## BJP committed to implementation of UCC Art 370 was abrogated and not a single bullet was fired: Shah

 JAMMU, Nov 5: Union Home Minister Amit Shah today said no one would have imagined in the country that Article 370 of the Constitution of India will be abrogated and not even a single bullet will be fired.

In an interview to ABP Asmita, Shah said Prime Minister Narendra Modi displayed commitment and abrogated Article 370 of the Constitution of India (which granted special status to erstwhile State of Jammu and Kashmir).

"Not a single bullet was fired. Nothing happened in Kashmir. No one would have imagined this," Shah said.

The Central Government had abrogated special status of Jammu and Kashmir on August 5, 2019 and bifurcated erstwhile State into two Union Territories of J&K and Ladakh.

Shah reiterated his party's commitment to implementing the Uniform Civil Code in India.

He said it is part of the BJP's agenda, from the days of the establishment of the Jana Sangh and added that it has always been the Congress which opposed the Uniform Civil Code because the party itself practised the politics of appeasement.

The Home Minister said this in light of the fact that just days ago the Gujarat Cabinet chaired by Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel had cleared a proposal to constitute a committee to implement the UCC in the State.

Asked about who would be the BJP's CM face in Gujarat, Shah was categorical in his answer saying where is the question of change? The elections are being held under the leadership of Bhupendra bhai, so it is natural that the people of Gujarat will stamp their approval in his name.

## Arms, ammunition recovered 2 LeT hybrid militants, another held in North Kashmir

 SRINAGAR, Nov 5: Security forces today arrested two hybrid militants of Lashkar-e-Toiba (LeT) in Sopore area and a militant from Bandipora in North Kashmir.

A police spokesman said that on 4th November evening, a cordon and search operation was launched by police and 22 RR of Army at Shah Faisal Market Sopore.

He said that suspicious movement of a person coming from Bus Stand Sopore towards Shah Faisal market having a bag in his hand was noted and he was asked to stop, but he tried to flee from the spot.

"However, he was tactfully apprehended by the security forces. Upon search of the bag, one pistol, one pistol magazine, some pistol rounds and an Improvised Explosive Device were recovered," he said.

The police spokesman said during preliminary questioning, he revealed his identity as Rizwan Mushtaq son of Mushtaq Wani, resident of Hamray Pattan in Baramulla district.

He said Rizwan is a hybrid militant of the LeT and was in search of an opportunity to carry out attacks on non-locals, minorities, security forces and peaceful citizens.

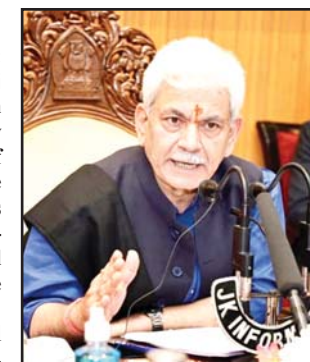
A case (FIR No. 250/2022) has been registered at Police Station Sopore against him and investigations are going on.

## PM visits Radha Soami Satsang Beas, meets chief Dhillon

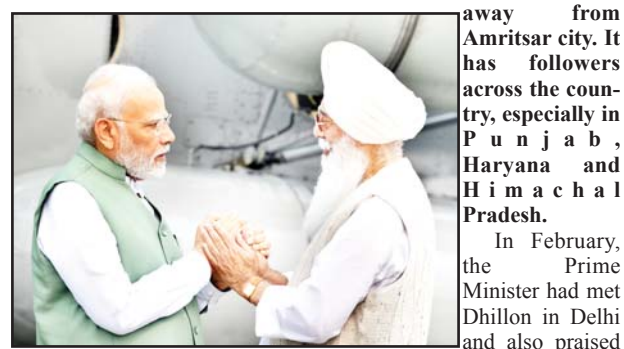
AMRITSAR, Nov 5:
