In absence of water, people here face many problems. It seems the authorities have taken us for granted that we may not voice our concern in this regard.

As per orders (source unknown) once on alternate days to each locality of this area on alternate days. Though such a bogus supply to the Kandi Zone like ours is itself a curse, but when even such a scanty supply is maintained on paper alone without any virtual supply, the living conditions of our poor fellow-companions gets further worsened. The fact is that the scanty supply of water to our locality is made hardly twice in a month long period particularly on the pretext of defective Water Pumps of this Station for the reasons best known to the officers of the PHE Deptt. This sort of affairs besides being cloudy and detrimental to the State Exchequer, is posing a great anxiety to the residents of this area in the absence of any proper arrangements for the said drinking water.

All our efforts to impress upon the concerned AEE, PHE, including the higher officers of the Deptt. to take measures to streamline the system of the Station as a whole have failed inspite of our best efforts.
