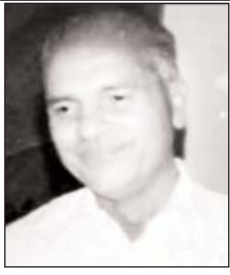

SHIMLA, Mar 30:

A mild earthquake, measuring 3.6 on the Richter scale, jolted parts of Chamba district in the state today.
This happens to be the second quake in the past four days in the region.
Indian Meteorological Department, Director, Manmohan Singh said that parts of Chamba district were hit by a 3.6 magnitude earthquake at 11:41 hrs.
The quake was epicentred at 32.7 degree North Latitude and 76.05 degrees East Longitude in the Chamba district.
A quake of similar intensity had hit Chamba on March 27. (UNI)

NTA asked to postpone last date for exams

NEW DELHI, Mar 30:

The HRD Ministry today directed the National Testing Agency to postpone the last date of acceptance of applications for multiple exams conducted by it, including UGC NET and JNU entrance test, amid the coronavirus pandemic.

"To enable students to fill up their application forms during these testing times, I have advised @DG_NTA to postpone the last date of acceptance of applications of ICAR Exam, JNU Entrance Exam, UGC NET, CSIR NET, NCHM JEE, IGNOU PhD and Management Entrance Exams by 1 month," Union HRD Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' tweeted.
The country is under a 21-day lockdown from March 25 to contain coronavirus outbreak.
The virus has infected 1,071 people and claimed 29 lives, the Union Health Ministry said today. (PTI)

31 Indians, including diplomats from Kabul sent to quarantine facility
NEW DELHI, Mar 30:

A special flight from Afghanistan carrying 31 Indians, including diplomats and ITBP personnel, landed at the Delhi airport on Monday and the passengers were sent to a quarantine facility set up in the wake of the coronavirus outbreak, officials said.
Officials had earlier said that a total of 35 people were brought on the plane.
They were brought on a Kam Air flight from Kabul that landed at about 2:40 pm at the Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport.
"There are 31 passengers on the special flight from Kabul that includes four diplomats, 26 ITBP men and a civilian," a senior official said.
Their medical samples will be taken to check coronavirus symptoms, he said.
The Indo-Tibetan Border Police is deployed to guard the main Indian embassy complex in Afghanistan's capital city of Kabul and four consulates in Herat, Kandhar, Jalalabad and Mazar-e-Sharif.
The passengers were screened with temperature guns by ITBP personnel at the tarmac and were sent to the quarantine facility in the Chhawla area of southwest Delhi.
The Centre already has 481 Indians who were recently rescued from COVID-19 affected Rome in Italy. (PTI)

Ensure uninterrupted supply of vital medicines, food products: Goyal to G20 Trade Ministers

NEW DELHI, Mar 30:

India today called for ensuring uninterrupted supply of vital medicines and food products across the globe to deal with the challenges in the wake of surge in the number of coronavirus cases across the world.
Participating in the Extraordinary G20 Trade and Investment Ministerial virtual meeting, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said that trade facilitative responses need to be in place, and wherever necessary, requirements by authorities like customs, banks of producing original documents by importers for various clearances can be removed temporarily.
"Additionally, we need to think of a suitable framework under which critical pharma products, medical devices, diagnostic equipment and kits and healthcare professionals can be deployed at short notice across territories under a pre-agreed protocol," he said.
"Our collective act must reflect and uphold the centrality of the rules based multilateral system with development at the centre of any action in trade as well as other areas. We must ensure that the supply of goods, and services most importantly that of vital medicines and food products are not disrupted consistent with national needs," he added.
The Minister said that the catastrophic impact of COVID-19 globally and the serious threat it poses to the world economy are alarming.
Around 90 per cent of the

COVID-19 cases and 88 per cent of deaths have occurred in the G20 countries, while many other nations too are now grappling with rising cases each day, he said.
He pointed out that developing countries and least developed countries (LDCs) are particularly vulnerable as they may not have matching resources, infrastructure and technical capacities to face this unprecedented pandemic.
"Our responses must recognize these inadequacies while deciding on our collaborative response. Such unprecedented challenges necessitate innovative, collaborative and proactive response from the world," Goyal said.
He said that G20 leaders at the Extraordinary G20 Leaders' Summit on COVID-19 last week committed to inject USD 5 trillion into the global economy to combat the social, economic and financial fallout of this pandemic, but this move needs to be substantiated with a predictable, inclusive and stable international trading environment which recognizes unequal level of economic development, per capita income, and human development index.
Additionally, the member countries need to think of a suitable framework under which critical pharma products, medical devices, diagnostic equipment and kits and healthcare professionals can be deployed at short notice across territories under a pre-agreed protocol.
"There is a need to uphold our multilateral commitments and improve upon its effective-

ness to meet current challenges...While putting in place our emergency responses, it is imperative that we act to safeguard our shared future as well by increase our preparedness for such calamities by suitably investing in strengthening public health infrastructure and capacities especially in developing and least developed countries," Goyal emphasized.
Therefore, he added, that the countries need to work towards creating a global framework for further enhancing affordable access to medicines for fighting pandemics and facilitating easier movement of healthcare professionals across national borders.
Despite many challenges, India has been a dependable and affordable source of efficacious and high quality medical and pharma products to nearly 190 countries around the world.
"We are confident that with improved regulatory and R&D cooperation, India can further enhance its capabilities to serve the world in crisis like this. We must ensure that suitable instruments stay in place to address these inabilities and preserve the life, livelihood, food and nutritional security of the poorest," the minister said.
He added that although the Indian government has taken several measures to deal with the situation, mere national responses are not sufficient in today's inter-dependent world, and there is a need to act more collaboratively as well as globally.
G-20 countries are a group of developed and developing countries. Its members include India, the US, European Union, China, Japan, Italy, France and Turkey. (PTI)

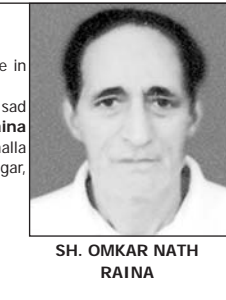

CRPF offers its camps, manpower to help COVID-19 patients

NEW DELHI, Mar 30:

The CRPF has opened up its camps across the country to help local administration store essential items and provide its manpower in carrying out relief work in the wake of the coronavirus outbreak, a senior official said today.
The country's largest paramilitary force has also asked its field units to "adopt" villages and localities in their vicinity to take care of the basic necessities of the locals like rations, medicines and masks during the ongoing lockdown period.
A directive issued by the headquarters of the force here said "keeping in view the prevailing emergent situation in the country, it has been desired by the DG (Director General) in consultation with senior commanders that the CRPF should go all out to extend a helping hand to the state agencies in combating the menace of COVID-19 as best as possible."
"With our pan-India presence, it is desirable that we offer our resources to the states in our respective areas of

deployment to augment the resources of states who are the first responders wherever they feel any gaps or deficiency," the directive accessed by PTI said.
It said the Central Reserve Police Force establishments can help in ways like: Transportation and logistics support; offering space in campuses for storage of medicines and equipment; offering manpower for helping in distribution of essential commodities, food, medicines and providing accommodation in their campuses for specialised teams.
The force has also asked its commanders to consider providing water tankers, join hands with various stakeholders in creating awareness about the pandemic and preparation of cooked food and its distribution to the needy and poor, including migrant workers in the vicinity of our locations.
The directive said the force can also assist local administration in enforcing the ongoing lockdown and pitching tents for rest and food of migrant labourers who are returning home. (PTI)

Postal Dept extends insurance premium payment date till Apr 30

NEW DELHI, Mar 30:

The Department of Posts today extended premium payment date for postal life Insurance and rural postal life insurance till April 30.
"In view of the threat posed by the outbreak of coronavirus and the complete lockdown across India, Directorate of Postal Life Insurance (PLI) has given an extension of period for payment of their due premium of March 2020 upto April 30 2020 without charging any penalty/default fee," an official statement said.
Directorate of PLI said although many post offices are functional as part of essential

services, postal life insurance (PLI) and rural postal life insurance (RPLI) customers are facing difficulty in approaching post offices for payment of premium.
The decision is likely to benefit approximately 13 lakh policy holders (5.5 Lakh PLI and 7.5 Lakh RPLI) who have not been able to pay premium for current month. As compared to about 42 lakh policy holders who paid premium last month, only 29 lakh of them have been able to pay premium for this month till date, the statement said.
"Customers registered on portal have also been advised to pay premium online using PLI customer Portal," it added. (PTI)

Congress attacks PM over new PMCARE trust

NEW DELHI, Mar 30:

The Congress today attacked Prime Minister Narendra Modi over the creation of the new PMCARE trust to help contain coronavirus in the country, asking what was the need to create a separate trust when Rs 3,800 crore was lying unused in PM National Relief Fund.
Party leader Shashi Tharoor said that instead of creating a separate public charitable trust whose rules and expenditure are totally opaque, the prime minister should have renamed the PM National Relief Fund.
"This is important. Why not simply rename PMNRF as PM-CARES, given the PM's penchant for catchy acronyms, instead of creating a separate public charitable trust whose

rules and expenditure are totally opaque," he asked.
"PM you owe the country an explanation for this highly unusual step," he said on Twitter.
Congress spokesperson Gaurav Vallabh said that when Rs 3800 crore were remaining unused in the PM National Relief Fund, what was the need to have a separate trust in the name of PMCARE.
"When an amount of Rs 3,800 crore was still lying unused in PM National Relief Fund, what was the need for having another trust in PM-CARE," he asked.
He also asked whether PMCARE was a trust and who were its trustees and whether the money given to the fund would give income tax relief to donors. (PTI)

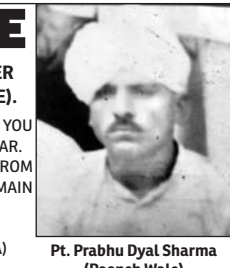
