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4 CRPF cops, ASI's son among 7 more arrested by CBI in SI paper leak scam

The case pertains to the leak of the question paper for the examination through which 1,200 posts of Sub-Inspectors were to be filled by the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board. "Investigation had revealed that the alleged payment of Rs 20 to 30 lakh (approximately) was made by willing candidates and their families to the accused for accessing the question paper before the commencement of the examination," the sources said. The agency had recently arrested one Pradeep Kumar, working at an Okhla-based printing press as packing in-charge. He allegedly stole the examination question paper at the time of packing and sold it to Rewari-based Yatin Yadav, who was also arrested in the case. According to the sources, it was Yadav who contacted the other touts based in Jammu and Kashmir to lure candidates for the sale of the leaked question paper, they said. The candidates were transported from Jammu to Karnal in vehicles arranged by Jammu and Kashmir Police ASI Ashok Kumar, then posted at Nowabad Police Station, a day before the

examination. In Karnal, tout Bajinder Singh arranged a hotel where candidates were handed over the leaked question paper, the sources said. They said a CRPF personnel allegedly provided the leaked question paper to certain candidates. The exam results were declared on June 4 this year. After the allegations of malpractice in the conduct of the exam surfaced, the Union Territory Government constituted an inquiry committee to look into the matter. "It was alleged that the accused entered into a conspiracy amongst officials of JKSSB, a Bengaluru-based private company, beneficiary candidates and others, and caused gross irregularities in the conduct of written examination for the posts of Sub-Inspectors. It was further alleged that there was an abnormally high percentage of selected candidates from Jammu, Rajouri and Samba districts. The JKSSB allegedly violated rules in outsourcing the setting of the question paper to a Bengaluru-based private company, the sources said.

Govt amends Aadhaar rules

years from the date of enrolment for Aadhaar, update their supporting documents in Aadhaar, at least once, by submitting Proof of Identity (POI) and Proof of Address (POA) documents... So as to ensure continued accuracy of their information in the CIDR, in such manner as may be specified by the Authority from time to time," it said. The changes have been made by tweaking the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations. Last month, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) -- the Government agency that issues Aadhaar numbers -- had urged people to update identification and residence proof documents, if they were issued the unique ID more than 10 years back but had not updated their details since then. Accordingly, to provide facility to Aadhaar holders in this regard, the UIDAI has developed a new feature of 'update document'. This feature can be accessed online through the myAadhaar portal, and myAadhaar app or residents can visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre to avail of the facility. The new feature permits Aadhaar number holders to revalidate details by updating the POI (containing name and photo) and POA (containing name and address) documents.

after UIDAI's latest move, is not known immediately. Last year, about 16 crore updates of various kinds took place. In a statement issued last month, UIDAI had said, "Any person who had got their Aadhaar made 10 years back and not updated the information in any of the subsequent years are being requested to do document updation". UIDAI had strongly encouraged people to come forward to update their documents, citing the benefits of doing so -- more than 1,000 State and Central Government schemes leverage Aadhaar for identification and authentication of beneficiaries, transfer of benefits, and ensuring de-duplication. Of these, nearly 650 schemes are of State Governments and 315 of Central Government -- all of which use the Aadhaar ecosystem and its biometric authentication. The updation drive initiated now for Aadhaar issued 10 years back relates to the updation of demographic information and do not involve biometric update. A call on the biometric update will be considered if and when the need arises, a Government source had earlier said. (PTI)

J&K, Ladakh will always be India's integral part: SGI

November 7-18 at the UN Human Rights Council (UNHRC) here, Solicitor General of India Tushar Mehta also slammed Pakistan for raking up the Kashmir issue at the forum. "The entire Union Territories of Jammu Kashmir and Ladakh were and will always be an integral and inalienable part of India," Mehta said at the UNHRC, where the Universal Periodic Review of India's human rights record is currently underway. Mehta said that after the constitutional changes and reorganisation of the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir, the people of the region are now able to realize their full potential as in other parts of the country.

India abrogated Article 370 of the Constitution, revoking the special status of Jammu and Kashmir and bifurcating the state into two Union Territories on August 5, 2019. Mehta said that the government of India has taken several steps for all round development of Jammu and Kashmir including restoration of democracy at the grassroots levels, good governance, unprecedented development of infrastructure, tourism and trade. He noted that this year, Jammu and Kashmir has already received over 16 million tourists, "the highest ever so far."

His response came after the Pakistani delegate raised the issue of Jammu and Kashmir during his remarks at the review process.

He added that extension of over 800 people-friendly and progressive Central laws to the region has ensured better opportunities for all the people of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh.

The Pakistani delegate made six recommendations, including reversal of steps taken since August 2019 and access to independent observers to the region.

"These Central laws include affirmative action for the vulnerable sections, the right to free and compulsory education, non-discriminatory inheritance laws, protection against domestic violence and empowerment of women, decriminalisation of same sex relations and conferment of rights to transgender persons," he said. (PTI)

Modi Govt broke convention, acted against Pak-based terror camps: Shah

Centre and Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur-led Government in the Himachal have left no stone unturned to develop Himachal Pradesh, Shah said, citing measures like installing IT, AIIMS and Medical Colleges.

Shah also accused the Congress of doing politics when vaccines against Covid were rolled out.

"The double engine Government has scripted history in development in every sector," he said, urging people to elect the BJP for another term for the State's continued development. Addressing youths, he said they have no place in the Congress as it is not a democratic but family party. Taking a dig at the rival party, he said people often ask what kind of leaders the Congress has while the BJP has leaders like Modi, Jai Ram Thakur and Anurag Thakur, the last two being from Himachal. The Congress has 'raja-rani', he claimed.

"If you want opportunity in the Congress, you will have to be born in the homes of 'raja-rani'. But this is not raja-rani's but people's era," he said, urging people to support Modi who is the "people's leader" and has enhanced India's standing globally.

In an apparent reference to Congress leaders Sonia Gandhi and her son Rahul Gandhi and to State Congress chief Pratibha Singh and her son Vikramaditya Singh, Shah said, "Congress has Maa-Beta there and here too."

"Tell me, should not a grand temple be built where Lord Ram was born. Ever since Babur destroyed it, lakhs sacrificed their lives, but temple was not built. Congress kept it entangled... "Now, a grand temple is being built and it will be ready in January 2024," he said.

Kashi Vishwanath corridor which was destroyed by Aurangzeb, since then it was not built. It is this government which built the corridor, he said. "...We don't do vote bank politics, but we are also not scared of vote bank," he said, again targeting Congress.

The Modi Government, he said, gave cooking gas cylinders to 12 crore women, built toilets in over 10 cr poor households and provided free health insurance worth up to Rs 5 lakh to the poor.

The Chief Information Commissioner further said, "in the given circumstances, no cause of action survives for adjudication under the RTI Act since information available on record with the public authority as defined under Section 2(f) of the RTI Act has been duly furnished. However, considering the plight of the appellant and others like him, the Commission strongly recommends an expeditious decision on the issue of releasing the pending salaries of the employees, who have already suffered for over three years". In the appeal, the appellant had pointed out that the JAKFED was ordered to be wound up on August 31, 2019 when payment

of salary to employees was also stopped and vide State Administrative Council decision No.133/15/2019 it was ordered to frame an appropriate Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) for the employees of JAKFED. But till date nothing has been done. It had further been mentioned in the appeal that in the month of October 2020, nine JAKFED employees were adjusted and sent on deputation to the Union Territory of Ladakh but rest were not adjusted till date. "Since no salary has been paid since September 2019, the employees are suffering badly as such their salaries should be released without further loss of time. Moreover, they should be adjusted in other departments on the lines of those who have already been posted in other departments or organizations", the appellant had specifically pointed out in the Second Appeal.

HC quashes 8 PSAs

Justice Kazmi while quashing the PSAs said the non-consideration of the representation constitutes violation of the Constitutional right, guaranteed under Article 22 of the Constitution which depicts the failure of the Government to discharge its function. "It may not be out of place to mention here that grounds of detention does not reflect the date and year of the activities alleged against the detenu for which he has been put under preventive detention, as such, are vague and unsustainable" the court recorded.

Justice Chowdhary said that the authorities including Jail Superintendents are directed to release the detenu forthwith, provided they are not required in any other case. "In the present case, the procedural requirements, as discussed and noted above, have not been followed and complied with by respondents in letter and spirit and as a corollary thereof, petition requires to be allowed", read the judgment.

"There is nothing like an execution report and receipt of grounds of detention on the record to suggest that the whole material relied upon to base detention has been furnished to the detenu, so as to make an effective representation. The failure on the part of the detaining authority to supply material renders detention illegal and unsustainable", Justice Chowdhary said.

Justice Sanjay Dhar while dealing with the petition of Mohammad Shafi Bhat of Sopore Baramulla who was detained on 09.11.2021 said the petitioner has been hampered by non-supply of these vital documents in making an effective representation before the Advisory Board, as a result whereof his case has been considered by the Advisory Board in the absence of his representation, as is clear from the detention record as such quashed the same with the direction to release him from the custody.

Valley clashes, he said what happened in 2020 was an "attempt by one party, and we know which one, to depart from agreements and understandings and that is at the heart of the issue". "Have we made progress from then? In some respects, yes. Relatively speaking there were multiple friction points. In those friction points, there were dangerously close up deployments by the military, I think some of those issues have been worked out keeping in mind ead and mutual security," Jaishankar said. "But there are some which still need to be worked upon. I think it's in the nature of what I do that...It's important to persevere and to keep pushing. Because it is tough or it is complicated, you don't say, well that's not going to happen," he said.

"We are doing a lot of things in terms of various policies and various pronouncements and the state of relations after all, ask yourself if you are an objective observer, looking at the state of relations would you suggest that everything is okay and this can carry on without any negative impact for the parties concerned, I don't think so," he added. Jaishankar said there is no ambiguity in India's messaging to China. "I don't think there is any ambiguity about our signalling and our messaging. They will weigh it from their interests and where they are but...It isn't just a matter of public sentiment, and public sentiment is strong...I think it is government policy, it is national thinking, public sentiment and strategic calculation. I do not think that the current state can continue without damage to the relationship," he said.

The External Affairs Minister hoped that there will be realisation in China that the present situation is not even in its interest. "I keep on at it and I do genuinely believe that there will be, there should be a realisation that the present state of relations is not even in China's own interest," he said.

The ties between India and China nosedived significantly following the fierce clash in the Galwan Valley in June 2020 that marked the most serious military conflict between the two sides in decades. (PTI)

Khan suffered bullet injuries in the right leg when two gunmen fired a volley of bullets at him and others standing on a container-mounted truck in the Wazirabad area, where he was leading the march. He underwent surgery for bullet injuries at the Shaukat Khan Hospital owned by his charitable organisation. He is advised to take rest for four to six weeks by doctors.

"Pakistan is going to become a banana republic as there is no rule of law (in the country)...chief justice you will have to save the country. The country's future lies in your (CJP) hands," Khan asserted. Leading the march in the absence of Khan, former foreign minister Shah Mahmood Qureshi earlier said that the party chairman would soon join his supporters in the long march to Islamabad. (PTI)

Khan, who is recovering from injuries, said that the people who wanted him dead had planned to pin his murder on a "religious fanatic". "They planned that if a religious fanatic kills me, the responsibility from them will go away," he claimed.

Khan has blamed Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, Interior Minister Rana Sanaullah and Major General Faisal Naseer of hatching a plot to assassinate him. He made a passionate appeal
