

'3rd round of spectrum auction within 70 days of EGoM nod'

NEW DELHI, June 9: Government will conduct the third round of spectrum auction within 70 days of receiving approval from an Empowered Group of Ministers (EGoM) headed by Finance Minister P Chidambaram, sources said.

"It will take around 70 days to start auction of airwaves from the date EGoM decides on it," a senior Department of Telecom official told.

The official said the EGoM is expected to meet soon but no date has been decided yet.

The EGoM would also decide on auction of 2G spectrum in 1800MHz band, premium airwaves frequency in 900 MHz band and CDMA spectrum that remained unsold in March 2013.

"Planning Commission Deputy Chairman Montek Singh Ahluwalia wants that spectrum pricing matter should be referred to TRAI. But referring matter to the regulator may delay auction as well as reforming. These are issues due to which clear time for auctions cannot be given. Only EGoM can decide on it," the official said. (PTI)

Reliance General Insurance hopes to grow 20%

MUMBAI, June 9: Private sector general insurer Reliance General Insurance expects to grow around 20 per cent in the current financial year, a top company official said.

"We hope to grow around 20 per cent in this fiscal. Our focus is on growing both on top-line and bottom-line fronts," Chief Executive Officer of Reliance General Insurance, Rakesh Jain told here over the weekend.

The private general insurer had a premium growth of 17.37 per cent to Rs 2,010 crore by the end of last financial year.

Jain said the company would like to have profitable growth with focus on value than on volume alone.

Referring to focus areas, Jain said the company would concentrate on weather insurance along with liabilities side to drive growth in the current financial year.

"Currently, while retail contributes 80 per cent of the total business, 20 per cent comes from the corporate side. We want to bring a balance between the two and seek to increase corporate line of business to 25 per cent in the near future," he said, adding weather and liabilities would be major focus areas to grow the corporate business pie in the overall business.

According to the company, it will also bring some balance in motor insurance segment in future. (PTI)

Mahindra to launch lower variant of XUV 500 this fiscal

NEW DELHI, June 9: Auto major Mahindra & Mahindra will introduce a lower variant of its sports utility vehicle XUV 500 by the end of this fiscal in a bid to rev up sales in a sluggish market.

"We constantly keep on getting customer feedback and taking that into account, we plan to launch a lower variant of XUV 500 by the end of the current fiscal," Mahindra & Mahindra Chief Executive Automotive Division Pravin

Shah told. Mahindra had launched the XUV 500 in 2011. It currently markets three variants of the model in the domestic market at a price range of Rs 12.13 lakh to Rs 14.77 lakh (ex-showroom Delhi).

XUV500 has clocked a cumulative of about 63,000 units so far in the 20 months since launch. After the initial euphoria, when the company had to even deliver the vehicle through draw of lottery, sales

of XUV500 have tapered off. Last month, the company had sold 2,200 units of the XUV500.

"In FY13, utility vehicles segment grew by 50 per cent but in the first two months of this fiscal, it has grown by just 4 per cent. Within the UV segment, those which have come under the extra 3 per cent excise duty, sales have declined by 14 per cent so far in this financial year," he said. (PTI)
