

Are protesting farmers protected against COVID: SC

NEW DELHI, Jan 7: The apex court was hearing a plea seeking various reliefs including a CBI probe into the matter related to Assembly of people at Anand Vihar Bus Terminal and the Tablighi Jamaat congregation at Nizammudin Markaz amid the pandemic and lockdown. "You must tell us what is happening. The same problem is going to arise in farmers' agitation. I do not know if farmers are protected from COVID. So, the same problem is going to arise. It is not that everything is over," said Chief Justice S A Bobde, who was heading the bench which also comprised Justices A S Bopanna and V Ramasubramanian. The top court asked Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, whether the protesting farmers are protected from the spread of COVID. The COVID-19 guidelines include wearing of face masks at public places and social distancing norms.

Mehta replied, "Certainly not". Mehta said he will file a report within two weeks on what has been done and what needs to be done. The protests by the farmers at the border points in the national capital demanding the repeal of the three new farm laws began on November 28. The plea in the top court filed by advocate Supriya Pandita has alleged that the Delhi police had failed to control the gathering of people at Anand Vihar Bus Terminal last year during the lockdown. Trump supporters storm US Capitol 4 dead in violence before Congress certifies Biden-Harris win

WASHINGTON, Jan 7: In an unprecedented assault on democracy in the US, thousands of supporters of outgoing President Donald Trump stormed the Capitol building here and clashed with police, resulting in four deaths and interrupting a constitutional process by Congress to affirm the victory of President-elect Joe Biden and Vice President-elect Kamala Harris in the election. The Electoral College votes of Biden and Harris were finally approved early today after both the Senate and the House of Representatives rejected all objections raised by the Republicans to the votes in the States of Pennsylvania and Arizona. In the presidential election held on November 3, Biden and Harris received 306 electoral votes, while President Trump and Vice President Mike Pence got 232. The counting of Vermont's three electoral votes put Biden and Harris over the 270-threshold needed to win the presidency. The 78-year-old Democratic leader and his 56-year-old

Indian-origin deputy will be inaugurated on January 20, it was announced after the constitutional process was finally completed by a joint session of Congress. In the violence yesterday, four people died, including one woman who was shot by a police officer, amid protests and rioting on Capitol Hill that resulted in dozens of demonstrators being arrested, police said. Metropolitan Police Department Chief Robert Contee called the rioting by pro-Trump demonstrators "shameful" during a news conference. One woman was shot and killed by Capitol Police during the rioting. Police said three other people - a woman and two men - died after apparently suffering "separate medical emergencies" near the Capitol grounds. In a statement released just after the certification was finalised, Trump acknowledged his election loss. He said that even though he disagrees with the outcome, "there will be an orderly transition on January 20th."

"I have always said we would continue our ... Fight to ensure that only legal votes were counted. While this represents the end of the greatest first term in presidential history, it's only the beginning of our fight to Make America Great Again!"

The joint session of Congress, which is normally a ceremonial step, was halted for several hours when supporters of Trump breached the Capitol. Proceedings resumed and continued through the night after the building was cleared. Vice President Pence brought the Senate session back into order and proceeded with the verification process. "The announcement of the state of the vote by the President of the Senate shall be deemed a sufficient declaration of the persons elected President and Vice President of the United States, each for the term beginning January 20, 2021...." Pence said following the count of all of the State's Electoral College votes. Earlier on Wednesday, thousands of angry supporters of Trump swarmed over the US Capitol, forcing lawmakers to evacuate their chambers and delaying by several hours a normally routine procedure clearing the way for Biden and Harris to be sworn in as president and Vice President. House of Representatives Speaker Nancy Pelosi announced after hours of chaos around the white-columned edifice that police had secured the building. (PTI)

Press Release Dated: 06.01.2021 The Health & Medical Education Department vide its communication No. HME/HRM/162/2018 Dated 10.06.2020 and 21.07.2020 referred Nine hundred (900) posts of Medical Officer (Allopathic) in H&FW, to the J&K Public Service Commission, for being filled up in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020, as per the following breakup;

2. In addition, 29 backlog vacancies (RBA:15, SC:01, ST:03 & ALC:10) were also to be filled up.

3. The J&K Public Service Commission, accordingly, notified these 929 posts, vide Notification No.01-PSC(DR-P) of 2020 dated:30.07.2020.

4. In accordance with the provisions of SRO 388 dated:10.09.2018, these 929 vacancies were to be filled up solely on the basis of a written test without viva-voce/interview:

" .... the posts of Medical Officer shall be filled on the basis of written test only to be conducted by the J&K Public Service Commission."

5. It was specified in the above said notification that the candidates who are domiciled in the Union Territory of J&K and possessing the prescribed academic and professional qualification and age for the said post alone are eligible for applying. It was also specified that the last date of receipt of online applications provided in the notification (i.e. 04.09.2020) shall be the cutoff date for determining the eligibility as regards education & professional qualification.

6. In response to the above said advertisement notification, a total of 2584 applications were received. 2508 candidates were found to be provisionally eligible to appear in the written test.

7. The written examination was held on 01.11.2020. 2122 candidates (1505 in Srinagar & 617 in Jammu) appeared in the said examination. The examination was held at 10 venues; 7 in Srinagar and 3 in Jammu.

8. It is pertinent to mention here that in order to ensure transparency and fair play, each candidate was allowed to carry back Carbon Copy of Answer Sheet (OMR) for his/ her perusal and records.

9. The provisional answer key was released on 01.11.2020 for claims and objections, if any, by the candidates. The official answer key was finalized only after examining all the representations submitted by the candidates and after obtaining the opinion of the experts of the subject.

10. The result of written test was declared on 10.11.2020. 965 candidates who had cleared the benchmark eligibility criteria were directed to get their documents verified at J&K Public Service Commission offices at Jammu & Srinagar w.e.f. 17.11.2020 to 28.11.2020.

11. To begin with, the Commission had recommended 459 candidates for appointment as Medical Officer on 14.12.2020 in whose case the documents were complete in all respect. The Commission had similarly recommended 168 candidates in the waiting list.

12. The recommendations with reference to 183 candidates from the select list & 64 candidates from the wait list were kept withheld due to deficiency of various documents.

13. In pursuance of Commission's Decision No. 11.3 dated: 18.12.2020, a Committee of the Members of the Commission was constituted to look into the cases of candidates in whose case the recommendations have been kept withheld on grounds that the candidates have submitted documents viz. Domicile/Registration certificates etc. which have been issued/obtained after the cutoff date and that the Committee shall scrutinize these cases and make appropriate recommendations for consideration of the Commission.

14. A notice was also issued and the candidates were conveyed that if he/she wishes to make any representation before said Committee of Members the same may be done within five days positively.

15. The Committee after detailed examinations and deliberations and keeping in view the exemptions/ relaxations granted by various Government Departments recommended "acceptance of these deficient documents as one time exemption because of COVID-19 and not treated as matter of course in future."

16. The above recommendations of the Committee were adopted by the Commission and the recommendations w.r.t. 151 candidates from the select list and the 48 candidates from the wait list were released today on 06.01.2021. The decision w.r.t. remaining 32 candidates from Select List and 16 candidates from the waiting list will be notified in due course of time.

17. It is important to mention here that the Commission has in order to check impersonation introduced, for the first time, the system of Photography of the individual candidate at the entry of examination halls and also during verification of documents.

18. It is also important to mention here that despite the disruptions caused due to COVID-19 restriction, the recruitment of Medical Officer (Allopathic) was conducted on a fast track basis and completed within a period of less than five months from the date of referral of vacancies.
