The road of Greater Kailash Colony has become so popular for the last few years that almost cent percent light vehicular commuters adopt this short and safe route from Jammu City towards Bari Brahmana onwards and return. This colony is also well known where high political personalities, high rank Government officers have also constructed residential houses.

But, we the residents regret to say that this colony is lagging behind in respect of required developments as in case of other adjoining housing colonies like Sainik Colony, Channi Himmat and Trikuta Nagar etc. There are no parks where children can play or elders can enjoy morning/evening walk. There is no shopping center, no community hall and no Government medical dispensary. In emergency cases one has to rush 15 Km to Jammu City for medical treatment.

During recent heavy rains, road/Lane No. 22 upside famous Phawara Chock was so much damaged that it has taken the shape of a Nallah. Flood water flowing 2 to 3 ft above road level entered the houses. One cannot walk on this damaged road even on foot. No one from Government, concerned department nor any political leader bothered to visit the area and listen to public grievances.

We the residents, particularly senior citizens request concerned-Government authority to visit and look into public demand in respect of restoration of damaged roads, lanes, drains, as well as required development works of this colony.
