of the hundred tons Tendulkar has scored in his international career so far, 53 of them have come in matches that India won. 20 of his 51 Test centuries have helped India triumph, which comes to 39.01 per cent.

In Lara's case, only eight of his 34 Test hundreds (23.52 per cent) have guided West Indies to victory.

It is argued that Lara's effort was often not complimented by his teammates, which resulted in his side's defeat in 63 Tests (48.01 per cent) out of the 131 matches he played. Lara's contribution in these matches were 44.47 per cent of his total runs. Interestingly, 14 hundreds from the Caribbean southpaw have come in losing cause.

When compared to Tendulkar, India have faced defeat in 56 Tests which is just 28.28 per cent of his total matches. Tendulkar has made 4088 runs, including 11 hundreds, in these encounters. (PTI)

## SAI DG laments lack of commitment in Indian coaches

NEW DELHI, July 18: Sports Authority of India (SAI) Director General Jiji Thomson today criticised the national coaches for their lack of commitment while raising doubts on the country's ability to field a competitive team if it wins the bid for hosting the 2017 Under-17 football World Cup.

"The government coaches after a while forget their commitment. Say for example a canoeing and a kayaking coach asks for transfer in Patiala where there is no kayaking. A boxing coach will ask for a transfer in Kerala where there is no boxing," Thomson said.

"UK produces 35,000 coaches a year and 80 per cent of them are voluntary, working without salary. Whereas SAI produces 300 coaches a year and 300 posts are left vacant. Next month we will recruit another 200 coaches," he added.

Talking about the U-17 World Cup, he said, "In four years' time we are probably going to host the youth football World Cup and as a host, it is imperative that we have a good team. But I doubt if we would be able to produce a team that would be upto the standards. And SAI is concerned."

Keeping in mind the soccer tournament, Thomson said he had suggested the idea of launching 'futsal' in India.

"I had a meeting with AIFF president Praful Patel and he has directed his secretary Kunal Das to meet me tomorrow. I had suggested that let us introduce futsal in all schools across India so that we can produce a good team in the next two years. Neymar is a product of futsal." (PTI)
