Rains create havoc, Chenab flows near alert mark

Sajjad Ahmed Khan, SP Poonch, Shamsher Hussain Sector Commander 6 RR and SDPO Surankote rushed to the spot and supervised the rescue operation and shifted the injured to Surankote hospital. Out of the three dead, identity of one could not be established. The two deceased were identified as 15-year-old Imtiaz Hussain, son of Mohd Hussain, resident of Lasana and Mohd Rafiq, son of Allah Ditta, resident of Sheen Darra in Poonch.

Six seriously injured were admitted to Surankote and Rajouri hospitals. They are identified as Anu Kumari of Qazi Morha Poonch, Satvir Singh of Poonch, Mohd Shabir of Daraba, Showkat Hussain of Hari Budha, Niaz Ahmed of Hari Budha and Mushtaq Ahmed of Kalai in Poonch.

the cave shrine by the evening and were on their way back to Baltal.

The spokesman said 1,000 pilgrims left from Nunwan-Pahalgal base camp to holy cave early this morning under tight security measures via traditional Chandanwari track. Besides the pilgrims who had a night halt at Chandanwari, Sheshnag and Panchtarni also started their onwards journey to holy cave.

He said weather to holy cave remained cloudy during the entire day but the yatra proceeded smoothly.

Spokesman said the decision to allow the yattris to leave for holy cave from Jammu and permit the stranded pilgrims from Pahalgal and Baltal to proceed towards Jammu was to clear their growing rush.

The pilgrims camping at Bhagwati Nagar base camp and

PESHAWAR, July 20:

At least 22 militants and six soldiers were killed in clashes between security forces and Taliban fighters in northwest Pakistan's restive Khyber tribal region, officials said today.

The fighting started last night when army and paramilitary forces launched an operation in Zao Kharamtang area of Khyber Agency, one of seven tribal districts where al-Qaeda-linked militants are active.

Clashes break out, 76 injured

Despite curfew, clashes were also reported from various places in Shopian, Kulgam and Pulwama in South Kashmir during which police fired tear smoke and charged batons on the protesters to disperse them.

Reports reaching from Bandipora said that an Army vehicle of a Commanding Officer came under stone pelting in Ashtingo, Bandipora early today. Police and Army later went in search of stone pelters in the neighbouring villages during which several youth were beaten up.

Residents said that one Ashfaq Ahmad Sheikh of village Watpora was severely beaten and he has been referred to Srinagar for treatment.

This was followed by clashes in Bandipora that

continued till evening. Protesters pelted stones on police and CRPF who charged batons and fired tear smoke to disperse them. At least seven people including four police men were injured in the clashes.

At least a dozen of protesters were also injured in Sumbal and Naidkahi in district Bandipora in protests. Three of the injured Mohammad Aarif son of Assadullah Lone, Aijaz Ahmad Lone, son of Ghulam Nabi and Muzaffar Ahmad, son of Abdul Gani Dar residents of NaidKhai were shifted to Srinagar for treatment.

Protests were also reported from Baramulla and Sopore towns. The protesters pelted stones at police and CRPF and the security forces fired tear smoke to disperse the protesters. At least six protesters were injured in the clashes.

Protests also broke out at several places in Ganderbal district. At Barsoo, police had to fire pellets to disperse a stone throwing mob, which was giving stiff resistance to police and CRPF even after tear smoke shelling. One protestor was injured in the firing.

Police sources said that three vehicles of former Chief Minister Mufti Mohammad Sayeed's motorcade were damaged when youth pelted stones at them at
