Whereas, Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) under Accelerated Recruitment Program advertised 8575 District/Divisional/UT Cadre posts of Class-IV vide advertisement Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020 in pursuance of the Jammu & Kashmir Appointment to Class-IV (Special Recruitment) Rules 2020 notified vide SO 184 of 2020 dated 04.06.2020 read with other relevant rules; and

Whereas, the aforesaid rules inter-alia provide that the selection to District/Divisional/UT cadre posts shall be made by following the procedure of assigning additional weightages on the basis of laid down parameters in addition to the score obtained in the OMR based test; and

Whereas, upon the consideration of the merit of the candidates in different cadres a cut-off merit in each category was fixed and a total of 9652 unique candidates who were falling in the ratio of 1:4 of the number of requisitioned posts were shortlisted for document verification; and

Whereas, on the basis of merit of the candidates a Provisional Selection List/ allocation of Cadres for Class-IV posts was notified vide Notification No. SSB/Secy/Class-IV/2021/7072-81 dated 15.10.2021; and

Whereas, the extant rules provide for allocation of departments in addition to the allocation of cadres in favour of selected candidates by the JKSSB and in pursuance thereof, a selection list alongwith allocation of cadres/departments was notified vide Notification No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/7093-7102 dated 18.10.2021

Now therefore, in view of the above the candidates whose merit is above the final cut-off merit (Enclosed as Annexure "A") for this notification have been considered only for selection, depending upon the number of posts requisitioned in various cadres and departments. **Subject: Selection List-Cum-Allocation of Cadres/ Departments for Class-IV posts under provisions of the Jammu & Kashmir Appointment to Class-IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020 pursuant to Advertisement Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020.**

**NOTIFICATION**

Whereas, the General Administration Department vide No. GAD/Mt/RB-IV/50/2020 Dated 22.06.2020, forwarded a requisition for 8575 Class-IV posts pertaining to various departments for recruitment, in accordance with the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Appointment to Class IV (Special Recruitment) Rules,2020 notified vide S.O.184 of 04-06-2020 read with S.O 193 dated 17-06-2020 and other relevant rules governing the subject; and

- Whereas, S.O. 184 of 2020 dated 04.06.2020 read with SRO 99 of 2008 dated 07.04.2008, envisages that the Minimum and Maximum qualification for appointment to Class-IV posts under Direct Recruitment shall be: "Minimum Matric and Maximum 10+2"; and
- Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) vide Advertisement Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020, advertised 8575 District/ Divisional / Union Territory Cadre Posts of Class -IV in various Departments under provisions of the Jammu & Kashmir Appointment to Class-IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020; and
- Whereas, the aforesaid Advertisement Notification prescribed the terms and conditions for making appointment to these Class-IV posts which, inter-alia, laid down that:
  - The selections under this advertisement notification shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Appointment to Class IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020 as notified vide S.O. 184 of 04.06.2020 read with S.O. 193 dated: 17.06.2020.
  - Any candidate having his/her qualification other than prescribed shall not be eligible for Class-IV posts; and
- Whereas, the JKSSB conducted OMR based Objective type Written Test Examination for aforesaid Class-IV posts (Different Departments), belonging to UT, Divisional Cadre Jammu/Kashmir and various District Cadres, in three batches on 27th, 28th February, 2021 and 01st March 2021; and
- Whereas, the JKSSB vide SSB/Secy/Class-IV/2021/ 3951-59 dated 25.05.2021, notified tentative merit / score of candidates obtained in the aforesaid written examination and asked the candidates to submit grievances, if any with regard to score awarded to them; and
- Whereas, in response to the aforesaid notification, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board received around 17,000 representations from aggrieved candidates wherein primarily the following issues were raised:
  - some candidates claimed change in the score awarded to them in the written test;
  - some candidates sought grant of additional marks for the parameters which carry additional weightage in the laid down criteria, due to their failure to mention the same in the online application form;
  - some candidates sought change of reserved category for failure to indicate the same in the relevant entry of the online application form.
- Whereas, in terms of Rule 5(5) of the Jammu and Kashmir Appointment to Class IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020 read with amendment notified vide S.O. 193 dated: 17.06.2020, preferences were to be sought from the candidates in regard to allocation of cadres/departments in favour of the selected candidates

and accordingly, the candidates vide Notice No. SSB/COE/PAA/2021/2986-94 dated: 25.03.2021 were called upon to furnish their preferences online from 26.03.2021 to 01.04.2021, No. SSB/COE/PAA/2021/3187-95 dated: 29.03.2021 and SSB/COE/PAA/2021/3394-3401 dated 08.04.2021, which was extended upto 02.05.2021 vide Notice No. SSB/COE/PAA/2021/3586-94 dated 23.04.2021 ; and

- Whereas, Rule 6(1) of the Jammu and Kashmir Appointment to Class IV (Special Recruitment) Rules, 2020 provides for preparation of Shortlist, four times the number of advertised posts on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates and accordingly a Shortlist based on the scores obtained by the candidates in the written test and additional weightage claimed by them for different prescribed parameters in the online application form, was notified vide No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/4621-28 dated: 23.06.2021; and
- Whereas, the aforesaid shortlisted candidates were called for counselling-cum-document verification vide Notice No. SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/4832-39 dated: 07.07.2021, for verification of requisite documents to determine eligibility in light of prescribed qualification and entitlement for additional posts as claimed, and subsequently finalise/revise merit of the candidates, wherever required in light of the laid down criteria; and
- Whereas, those shortlisted candidates who failed to appear for document verification were given another opportunity vide No.SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/6001-12 dated: 08.09.2021to appear for document verification before the designated officers both at Jammu and Srinagar; and
- Whereas, the JKSSB also deemed it fit to seek from the shortlisted candidates, an undertaking duly attested by the Judicial Magistrate Class 1st to the effect that they do not possess higher than the prescribed qualification and accordingly, vide Notice No.SSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/4832-39 dated: 07.07.2021 asked the shortlisted candidates to produce the same in the Board; and
- Whereas, some of the candidates also approached the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal and filed O.A. 61/517/2020 titled by N.K.Tripathi &Ors vs UT of J&K &Ors for seeking quashment of condition 6 (iii) of the Advertisement Notification No. 01 of 2020 dated 22.06.2020; and
- Whereas, the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu was pleased to dismiss the aforesaid O.A. vide judgement dated 28.07.2021, the operative part whereof is reproduced as under:- "..... we do not find any reason to quash condition No. 6 (iii) of the Advertisement Notice No. 01 of 2020 dated 22.06.2020 issued by JKSSB. Accordingly, the O.A. is dismissed"; and
- Whereas, the JKSSB received various representations that a considerable number of shortlisted candidates, despite being graduates and above, are furnishing wrong affidavits with the intention of getting selected for the aforesaid Class IV Posts; and
- Whereas, the JKSSB accordingly considered it appropriate to analyse the data available for the posts having graduation or above as educational qualification and for which written examination were held in recent past, so as to gauge the extent of misrepresentation and furnishing of wrong affidavit by the candidates shortlisted for Class IV Posts; and
- Whereas, in view of the above, the JKSSB vide Notice No. SSB/Secy/Class-IV/2021/6013-21 Dated: 08.09.2021, provided an opportunity to all such higher qualified candidates who have applied for Class-IV Posts, to withdraw their candidature voluntarily against the aforesaid posts by or before 22.09.2021, failing which the JKSSB shall take necessary actions deemed appropriate under rules; and,
- Whereas, after the grant of opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the candidature, the Board received withdrawal applications from the candidates and accordingly, their candidature for Class-IV posts was treated as withdrawn for consideration against aforesaid Class-IV posts; and
- Whereas, a Selection Committee was constituted vide Order No. 321-SSB of 2021 dated: 10.09.2021 to examine the representations referred to hereinabove and prepare selection list for the Class IV posts;

- Whereas, the Selection Committee constituted for the purpose examined the aforesaid representations with reference to the available records through the concerned agency and settled procedures adopted by the Board in respect of such matters. After considering the representations, the Committee recommended as follows:
  - not to effect any change in the scores awarded to the candidates, based on the verification report received from the concerned Agency;
  - to consider and dispose of other representations as referred to above, separately later on, after holding consultation with the Law Department/ Ld. Advocate General through GAD;
  - to adhere to the qualification prescribed in the Recruitment Rules for the post and declare higher qualified candidates ineligible for the selection process;
  - prepare a revised merit list based of eligible candidates keeping in view the above aspects and notify the same for information of general public and candidates.
- Whereas, the matter has been examined by the Board in its 188th meeting, in light of the extant norms together with the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) in the O.A. referred to hereinabove and other relevant rules and terms and conditions governing the instant selection for Class-IV posts and it was decided to accept the recommendations of the Selection Committee; and
- Whereas, in pursuance of the aforesaid decision of the Board, a Revised Merit List of Eligible Candidates was prepared and notified vide No.SSB/Secy/Class-IV/2021/6882-91, dated 08.10.2021, and
- Whereas, the GAD vide SO-184, dated 04.06.2020, read with SO- 351, Dated 18.11.2020, has notified the procedure for allocation of Cadres/Departments for Class-IV posts as under:- "Candidates will be required to indicate their order of preference for allotment against District /Divisional /UT Cadre vacancies at the time of application or as and when considered appropriate by the Board"
- Whereas, the JKSSB at para-9 (vi) of the Advertisement Notification No.01 of 2020 had laid down as under: 9 (vi): in case a candidate does not indicate his/ her preference (fully or partially) as and when asked by the Board, he/she shall be deemed to have agreed to the Cadre and Department allocation as shall be done, by the Services Selection Board, and the decision of the Board in this regard shall be final and binding.
- Whereas, the Selection Committee also recommended to adopt a rational mechanism if need be based on parameters of Domicile District, next adjoining District; Domicile Divisions, etc for allocation of Cadres, in case of such candidates who failed to furnish their preferences despite repeated extension of Dates; and
- Whereas, the Selection Committee on the basis of aforesaid norms and parameters prepared a draft Provisional Selection List-cum-Allocation of Cadres in favour of eligible candidates figuring in the revised merit List; and
- Whereas, the draft Selection List-Cum-Allocation of Cadre/Departments was placed before the Board in its meeting held on 15th of October 2021, and after threadbare discussion, the draft Provisional Selection List as referred to above, was approved for notification; and,
- Whereas, the Provisional Selection List cum Cadre Allocation for Class-IV posts was notified vide Notice No. SSB/Secy/Class-IV/2021/7072-81 dated 15.10.2021, for information of the general public; and
- Whereas, the JKSSB received information through different means that many candidates with higher qualification than the prescribed, are figuring in the Revised Merit List and in the said context the JKSSB again vide Notice No. SSB/Secy/ClassIV/2021/7054-62 dated 15.10.2021, again notified for information of all concerned that if it is learnt at any later stage that any candidate has secured selection on the basis of giving false information or mis-

representation, despite having been granted repeated opportunities as explained hereinabove, or explicitly knowing about qualification prescribed under rules, his/her candidature shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio without further intimation; he/she also shall be liable for criminal prosecution for giving false affidavit in the light of judgments rendered by the Apex Court in this regard; and,

- Whereas, Rule 6(3) of the aforesaid rules, provide that the procedure for allocation of the Departments shall be prescribed by the Government. Subsequently, vide Government Order No. 692-JK (GAD) of 2021 dated 06.08.2021, the General Administration Department, conveyed that the principle/procedure for allocation to be adopted by the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board for allocation of the Departments among the candidates selected for Class-IV posts shall be as determined on the principle of 'Merit-cum-Preference'.
- Whereas, in pursuance of the aforesaid Government Order, the JKSSB vide Notice No. SSB/COE/Class-IV/2021/7063-71 dated 15.10.2021, called upon provisionally selected candidates to indicate their preference for allotment of departments through the link provided on the official website of the Board from 16.10.2021 (12 Noon) upto 17.10.2021 (12 Noon).
- Whereas, various representations were received from candidates with regard to the notified Provisional Selection List for Class-IV Posts which were considered by the Selection Committee and after due examination recommended their disposal, along with rectifications as necessary, to be made in the Provisional Selection List.
- Whereas, the recommendation of the Selection Committee relating to disposal of representation along-with necessary rectifications proposed to be made in the Provisional Selection, were placed before the Board in its 191st meeting on 18th October, 2021 and the Board upon consideration approved/accepted the said recommendations furnished by the Selection Committee.
- Now, therefore, in view of the above:
  - Selection List-Cum-Allocation of Cadres/Departments for Class-IV posts advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2020, dated 26.06.2020, is hereby notified as Annexure 'A' to this notification.
  - 29 posts of Class-IV are reserved in pursuance of the orders passed by the Hon'ble CAT in O.A No. OA/2011/2021, titled Rohit Sharma & Others vs Services Selection Board.
  - The aforesaid Select List shall be subject to the outcome of any writ petition(s) /WP (C) pending in any court of competent jurisdiction.
- It is further notified that:
  - If any candidate figuring in the aforesaid Selection List is found at any later stage, to be possessing lower/higher than the prescribed qualification with reference to relevant cut off date, he/she shall be himself responsible for that and his/her candidature shall be cancelled ab-initio without any further notice, and that he/she also shall be liable for prosecution in terms of the judgements passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
  - The Provisional Shortlist/selection in respect of vacancies earmarked for PwD candidates (Horizontal Reservation) for Class-IV posts is under process and shall be notified in due course. Thereafter the Select List-Cum-Allocation of Cadres/Departments in respect of such candidates shall be notified separately.
  - Some posts belonging to different reserved categories in each Cadre have been kept reserved for appropriately considering the candidates belonging to PwD category and certain others whose claims are under examination, in accordance with the rules governing the field.
