- 1) The parties/individuals submitting the E.O.I. should be permanent residents of J&K State.
 - 2) The MRI along with the accessories shall have to be procured by the parties/individuals/firm without any financial liability on the hospital or department.
 - 3) The MRI installed by the firm (Private Party) should be of latest configuration with 1.5 Tesla strength, backed-up by adequate Generator/UPS/battery back-up as per the requirements of the equipment.
 - 4) The space for installation of MRI shall be provided by the hospital free of the rental charges for the first 10 years along with Electricity Connection. The hospital will provide a basic structure for housing the MRI but any modifications, furnishing etc of the structure shall be carried out by the firm itself.
 - 5) The Operation and maintenance of the MRI Equipment as well as reporting of MRI will be the responsibility of the firm.
 - 6) MRI Services have to be made available regularly from 10 AM to 4 PM in the premises of Bone and Joint Hospital. However services have to be made available round the clock in case of emergencies at the time of need. The machine has to be kept functional at all times barring unforeseen circumstances.
 - 7) The rates charged for the MRI shall be as per the rates applicable to Govt. Hospitals as notified by the Health and Medical Education Department vide relevant Govt. Orders on the subject. The rates shall however be subject to revision if ordered by the Department from time to time. As per the provisions of above mentioned Govt. Order the firm will have to provide 50% concession on MRI in case of extremely poor patients on the recommendations of the HOU/HODs countersigned by the Medical Superintendent. Even at times in respect of accidental cases who are unknown/unconscious without any attendant the investigation shall be done free of charges, if recommended by the HoD and countersigned by the Medical Superintendent at contained in the provisions of the said Govt. order.
 - 8) The quality of the films, imaging and reporting has to be in consonance with the hospital requirements and will be reviewed from time to time by the Radiologist of this hospital.
 - 9) The firm/Diagnostic center will be at liberty to entertain any patients referred from other Govt. Hospitals. However, priority shall have to be given to the patients of this hospital for whom the waiting time is to be minimized to maximum possible extent.
 - 10) In case of poor quality of services or stoppage of services, penalty clause will be incorporated, which will form a clause in the detailed MOU to be entered into by the hospital authorities with the selected private party.
 - 11) After detailed deliberations with the selected party, the hospital authorities shall enter into an agreement in the shape of MOU, the terms and conditions of which will be binding upon both parties.

SBI witnesses 60% rise in deposits as savers seek safe haven

MUMBAI, June 13: State Bank of India has notched up nearly 60 per cent uptick in deposits so far this fiscal, partly due to the flight of savings from ponzi and bogus schemes, many of which went belly up in recent months, its Chairman Pratip Chaudhuri has said.

Surprisingly, during the latter part of the past fiscal, the country's largest bank had witnessed a sharp fall in deposit accretion, just like other banks. Chaudhuri described the development, which has its roots in one of the biggest tragedies to hit the investors, especially in the eastern states, as "flight to safety".

"There is a flight to safety. In many parts of the country, many (ponzi and bogus) schemes are not able to redeem their deposits. So then SBI becomes a beneficiary," Chaudhuri said, adding that the eastern states are a fertile deposit collecting ground.

Deposit growth is very strong, in fact we are surprised because our deposit rates are lowest in the industry...They have grown 1.5 times," he told in an interview.

In absolute terms, the bank's deposit growth till now has been Rs 41,000 crore as against Rs 26,000 crore it had notched up in the same period last fiscal.

The bank had posted a 14.9 per cent rise in deposits in FY13, with the last two quarters witnessing headwinds, partly due to the bank's decision to test the market by lowering its offering.
