NDPI demands Statehood restoration

JAMMU, Nov 24: National Democratic Party Indian (NDPI) has demanded early Assembly polls and restoration of Statehood in J&K. In a meeting NDPI J&K president, Rajesh Gupta flayed the government for price hike of essential commodities and said that PM Modi had promised to provide two crore jobs every year but only 7.5 lakh jobs were given in the last eight years. He claimed that in J&K, the administration has punished candidates who had qualified for various jobs as corruption and malpractices prevailed here. "Modi Government has resolved to render every deserving candidate jobless," Gupta alleged adding that J&K has a huge potential for power production and despite harnessing thousands of megawatts of power, the UT kept in dark. "People of J&K rightfully deserve a part of that power which is produced here," he maintained. Those who attended the meeting were Umesh Manhas, S. 5-shops gutted in fire

SRINAGAR, Nov 24: At least five shops were damaged in a fire that broke out in a shopping center in the Baramulla area of North Kashmir. According to an eyewitness, the fire apparently started in one of the shops at the Tanga shopping center close to the bus stand and eventually spread to other shops nearby. Locals called the fire department and the police, who responded and started putting out the fire. "At least five shops were destroyed before firefighting efforts began due to the fire's extreme intensity," a local said. An official said that the cause of the fire was not immediately discovered, but investigations have started. "Police have recorded a complaint, and further investigation has been conducted into the situation," an official said.

Police rescues 13 bovines

JAMMU, Nov 24: Cops at Police Station Nagrota near here rescued 13 bovine animals which were being illegally transported to Kashmir and seized the vehicle involved. Under the supervision of Inspector Vishav Pratap Singh, SHO Police Station Nagrota, cops at a check point on National Highway at Nagrota stopped a Truck bearing number JK08F-2385 whose driver escaped leaving the vehicle which was seized by the police and on checking it 13 bovine animals were found loaded in a cruel manner with no food and water for them. The cops rescued these animals and registered a case in this regard under the relevant sections of IPC.

Theft in teacher's house at Poonch
