Army organizes medical camp

SRINAGAR, Jan 3: Army today organized a medical camp at Dardpora area of Kupwara District.

The area and its surrounding villages are located at the foothills of Shashabari mountain ranges and lack basic amenities and medical infrastructures such as Govt Hospitals and Primary Health Centres.

During recent interactions in Khariat Patrols, villagers have conveyed the requirement of medical assistance by med specialists, Army said.

Based on the felt need, a medical camp was organized by the Indian Army at Dardpora B village.

During the camp, the specialists from Government Hospital Kralpora to include gynaecologists, ophthalmologists, medical specialists and dentists ensured medical assistance to the people in this

remote region at their doorstep.

Two medical officers from the Indian Army have also provided much needed medical assistance during the camp.

All patients were received at the reception centre where they were given entry slips for specific OPD and face masks to ensure adherence to COVID protocols. From reception, the patients were directed to the waiting area for respective OPD.

The camp was attended by a total of 175 males and 138 females including children. Every individual was given a medical check-up along with specific medical advice in the various OPDs setup. Post completion of the check-up, medicines were also distributed as endorsed on the medical slips.

The doctors and staff from Kralpora Hospital were felicitated post completion of the camp as a token of appreciation from the Army.

Vaccinating 15-18 age group will be big respite to parents: Arvind

JAMMU, Jan 3: Jammu and Kashmir BJP secretary and Vaccination Incharge, Arvind Gupta, while expressing gratitude to Narendra Modi Government and the UT for launching the vaccination for 15-18 years age group, said that it will cover a large population and give respite to the parents who were most concerned for their children.

In a statement, Arvind Gupta, said that the decision of the Government to start vaccination for this age group will not only be one more step towards ensuring the benefit of dose to the uncovered children but also free parents of the worries related to their safety and well being.

Arvind Gupta, who has been coordinating the vaccination exercise with the UT administration on

behalf of the party, informed that after its launching on January 03, a target of 8.33 lakh has been fixed, which will be completed in ten days time. The Health Department has collaborated with the Education Department, under which first dose of COVAXIN will be injected to the students in the school premises itself. Moreover, this facility can be availed by non school going children in the already established vaccination centres across Jammu and Kashmir, he added.

Arvind further shared that those born in 2004 or earlier will be benefited by it and appealed the people to strictly follow the COVID Appropriate Behaviour in view of the reports of Omicron variant of the virus.

Gupta said that those falling in the fixed age group, will be given second dose after 28 days.

JAMMU, Jan 3: Workers of Dogra Front & Shiv Sena (DF&SS) under the leadership of their president, Ashok Gupta here today took out a protest rally against the delimitation exercise for increasing seats to Jammu far less than what the region deserves in Legislative Assembly.

In a handout, DF&SS stated that the administrative order of erstwhile princely State of J&K as regards the two regions of Jammu and Kashmir had Jammu region with area of 36315 sq. km with five districts—Mirpur, Jammu, Kathua, Udhampur, Reasi comprising 18 Tehsils plus two Jagirs—Poonch and Chenani.

It further quoted the administrative order of erstwhile princely State of J&K to say that Kashmir

region had area of 22133 sq. km with three districts—Muzaffrabad, Baramulla and Anantnag comprising only 10 Tehsils.

Addressing protesters Ashok Gupta said in 1947 after Pakistani illegal occupation of some areas of J&K including Mirpur and Muzaffrabad districts, the areas remaining free from Pakistani occupation were Jammu, Kathua, Udhampur, Reasi, Poonch Jagir and Chenani Jagir in Jammu region having area of 26293 sq. km were reorganized as six districts of Poonch, Rajouri, Jammu, Kathua, Udhampur and Doda and the areas of two districts—Anantnag and Baramulla in Kashmir region having area of 15948 sq. km were reorganized as three districts of Anantnag, Srinagar and Baramulla.
