Motorcyclist knocked to death by speeding car

JAMMU, June 4: A youth was crushed to death when his motorcycle was hit by a speeding car on Jewel-Satwari road near Gandhi Nagar, this evening.

Identity of the deceased has been established as Pankaj Sudan (26) son of Jagdish Sudan of Nai Basti. He was driving at Satwari branch of a private bank.

According to police, Pankaj died on the spot following the accident. The over speeding car also hit a barricade after and then collided with another car damaging it and injuring the driver.

Meanwhile, police recovered body of an unidentified female of the age group of 45, near Presentation Convent School Gandhi Nagar while a youth was found dead under mysterious circumstances at Satwari.

The deceased youth was identified as Tins Kumar (32), son of Ram Saran of Chattisgarh, who was presently putting up at Satwari.
