6. The site of work is available the intending bidders are strongly advised to inspect the site of work before bidding.
7. The Technical bids uploaded on the website up to due date and time will be opened on 21-06-2013 (1 P.M.) or any other convenient date in the Office of the Superintending Engineer Hydraulic Circle Jammu in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
8. The earnest money shall be forfeited, if any bidder/tenderer withdraws his bid/tender during the period of bid validity or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the bid.
9. Standard Bidding Document can be seen at and downloaded from the website www.jktenders.gov.in. Standard Bidding Document contains qualifying criteria for bidders, technical specifications, BOQ, general terms conditions and other details.
10. Bids must be accompanied by bid security and cost of document as mentioned in the above table in the form as specified in the Bidding document. The Demand Draft (non-refundable) on account of cost of bidding document shall be pledged to Executive Engineer PHE Division Akhnoor payable at Akhnoor while as the EMD for the bid shall be pledged to Superintending Engineer Hydraulic Circle Jammu and shall be valid for 90 days from the date of opening of Technical Bid. 11. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without permission of the Government. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who has not obtained the permission of the Government as foresaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Contractor's Service.
12. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids. If any bidder/tenderer withdraws his bid/tender during the said period or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the bid, the earnest money of such bidder shall be forfeited.
13. Contractor shall make his own arrangement to the key construction materials like Cement and steel etc. to be purchased by the contractor as per the latest IS specifications in vogue and that too from stipulated manufacturers (From major plants only and supported with quality test reports which shall be checked with reference to prescribed standards by the Asst. Ex. Engineer) and the materials should meet the requirement as per Govt. order No. 171-PW (Hyd) of 2011 dated 26-04-2011. Instruction to the bidder regarding e-tendering process.
i. The interested bidder can download the NIT/bidding documents from the website www.jktenders.gov.in
ii. To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) as per information Technology Act-2000, to participate in online bidding. The certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. Bidders can get above mentioned digital certificate from any approved vendors. The Bidders, who already possess valid (DSC) Digital Signature Certificate, need not to procure new Digital Signature Certificate.
iii. The bidders have to submit their bids in online electronic format with Digital Signature. The bid cannot be uploaded without Digital Signature.
iv. Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
v. The Department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
vi. All the required information for bid must be filled and submitted online.
vii. The details of cost of documents, EMD specified in the tender documents should be the same, as submitted online (scanned copies) otherwise bid will not be accepted.
viii. Bidders can contact the undersigned for any guidance for getting DSC or any other relevant details in respect of e-tendering process.
ix. Variation if any in EMD shall be deposited by the lowest bidder at the time of allotment.
x. Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copy of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid. (Note: Bidders are advised to scan their document at 100DPI (Dots per Inch) resolutions with Black and White, JPEG Scan properly, convert scan images to PDF.
xi. Bidders are advised to use 'My Documents' area in their user profile on website www.jktenders.gov.in. e-tendering portal to store important documents like Experience Certificate, Balance sheet, VAT Certificate, Sales Tax Clearance Certificate, IT certificate, Manufacturers authorization and other related documents etc; and attach these certificate as Non statutory documents while submitting their bids.

PMO gives green signal to Amritsar-Delhi-Kolkata industrial corridor

NEW DELHI, June 7:

Prime Minister Manmohan Singh today gave green signal to the Amritsar-Delhi-Kolkata industrial corridor and constituted an inter-ministerial panel to prepare the feasibility report for setting it up.

This is the second such corridor after the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC), which is currently under development.

The Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) to be headed by Department of Industrial Policy and promotion (DIPP) Secretary would include Secretaries of Economic Affairs, Road Transport, Shipping and Chairman Railway Board.

"This IMG will examine the feasibility of setting up the Amritsar-Delhi-Kolkata industrial corridor along with the structural and financing arrangements that would be required to operationalise it at the earliest. The IMG will give its report within a month," said an official statement.

The corridor will cover the

states of Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal.

"This is one of the most densely populated regions in the world and houses about 40 per cent of India's population. This is a region which needs major push for industrialisation and job-creation and this corridor will act as a catalyst for growth," the statement said.

The industrial corridor will use the Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor as the backbone. The Eastern Dedicated Freight

Corridor extends from Ludhiana in Punjab to Dankuni near Kolkata.

It will also leverage the Inland Waterway System being developed along National Waterway - 1 which extends from Allahabad to Haldia, the statement added.

The statement said that in order to give a boost to industrial development in the densely populated states of Northern India, the Prime Minister has approved the commencement of preparatory work on creating an Amritsar-Delhi-Kolkata Industrial Corridor (PTI)

Whereas, vide Govt. Order No. 233-FST of 2011 dated 18.05.2011 and Govt. Order No. 435 - FST of 2011 dated 01.12.2011, 40 Assistant Conservator of Forests have been appointed, under direct recruitment quota, on the recommendations of the J&K Public Service Commission; and

Whereas, regularization of some Range Officers Grade - I as Assistant Conservators of Forests have been ordered vide Govt. Order No. 317 - FST of 2012 dated 13.08.2012; and

Whereas, it has become necessary to update and notify the seniority of Assistant Conservators of Forests by deleting the names of those who have been either regularized as Deputy Conservators of Forests or have retired and by incorporating the names of those officers who have been regularized/appointed as Assistant Conservators of Forests subsequent to the date of issuance of the last seniority list of Assistant Conservators of Forests viz: 01.04.2011; and

Whereas, an updated tentative seniority list of Assistant Conservators of Forests as it stood on 01.10.2012, was issued vide Notification No. FST/Ser/1/2010 dated 15.10.2012 for information of all the members. It was also notified that any officer not satisfied with the position assigned to him/her in the tentative seniority list may represent to the Administrative Department through Principal Chief Conservator of Forests with documentary evidence within a period of 21 days; and

Whereas, no representation has been received in the Administrative Department within the stipulated time and it is, as such, presumed that there is no objection to the position assigned to the officers in the tentative seniority list.

Now, therefore, final seniority list of the Assistant Conservator of Forests as it stood on 01.03.2013, forming annexure to this Government Order, is hereby notified for information of all the concerned.

It is further notified that -

- a) Review petition by the officers, if any, against the position assigned to him/her in the seniority may be made to the Competent Authority, if he/she chooses to do so, within 15 days time from the date of issuance of the Government Order, after which no petition, whatsoever, shall be entertained.
b) Date(s) of birth indicated against the Officers in annexure to this Order shall not be treated as authentic for the purpose of determination of age which shall and shall always have reference to the recorded date of birth in the Service Book on the basis of the matriculation certificate issued by the Board of Secondary School Education/University as the case may be.
c) The officers belonging to any reserved categories may also submit valid category certificate fresh within the prescribed time period.

This issues without prejudice to the outcome of the Writ petition(s), if any, on the subject pending before any Competent Court of law.
