scale" tax evasion through "under-valuation" and under-reporting of stocks, the IT department alleged. "Unaccounted stock of more than Rs 4 crore has been detected in Delhi alone," it said.

"The search action has led to the seizure of unaccounted cash of more than Rs 46 lakh," it added.

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After ECI sets the ball rolling, Rajnath indicates Assembly polls in J&K

"In Jammu and Kashmir, our neighbouring country is playing an important role in sowing the seeds of hatred. From 1947-48 tribal raids, till the recent targeted killings (by militants in Kashmir), there is a foreign conspiracy behind this," he said.

Kashmir, and with it, the Constitutional distance was bridged and a lot of changes which should have taken place much before started happening here," the Defence Minister said

Without naming Pakistan, the Defence Minister said the neighbouring country is not happy with India marching ahead despite various challenges.

"We have to thwart this conspiracy and the people of Jammu and Kashmir need to build their future with their own hands," he said.

"Our Government has taken the pledge of resolving the Jammu and Kashmir problem when it first came to power in 2014 when I was the Home Minister. The work is going on at a fast speed under the new Home Minister (Amit Shah)," he added.

Stating that the twin Union Territories of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh have a major role in "new India", he said the BJP-led Government took a number of steps for the welfare of the displaced people, whether they are West Pakistani refugees, PoJK residents or Chhamb migrants.

"There was no honest move to resettle 5,674 refugee families of West Pakistan but our Government provided them Rs 5.5 lakh per family for their one-time settlement and similarly."

"The package was extended to PoJK displaced persons and Chhamb refugees who were also provided Rs 5.5 lakh per family. A package of Rs 2,000 crore was given to Kashmiri migrant Pandits to create transit accommodations and jobs for them besides increasing their monthly relief," he said.

Singh said Jammu and Kashmir has witnessed the pain of displaced people and "we will not allow another displacement of any community, whether Hindus or Muslims or Christians, from any part of the UT. I assure you that we will not allow forced migration of anyone".

He said over 170 Central Laws and Acts like the Anti-Corruption Act came into force in J&K with the abrogation of the Article 370 and Panchayati Raj was strengthened.

Referring to PoJK and Gilgit-Baltistan, he said "Pakistan has no locus standi on these areas. Had it been so, its Constitution never mentioned it while as our Constitution says that PoJK and Gilgit-Baltistan are part of India and both the Houses of our Parliament have passed a unanimous resolution in this regard."

Rajnath said the 'future and picture' of Jammu and Kashmir is changing at a very fast speed and the time is not far when it will become an example not only for the country but for the whole Asia.

He said the people of J&K had suffered a lot of pain over the past 70 years as 'vote bank politics and vested interest' became a hurdle in revocation of Article 370 and strengthened the ideology of separatism.

"At last, the historic day came when both Houses of Parliament passed the resolution (on August 5, 2019) to end the Article 370 (granting special status to Jammu and

the second leg of his two-day tour of Jammu and Kashmir - his first after the abrogation of the Article 370 - said J&K suffered a lot over the past 70 years by living in isolation.

"The 'New J&K' will emerge and become an example not only for the country but for the whole Asia and I am sure about it," he said, stating that an investment of Rs 17,000 crore was made in J&K over the past 70 years but after abrogation of Article 370, investment proposals worth over Rs 38,000 crore had already been received which shows that the 'future and picture' of J&K is changing at a very fast pace.

"Article 370 kept J&K separate from rest of the country and the people have already foreseen the problems as a result of which agitation was launched by Praja Parishad which gave the slogan against two constitution, two Prime Ministers and two flags," he said, adding they were joined by Jana Sangh founder Shyama Prasad Mukherjee who gave up his life and thus revoking Article 370 became a national issue.

However, he said vote bank politics and other vested interests continued the Article 370 in the Constitution but when 2019 came "we made it clear in the party manifesto that we will end this to remove the burden on the people of J&K."

"When the manifesto was being prepared, I visited Prime Minister Modi because I was the chairman of the (manifesto) committee and told him that we have to finish this Article which he agreed to," he said, referring to the benefits various sections of the society like Pakistani refugees, Balmiki Samaj and others got by its revocation.

Rajnath reiterated the Government's resolve of development of border areas to bolster national security and said that institutions like JIM&WS can help in carrying forward that vision and contribute to the progress of the country. Emphasising on the importance of environment protection, he called upon the institutions like JIM&WS to promote eco-sensitive tourism and contribute in saving nature. He concluded his address with the hope that JIM&WS will become one of the leading institutes of the world in the coming times.

On the occasion, Rajnath also inaugurated Col KS Mal Bouldier Climbing Wall and Himalayan Museum at the Institute. The aim of JIM&WS is to expose the youth to nature and develop their personality, character and confidence through adventure sports.

termined Hafiz Saeed. Makki, 74, also known as Abdulrahman Makki, has occupied various leadership roles within LeT, a US-designated Foreign Terrorist Organisation (FTO). Both India and the US have already listed Makki as a terrorist under their domestic laws.

On June 1, India and the US jointly proposed to list Makki under the UN Security Council's Al-Qaeda and ISIL Sanctions Committee which is also known as the UNSC 1267 Committee. But, China, a close ally of Pakistan, placed a "technical hold" on the proposal to list Makki and this measure can last for up to six months at a time.

All decisions of the Committee are taken through consensus. In New Delhi, Government

sources said China's decision runs counter to Beijing's claim of combating terrorism and signals its "double standards". He has been involved in raising funds, recruiting and radicalising youths to resort to violence and planning attacks in India, particularly in Jammu and Kashmir, they said.

Protecting well-known terrorists from sanctioning will only undermine China's credibility and "risk exposing" even itself more to the growing threat of terrorism, they said.

"This decision by China is extremely unfortunate given the overwhelming evidence against Makki. Moreover, it runs counter to China's claims of combating terrorism," said a source. (PTI)

Pak stays on FATF Grey List

implementation of Pakistan's reform on countering terror financing mechanisms.

"At its June 2022 Plenary, the FATF made the initial determination that Pakistan has substantially completed its two action plans, covering 34 items, and warrants an on-site visit to verify that the implementation of Pakistan's AML/CFT reforms has begun and is being sustained and that the necessary political commitment remains in place to sustain implementation and improvement in the future," it said.

Inclusion in the 'Grey List' implies "strategic deficiencies" detected in a jurisdiction's policies to prevent money laundering and

terror financing, according to an IMF working paper. This makes it difficult for a country to get financial aid from world bodies like the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Not as severe as black-listing, the inclusion in the 'Grey List' shows that it is working to remove the deficiencies that have been flagged.

The FATF is a global body which focuses on "setting standards and promoting effective implementation of legal, regulatory and operational measures for combating money laundering, terrorist financing and other related threats to the integrity of the international financial system". (PTI)
