## Kangrail, Deharan without power for 3 days

JAMMU, June 13: The villages --Kangrail and Deharan in Jammu tehsil has been reeling under complete darkness for the last three days as the feeding transformer damaged three days ago, which the Power Development Department (PDD) failed to repair or replace despite repeated requests and reminders by the people.

Moreover, these villages did not get any water supply from one week as the pumping motor is also out of order and the Public Health Engineering Department has failed to get it repaired.

The villagers alleged that they approached the concerned authorities of PDD several times but they got nothing except assurances and promises.

They also rued that the transformer installed in their area is not sufficient enough to cater to the power demand of their area. They said that even MLA had been apprised of the problem several times but nothing has been done. They demanded that water supply in the area should be immediately restored.

## Protest rally against DSE

The Forum demanded that all the old subjects (Political Science, Sociology, History and Sanskrit) being taught presently in the school should be continued as these subjects have maximum enrollment in school. They said although these are the most important subjects from career point of view, yet the Director School Education has excluded these important subjects.

The Forum members criticized the wrong and useless decision of Director School Education for excluding these subjects from 11th class.

It was also demanded to provide faculty for the new subjects introduced in the school as early as possible.

Meanwhile, NSF presented a memorandum short listing a number of important issues and demands in the interest of student community to Tehsildar RS Pura, who assured to forward the matter to the concerned higher authorities.

## Govt to establish separate directorates for implementation of ICDS: Sakina

JAMMU, June 13: Government is contemplating to establish separate directorates for the implementation of the flagship Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) in the twin divisions of Kashmir and Jammu.

The new directorates would exclusively take care of ICDS that aims at eradicating malnutrition among the children by providing required nutrition to them through Anganwari Centres established across the State.

Addressing participants at one day awareness-cum-cheque distribution camp organized by the Department of Social Welfare, the Minister for Social Welfare, Sakina Itoo said that the proposal to have separate ICDS directorates was under active consideration of the Government. She said that the step was being taken to streamline the implementation of the flagship scheme meant for the overall wellbeing of child and mother, besides to overcome the problem of malnutrition among the children.

Highlighting the role of Anganwari Centres in creating awareness among the people about health, hygiene and child care, the Minister said that they were also doing a yeoman's job in anti-female foeticide campaign. She said that falling male-female ratio was assuming alarming dimensions and demands immediate corrective measures.

She called upon the participants to intensify the 'Save Girl Child' campaign saying that it would be a great service to the humanity.

Later, the Minister distributed cheques worth Rs 40 Lakh among 350 beneficiaries which include Indira Gandhi Old age, Window and Handicapped Pensioners besides SC women beneficiaries trained in Tailoring under Special Central Assistance (SPA) for Scheduled Cast Population (SCP).

The Minister also distributed sewing machines and tailoring kits among the women trained in tailoring, besides wheelchairs, tricycles and, hearing aids among the persons with special needs.

Among others, Director Social Welfare, M.H. Bhatti, Programme and District Social Welfare Officer, Deputy Directors, CDPOs, supervisors, anganwari workers and prominent citizens were also present on the occasion.

## DPP flays Govt for power, water crisis

JAMMU, June 13: Duggar Pradesh Party (DPP) has strongly criticized the State Government for the power and water problem in the region.

The leaders of DPP in a meeting held under the chairmanship of Udhay Chand alleged that Government has failed to provide electricity and water supply to the people of Jammu region. They said the Jammu, Kathua, Samba and other districts of the region are reeling under severe hot temperature but the PDD has imposed long power cuts, causing inconvenience to the people. The people are suffering from virtual torture due to frequent power cuts.

They said in rural areas the condition is more worse. Due to power failure and low voltage, the water supply has also been hit in the entire Kandi belt. The motors at the pumping stations remain un-replaced for days and weeks together while villagers remain facing crisis. They alleged that Government has been unable to deliver the essential services to the public.

## DFSS takes out protest procession

JAMMU, June 13: Dogra Front and Shiv Sena today took out a protest procession against the State Government's discrimination with Jammu region on disbursement of electricity.

The procession was taken out by hundreds of DFSS workers under the leadership of Ashok Gupta from Raj Tilak Road to Press Club.

By holding electric fans, matkas, taps and hand fans in their hands, protestors raised slogans against the PDD and State Government.

Lambasting the Government for its highly biased approach, Gupta pointed towards the most obnoxious aspects of power distribution within the State. Citing figures, he said that the power consumption between Jammu and Kashmir regions is in the ratio of 40:60 respectively but when it comes to revenue realisation Jammu contributes more than 66% of power tariff with barely 33% coming from Kashmir region.

He said that the people of Jammu are paying their bills regularly but still they are facing 8-12 hours of power cut. This, he said indicates the highly biased, parochial and discriminatory approach of the State Government with regard to supply of power and revenue collection vis a vis the two regions of the State.

Gupta said that the Sena has vowed to fight such discriminatory tactics of the Government tooth and nail.

## Woman attacked by bear

UDHAMPUR, June 13: A woman was attacked and seriously injured by a wild bear at village Gardiaya Khurd in Chenani, last evening.

The victim, identified as Shankri Devi wife of Khem Raj of Gardiaya, was on way to home from a nearby jungle after grazing goats and sheep when the bear attacked her. Before the woman could raise alarm for help, the bear attacked and left her critically injured.

The victim was later shifted to Sub-District Hospital Chenani and then referred to District Hospital Udhampur for the advanced treatment.

UDHAMPUR, June 13: A VDC member committed suicide by shooting self with his own rifle at village Gondha Khwas in Budhal area last night.

The deceased has been identified as Bansilal (45), son of Sathu Ram, resident of Gondha village in Khwas area. The other members of the family woke up at around 3 am after hearing sound of gun fire. They saw Bansilal lying in pool of blood. He was a drunk and used to sleep alone in his room.

The family members informed police about the matter. The dead body was shifted to hospital for postmortem and later hand over to the family. The 12 bore gun of the deceased was also seized. A case under Section 174 CrPc has been registered in this connection.
