No body frisking of disembarking passengers during polls: EC

NEW DELHI, July 25: Body frisking of any passenger will not be done during disembarkment at remote uncontrolled airports/helipads unless there is specific information about unauthorised arms or contraband goods being carried during elections.

The airport security has also been asked to instantly inform the Income Tax department on detection of cash exceeding Rs 10 lakh or bullion weighing 1 kg or more in the baggage of aircraft flying to or from any poll-bound state.

While all rules and procedures with regard to frisking and checking of persons and baggage should be enforced without any exception during the election process, any unauthorised arms, contraband goods, cash exceeding Rs 50,000 belonging to any candidate or agent or party functionary shall be investigated and considered for seizure.

This has been clarified by the Election Commission to all poll-bound states following new instructions from government to be adopted for prevention of transport of unauthorised arms, contraband goods and suspicious money/bullion through airports during the conduct of elections.

The law enforcement agencies, like CISF, state police and Income Tax Department have also been asked to develop internal Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) in such a way that the entire event right from detection till seizure or release at the airport is captured by close circuit TVs/video camera.

BSNL improving services, installing 10 more towers: CGM

 KARGIL, July 25: Bhartiya Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) is trying to improve the connectivity problem of Ladakh in general and Kargil in particular.

This was stated by Chief General Manager (CGM) BSNL J&K Circle KK Koul during a press conference, here today.

BSNL has installed a new and improved BSC with high capacity in Kargil, which has been connected with mobile switch Leh, he said, adding that the benefit of connecting the BSC with Mobile

Switch Leh is that even if the OFC is disconnected or broken-down, there will be no effect on the Mobile Service in Kargil.

To improve further service in Kargil particularly of mobile service, BSNL is installing 10 more towers out of which 3 will be in town and on 2 of these 3 towers work is under progress, 2 each in Drass and Zaskar and remaining 3 will be installed in the peripheries. After the installation of these 3 towers in town area will reduce the load on the existing towers leading to improvement in service, he added.

Koul directed the TDM Ladakh to depute the Accounts Officer BSNL Ladakh in the first week of every month for at least three days to solve the problems of the customers of Kargil.

TDM BSNL Ladakh Punchok Dorjey was also present during the press conference.

SC issues notice to Centre, states on migrant issue

NEW DELHI, July 25: (Expulsion from Assam) Act, 1950 protecting from expulsion of victims of civil disturbances, no measures have been taken either by the Centre or Assam to provide ameliorative steps for displaced persons.

It was submitted that citizenship was granted to similarly affected persons from Pakistan and Bangladesh by Citizenship (Amendment) Rules, 2004, for minority Hindu community people who were displaced as a result of the 1965 and 1971 wars between India and Pakistan and they were settled in Rajasthan and Gujarat.

"A new procedure was worked out between the years 2004 and 2007 by an executive action by the Centre. This facilitated the grant of citizenship of India to these persons under the provisions of Citizenship Act, 1955," the petition said. (PTI)

The Supreme Court today sought responses of the Centre and several State Governments on a PIL seeking citizenship or refugee status to thousands of displaced persons of minority communities like Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists and Christians due to their alleged religious persecution in Bangladesh.

A bench headed by Chief Justice P Sathasivam agreed to hear the PIL filed by an NGO Swajan and issued notices to the Governments excluding Jammu and Kashmir and southern States.

The petition stated that in spite of a specific mandate of Section 2 of Immigrants

According to police, the accused namely Jogennder Kumar committed rape on the victim when the duo was on way to home from Udhampur.

Both of them had boarded a bus at Udhampur last evening and on reaching Barmeen, they started covering the distance up to home on foot. However, in the midway, the accused allegedly overpowered the girl and raped her taking advantage of darkness and isolated area.

On reaching home, the victim narrated the incident to family members, who took her to Police Station and lodged a complaint.

Police have registered a case in this connection and launched a hunt to nab the accused, who was absconding since the incident.

Army, civil administration flags off annual Kounsar Naag Yatra

Court directs Police to trace missing youth

This court direction came after father of the missing youth appeared before the court and sought proceedings under Section 156 (3) CrPc about the whereabouts of his missing son for which a missing report was lodged with GBS Police Station on March 17, 2007, but the police did not proceed to locate the missing youth.

According to the complainant Garu Ram, his son Avinash Dogra, R/o House No. 19, JMC Mohalla Ahata Chopra, B C Road, went missing since March 17, 2007. A missing report was also lodged with Police Station General Bus Stand, but no action was taken by police after that which compelled the complainant to seek remedy from the court.
