

SGEJAC demands release of money to Jammu treasuries

JAMMU, June 21: Expressing serious concern over delay in release of salaries and wages due to emptied treasuries, the State Government Employees Joint Action Committee has demanded immediate release of money to Jammu treasuries.

Addressing a press conference after an executive body meeting of the SGEJAC Jammu here today, Sushil Sudan, Subhash Verma and Suresh Sharma highlighted various issues, including the emptied treasuries of Jammu due to which the salaries of employees, GP fund and wages to the daily rated workers could not be disbursed. They urged the Government to immediately release the money to Jammu treasuries so that employees may not suffer further.

The SGEJAC also reiterated the employees' demands, which include regularization of daily rated workers, removal of pay anomalies in all cadre, budgetary support to PSUs and withdrawal of circular number 9 of GAD dated 26-3-2013.

They flayed the PDD authorities for allegedly victimizing the trade union leader in Kathua and demanded immediate reinstatement of all the six employees who have been suspended. The SGEJAC threatened to take 'appropriate' action if the employees are not reinstated.

Earlier, an executive body meeting of SGEJAC was held for discussing various issues concerning the employees. The meeting was attended by Suman Sharma, Maheshwar Sharma, Vinod Sharma, Rinku Gill, Jamal Khokhar, Mohd Farooq, Swaran Singh, K C Dubey, C L Koul, Manzoor Ali and others.

24000 candidates appearing in CET today Last date for submission of admission forms in City colleges extended

JAMMU, June 21: Last date for submitting application forms for fresh admission in all the Government Colleges in Jammu city was extended today by June 25.

Now the first cut off merit list for admission in these City colleges will be issued on June 29.

Earlier, the last date for submitting application forms was June 21 while the cut off list had to be released on June 27. The last date for submitting application forms was extended in view of the heavy rush of admission seekers.

So far, a total number of 10,500 candidates have applied for admission in the five City colleges, which include GGM Science College, Government College for Women Parade, Government College for Women Gandhi Nagar, SPMR College of Commerce and

MAM College. In GCW Parade, where online facility for admission has also been provided, 3000 candidates have submitted the application forms. The number of applications for admission in GCW Gandhi Nagar is 2300 while 2700 candidates have so far applied in GGM Science College. The number of admission applications, received at SPMR College of Commerce and MAM College, is 2700 and 1500, respectively.

Meanwhile, all arrangements were finalized for the Combined Entrance Test-2013 tomorrow in which 24000 candidates are appearing across the State.

Board of Professional Entrance Examination (BOPEE), which is conducting the CET, has set up total 24 centres for the purpose. Fourteen 14 centres have been established at Kashmir and 10 in Jammu.

EJAC president alleges harassment, announces retirement

SRINAGAR, June 21: President of the Employees Joint Action Committee (EJAC), Muntazir Mohidin, today announced pre-mature retirement from his service alleging harassment by two Cabinet Ministers.

While addressing a press conference Mohidin launched a scathing attack on CAPD Minister Choudhery Mohammad Ramzan for transferring him from Budgam to Anantnag when he was about to retire. "Ramzan and Rural Development Minister Ali Mohammad Sagar played a biased role and harassed me on the one or the other pretext. Even Ramzan told me that higher ups of the Government were pressurizing him to deal sternly with me," Mohidin alleged.

Muntazir Mohidin alleged that the day Ramzan took the charge of CAPD, he started harassment of the employees. "I was shocked to learn from Ramzan that he is helpless before the higher-ups of the Government and he can't stop his transfer. Finance Minister Abdul Rahim Rather played a positive role but all his efforts proved futile in stopping my transfer from Budgam. One of the bureaucrats suggested me to take premature retirement," he said.

Petrol Pump sealed, owner booked for short delivery

JAMMU, June 21: Legal Metrology Department today sealed a petrol pump and booked its owner for short delivery.

A joint team of officers of Legal Metrology and sales officers of Indian Oil Corporation led by Deputy Controller, Consumer Protection, Manoj Prabhakar conducted a joint inspection of petrol pumps at RS Pura, Kunjwani and Narwal area.

During the drive, 4 pumps were inspected to ascertain the correctness of sealing and delivery of the fuel dispensed to the consumers.

As one dispensing unit was found to be delivering less by 60 ml to the consumers against five litre calibrated check measure, it was sealed and its owner booked under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Law. The unit was fined for Rs 5000 on the spot and the delivery was made accurate in the interest of consumers.
