

Parliament panel seeks regulator for FDI in multi-brand retail

NEW DELHI, July 23:

Cautioning that the entry of foreign retail giants could create joblessness, a Parliamentary panel today asked the Government to set up a 'Retail Regulatory Authority' to deal with issues concerning foreign multi-brand retail companies in the country.

"We have recommended a regulatory authority to look into the problem (impact of FDI in multi-brand retail on MSMEs)," Tiruchi Siva, DMK leader and Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Industry, told reporters here.

According to Siva, if multi-brand retail chains are not regulated well, it will impact medium, small and micro enterprises (MSMEs), farmers and domestic mandis.

"Once...Mandis are eliminated, the big foreign retail giants will manipulate prices and our farmers will be forced to sell their products at low prices dictated by them (foreign retailers), the panel said in a report.

"Our own squeezed out retailers and all those associated with the market and retail trade would lose their livelihood and become jobless. It will add to our already existing social and economic woes, which generate so much unrest and violence."

Siva was of the view that multi-brand chains should be regulated so that customers are not fleeced and farmers are not under-paid for their produce.

Taking serious note of the implementation of sourcing norms, the committee suggested the 30 per cent procurement requirement should be applicable item-wise.

While allowing 51 per cent FDI in multi-brand retailing, the government made it mandatory for at least 30 per cent of the value of manufactured or processed products to be

sourced from small industries.

The panel also suggested the MSME ministry should commission a survey to assess the benefit and losses of previous FDI policies on the MSME sector to ascertain if they have created any back-end infrastructure, imparted skills to domestic manpower or upgraded managerial skills, as is envisaged in the current FDI policy.

The committee was also of the view that an institutional monitoring mechanism is essential to remove any unwarranted consequences of the policy on FDI in retail.

The panel said it concurs with the recommendation of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Commerce that "there is a need for setting up of a retail regulatory authority to look into the problems and act as a whistle blower in case of anti-competitive behaviour and abuse of dominance."

Siva said, "They are saying that they will create lakhs of jobs. It is not true. What today is done by thousands, they will get it done by hundreds."

Since the approval of 51 per cent FDI in multi-brand retailing in September, no multi-national company has approached the government to set up stores in India.

The panel also recommended strengthening of public sector undertakings, saying about 70 per cent of them are not sick and are making profits.

The committee recommended the revival of Nagaland Pulp and Paper Company, Madras Fertilisers Limited and Fertilisers and Chemicals Travancore Limited.

According to Siva, the panel has suggested that these fertiliser plants should get gas at a price on par with naphtha, which is being used as fuel. (PTI)

Home Ministry says its position on IM clear

NEW DELHI, July 23:

Refusing to be dragged into the controversy over Congress leader Shafeek Ahmed's statement that Gujarat riots led to creation of Indian Mujahideen, the Home Ministry today said the NIA charge sheet and its position on the banned terror outfit are clear.

Minister of State for Home RPN Singh said the Ministry's official position on IM is very clear and the outfit, like 34 other organisations, has been declared as banned under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act.

"What the Home Ministry thinks on the Indian Mujahideen, it is there on our website. Under UAPA, these are all banned organisations. Our position is

very clear. The Home Ministry is not tweeting on these kind of things," he told reporters here.

Singh was reacting to the controversy over a remark of Ahmed, who quoting a charge sheet of the National Investigation Agency (NIA), wrote in microblogging site Twitter that the Gujarat riots had led to creation of the terror outfit.

The remark evoked a sharp reaction from BJP which accused his Congress party of playing the communal card for vote bank politics, while the Congress distanced itself from Ahmed's comment.

Minister Singh said everything was very clear in the NIA charge sheet and everyone knows what the charge sheet says.

In the charge sheet filed on July 17, accusing five IM operatives of hatching a conspiracy for carrying out various terrorist acts across the country, the NIA has said, "IM was formed in 2003 after ultra radicalised Muslim youth segregated from the Student Islamic Movement of India due to communal mobilisation caused by factors like the riots in Gujarat in 2002 after the Godhra train burning incident and the Babri Masjid demolition".

"They do not believe in India's Constitution and IM's members nurse communal hatred against...the Hindu community." (PTI)

Bring back Sarabjeet's belongings from Pak: Sister

NEW DELHI, July 23:

Sister of Sarabjeet Singh, the Indian prisoner who was killed in a Lahore jail, today demanded that all his belongings and the money he had earned through labour in the Pakistani prison should be brought back home.

Dalbir Kaur told Home Minister Sushilkumar Shinde that Sarabjeet's belongings, clothes and other items he had kept with him during his stay in Lahore's infamous Kot Lakhpat jail should be brought back to India.

Kaur told the Home Minister that the money Sarabjeet had earned in the jail through his

labour should also be brought back home.

"The Home Minister assured that everything will be brought back from Pakistan as soon as possible," she told reporters after meeting Shinde.(PTI)
