

IT Deptt records Vadra's statement

NEW DELHI, Jan 5: The Income Tax Department questioned Robert Vadra, son-in-law of Congress President Sonia Gandhi, for about four hours on the second consecutive day today in connection with its probe against him under the benami assets law, official sources said.

Vadra today reiterated the allegations he had made the previous day -- that the aim of the action was to "digress" from the "real issues" being faced by the country and the farmers.

A team from the Chandigarh Cops recover actor Amisha Patel's hacked Instagram account

MUMBAI, Jan 5: Maharashtra Cyber on Tuesday recovered the Instagram account of actor Amisha Patel after it was hacked, an official said.

The actor had told police she had received a message purportedly from Instagram about a copyright violation and when she clicked on the link embedded in the message to clarify matters, she was directed to a fake site after which she lost control of her account, he said.

"She filed a complaint with us yesterday. The hacker had blocked the account and deleted the contents. However, we contacted Instagram and got them to reactivate the account with all its contents intact," he said.

"The phishing link was sent from a Netherlands URL while the IP address has been located to Turkey. Actor Sharad Kelkar also lost control over his account in the same manner and efforts are on to recover it," he added. (PTI)

Officials had said that the questioning was linked to the purchase of some land parcels by a firm linked to Vadra in Rajasthan's border town of Bikaner in which another Central probe agency, the Enforcement Directorate, had filed a money laundering case in 2015.

The ED has questioned Vadra in this case in the past and had attached assets worth Rs 4.62 crore of his firm M/s Sky Light Hospitality (P) Ltd (now LLP) in 2019.

Sources said the ED shared case documents of this probe along with that of possession of some alleged undisclosed assets abroad with the Tax Department for action under the anti-benami law that is enforced in the country by the latter. (PTI)

"Whenever there is an issue, Robert Vadra props up... If my family works hard for the people of this country and they (Government) want to digress from issues...They will use me or any other issue," he told reporters after the tax team left.

He said the Government should "help farmers and the people of this country", adding the agencies have all information about him and his businesses "right from inception."

"Whatever their queries are, I am here to answer...I have met ED 15 times for over 80 hours (in the past)," he said.

On Monday, Vadra was questioned for about eight hours and his statement was recorded as part of the proceedings related to the Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions Act, sources had said.

Tax department sources had said Vadra was asked to join the investigation at their office but as he cited the prevailing COVID-19 restrictions, I-T officials decided to visit his premises.

Officials had said the questioning was linked to the purchase of some land parcels by a firm linked to Vadra in Rajasthan's border town of Bikaner in which another central probe agency, the Enforcement Directorate, had filed a money laundering case in 2015.

The ED has questioned Vadra in this case in the past and had attached assets worth Rs 4.62 crore of his firm M/s Sky Light Hospitality (P) Ltd (now LLP) in 2019.

Sources said the ED shared case documents of this probe along with that of possession of some alleged undisclosed assets abroad with the Tax Department for action under the anti-benami law that is enforced in the country by the latter. (PTI)

Indian economy expected to contract by 9.6 per cent in 2020-21: World Bank

WASHINGTON, Jan 5: India's economy is estimated to contract by 9.6 per cent in the fiscal year 2020-21, reflecting a sharp drop in household spending and private investment, and the growth is expected to recover to 5.4 per cent in 2021, the World Bank said today.

In its Global Economic Prospects report, the World Bank said that the informal sector, which accounts for four-fifths of employment, has also been subject to severe income losses during the COVID-19 pandemic.

"In India, the pandemic hit the economy at a time when growth was already decelerating. The output is estimated to contract by 9.6 per cent in Fiscal Year 2020/21, reflecting a sharp drop in household spending and private investment," it said.

"In India, growth is expected to recover to 5.4 per cent in 2021,

as the rebound from a low base is offset by muted private investment growth given financial sector weaknesses," the bank said.

The informal sector, which accounts for four-fifths of employment, has also been subject to severe income losses during the pandemic. Recent high-frequency data indicate that the services and manufacturing recovery are gaining momentum, the report said.

"In the financial sector, non-performing loans were already high before the pandemic," it said.

In Pakistan, the recovery is expected to be subdued, with growth at 0.5 per cent in fiscal 2020/21. Growth is projected to be held back by continued fiscal consolidation pressures and service sector weakness," it said.

In the rest of South Asia, the economic impact of COVID-19 has been somewhat less severe but still significant. Economies that depend heavily on tourism and travel have been especially hard hit. That includes the Maldives, Nepal, and Sri Lanka, the report said.

"Regional economic activity is estimated to have contracted by 6.7 per cent in 2020, led by a deep recession in India, where the economy was already weakened before the pandemic by stress in non-bank financial corporations," the World Bank said.

In Bangladesh, which had been one of the fastest-growing emerging markets and developing economies prior to the pandemic, growth is estimated to have decelerated to two per cent in FY2019/20. (PTI)





Subject: Exploitation of rights of employees working in various shops/commercial establishments.

Ref: Representation on behalf of casual employees (casual labourers) of J&K Cable Car Corporations Ltd.

CIRCULAR

The Labour Department J&K has been receiving representations/complaints from time to time from applicants working in various Shops/commercial establishments with regard to violations of their rights by their employers/owners vis-à-vis "right for casual and privilege leave".

In this context, section 26 and 27 of the J&K Shops & Establishment Act, 1966, says:

"26. Employee's right for casual and privilege leave:

(1) A Person employed in an establishment to which this Act applies shall be entitled to:

(a) After every 12 months continuous employment, to privilege leave for a total period of one month; and

(b) In every year to casual leave for a total period not exceeding 14 days:
Provided that the leave under sub-clause (a) shall not at any time accumulate for a total period exceeding 3 months. ;
Provided further that holidays under sections 13, 18, 23 falling during the period of such leave shall be included in the leave so granted;
Provided further that casual leave shall not be combined with privilege leave."

Explanation: An employee shall be deemed to have completed a period of twelve months continuous service in an establishment notwithstanding any interruption in the service during those twelve months brought about by sickness, accident or authorized leave not exceeding ninety days in the aggregate for all three, or by a lockout or by a strike which is not an illegal strike, or by intermittent period of involuntary unemployment not exceeding thirty days in the aggregate, and authorized leave shall be deemed not to include any weekly holiday allowed under this Act which occurs at the beginning or end of an interruption brought about by the leave.

"27. Pay during leave:
Every employee shall be paid for the period of his leave at a rate equivalent to the daily average of his Wages for the days on which actually worked during the preceding three months, exclusive of any earning in respect of overtime."

In view of the above quoted Law, it is imperative upon the Employers/Owners of the Shops/commercial establishments/Corporation/Private Institutions/Firms etc, to which this Act applies, to provide Casual/Privilege Leave, to their employees and not to deduct any wages from their salaries for the said leave.

It is, therefore, impressed upon all the Employers/Owners of the Shops/commercial establishments/Corporation/Private Institutions/Firms etc, to which the J&K Shops & Establishment Act, 1966 applies, to strictly abide by Laws as laid down under the Act and Rules thereunder, so that the rights of the employees, working in various shops and other commercial establishments, are not exploited any further.
