

Healthcare top most priority of Govt: Sagar

SRINAGAR, July 27: Minister for Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Ali Mohammad Sagar today said that healthcare is the top most priority of the Government and several innovative measures have been taken to upgrade the health related infrastructure across the State during the past over four years.

The Minister was interacting with the prominent citizens and doctors while inspecting the pace of work on the construction of new building of Jawahar Lal Nehru Memorial Hospital which is under execution at an estimated cost of Rs. 58 crore.

Medical Superintendent JLNH Hospital and senior officers of various departments including, R&B, PHE, JKPC were also present on the occasion.

Mr. Sagar directed the executing agency to speed up the pace of work and complete the project within the stipulated time frame so that the people living in old city get the upgraded health care facilities. He directed the officers to work in close coordination so that the bottlenecks, if any, are removed

and the project gets completed expeditiously.

The Minister also directed the officers to develop the necessary parking facilities in the hospital premises for the convenience of the people. He also

CJI's advise to Law Graduates

HYDERABAD, July 27: Chief Justice of India P Sathasivam today said legal education is not just a tool of professional success but a medium for social welfare and empowering deprived sections of the society.

Advising law graduates to never see law only as a means of livelihood, he said the true value of legal education includes the ability to contribute to social welfare.

"It is imperative for you to realise that legal education is not just a tool of professional success. The true social value of legal education includes personal empowerment as well as the ability to contribute to social welfare," he said.

"Law degree is not just a degree, rather a licence to help others to resolve their disputes with the aid of law," the CJI said while delivering the 11th annual convocation address at NALSAR University of Law here.

Asking the students who were awarded law degrees and diplomas to challenge themselves, the CJI said they should not allow money or fear to influence their decisions in life.

"Never allow any decision of yours at any corner of time to be swayed by the factor of money or fear," he said.

Focusing life solely on making money shows a dearth of ambition, Sathasivam said, adding that to make a mark in the world requires patience, commitment and ability to handle failures.

Protests over death due to medical negligence

SRINAGAR, July 27: Protests broke out at Tral in South Kashmir's Pulwama district over the death of a pregnant woman due to the alleged medical negligence.

Reports said that Afshana wife of Tariq Ahmad Bhat of Tral Balla, Pulwama was admitted to Sub District Hospital (SDH) Tral yesterday afternoon. She complained of labour pain and late in the evening she gave birth to a baby after a caesarean.

However, hours later as her condition worsened, doctors shifted her to SKIMS Hospital at Soura in Srinagar where she died.

Today the family members and other attendants of the woman held protests in the Sub-District Hospital Tral against the alleged negligence of doctors. The doctors and other staff managed to escape from the hospital as they feared that the protesters may beat them. The protesters ransacked the hospital.

The Deputy Commissioner of Pulwama, Manzoor Ahmad Lone, has ordered an inquiry into the death of the woman due to alleged negligence. Medical Superintendent (MS) of District Hospital Pulwama has been appointed as Inquiry Officer.
