

Number of girl students should increase: Prez

CHANDIGARH, Oct 9:

President Droupadi Murmu today said the number of girl students should be increased in technical educational institutions to give more impetus to the progress of the country.

Murmu was addressing 52nd convocation and closing ceremony of centenary year celebrations of Punjab Engineering College (PEC) in Chandigarh.

The President lauded the institute and said she was happy to note that it has provided many luminaries to the country.

Among its famous alumni, she named former Chairman of ISRO and father of experimental fluid dynamics research in India, Prof Satish Dhawan, eminent educationist and founder Director of IIT-Delhi, Prof R N Dogra and an expert in missiles technology and strategic systems, Dr. Satish Kumar.

Murmu said, Kalpana Chawla, an alumna of PEC's Aeronautical Engineering Department, became the first woman astronaut of Indian origin and created an inspiring history of self-sacrifice for science.

Noting that Kalpana Chawla Chair of Geospatial Technology is established in the institute, she said, "The number of girl students should be increased in technical educational institutions to give more impetus to the progress of the country."

She urged students to never forget their duties towards the motherland, whatever they choose to become in their life as they are the builders of India of tomorrow.

The President said as students are entering in a world of unlimited opportunities and possibilities, she has no doubt that they are capable of converting opportunities into success and possibilities into certainties.

It is expected from them that they will use the knowledge acquired in the service of humanity too, Murmu said, urging them to keep Mahatma Gandhi's message of 'Sarvodaya' in their individual priorities.

It is the moral duty of every citizen, especially the youth, to put into practice the values of the 'Father of the Nation', she added. (PTI)

Delhi Minister resigns after controversy over religious conversion event

NEW DELHI, Oct 9:

Delhi Minister Rajendra Pal Gautam resigned from his post on Sunday amid a controversy over his presence at a religious conversion event where Hindu deities were allegedly denounced.

The BJP had used the issue to attack AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal during the election campaigning in Gujarat and accused him of being "anti-Hindu".

In a letter shared on Twitter, Gautam said he attended the event in his personal capacity and it had nothing to do with his party or the ministry. He lashed out at the BJP for targeting Kejriwal and AAP Aadmni Party (AAP), alleging the saffron party was doing "dirty politics" on the issue.

Gautam said he is resigning as minister as he does not want his leader or AAP to be in trouble because of him.

The controversy erupted last week after a video went viral in which Gautam is seen at an event on October 5 where hundreds took a pledge to convert to Buddhism and to not consider Hindu deities as gods.

Leader of Opposition in Delhi Assembly Ramvir Singh Bidhuri said that Gautam had resigned due to pressure from the BJP.

He said that only the minister's resignation is not enough and legal action should also be taken against Gautam and he should also be expelled from the party for "condemning Hindu gods and goddesses".

"Apart from this, resignations should also be taken from the Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and minister Satyendra Jain who are involved in corruption," the BJP leader said.

Gautam had accused the BJP of spreading "rumours" against him, and apologised to "anyone who has been hurt due to such propaganda".

"I do not want my leader Shri Arvind Kejriwal or the party to be in any trouble because of me. I am

a true solid of the party and I will follow the ideals shown by Baba Saheb Ambedkar and Gautam Buddh throughout my entire life," he said on Sunday.

Sources in the chief minister's office said Gautam's resignation letter has been received by the chief minister and a decision on it is pending.

Gautam was the Minister for Social Welfare, SC and ST, Registrar of Co-operative Societies and Gurudwara Elections. He is an MLA from Seemapuri constituency.

The AAP leader said he participated in the October 5 event "as a member of a society in personal capacity" and it had nothing to do with his party and the council of ministers.

He said Rajratana Ambedkar, the great-grandson of Dr Bhim Rao Ambedkar, reiterated the 22 pledges (people take while embracing Buddhism) at the event and he had also repeated them along with more than 10,000 people.

"Since then, the BJP has been targeting our leader Arvind Kejriwal and the AAP which has paid me a lot," the letter read.

Gautam said crores of people repeat these 22 pledges at thousands of places across the country every year.

"The BJP is playing dirty politics on the issue which has paid me and therefore, I am resigning from my ministerial post," he said.

He alleged that the BJP has objections to Baba Saheb Ambedkar and his 22 pledges.

Gautam thanked Kejriwal for giving him respect and support and praised his party for the work done in the sectors of education, health, women and child development, social welfare, electricity and water.

He said the incidents of violence against the members of the Dalit community over the last few years and the discrimination on the basis of caste "impales his heart". (PTI)

Rahul Gandhi will be seen in new avatar after Bharat Jodo Yatra: Digvijaya Singh

TURUVUKERE (K'taka), Oct 9:

Rahul Gandhi has become a symbol of "Bharat jodo" (unite India) and will be seen in a new avatar post the Congress' pan-India march, senior party leader Digvijaya Singh on Sunday said.

Singh, who has been a part of the Bharat Jodo Yatra since it started from Kanyakumari, told PTI in an interview that the march has definitely impacted the Congress positively as it is for the first time after many years that the grand old party is being discussed in remote areas, villages and people are very impressed that Rahul Gandhi is walking all the way.

The yatra will help strengthen the party, he said while noting that the commitment to ideology and leadership is missing in the Congress at present.

Rahul Gandhi is spearheading the yatra that began from Kanyakumari and will end in Jammu and Kashmir. A host of Congress leaders will walk 3,500 km during the march.

"In this country, if anyone does 'tyag' (sacrifice), he is always revered. Sonia Gandhi did 'tyag' of the prime minister's post. And here, Rahul Gandhi is walking, sweating in the heat, standing in the rain, fighting all kinds of fake news and defamation. He has become a symbol of Bharat jodo," the former Madhya Pradesh chief minister said.

Asked which way has the Yatra helped Rahul, Singh said, "Well, you shall see him now in

his new avatar." He said he has known Rahul for a long time and once he decides to do something, nothing can stop him from achieving that.

"The day he decides, no one will be able to stop him," he said on Rahul's political journey forward.

"Frankly, I have always seen him as a very highly committed and ideologically committed person with a highly inquisitive mind. He would not let you go until he has his answers. And, he is a prolific leader and very spiritual too," the veteran Congress leader said.

Singh, who has dropped out of the race for the post of Congress president and became proposer for party veteran Mallickarjun Kharge, noted that the Congress is "extremely poor" as an organisation as compared to the BJP organisation, which is a cadre-based party.

The Congress is part of a mass movement and new leaders emerge out of past movements.

"Obviously, new leadership will emerge from the party," he said, adding those who are taking part in the march have left their homes and showing their commitment.

Elections for the Congress president's post will take place on October 17 and results will be announced on October 19.

The Congress veteran also dwelled on the weaknesses of the party and efforts to overcome them. (PTI)
