Clear stranded trucks on NH within 24 hours: CS

Tribal Affairs Department and Deputy Commissioners were directed to facilitate the "Deras" to move on the highway in trucks along with their family members and livestock.

The divisional and traffic management authorities were further told to encourage the traffic to use Mughal Road especially the vehicles loaded with less perishable items.

He urged the transport Associations and horticulture associations to cooperate with police and administration, maintain discipline and avoid spreading unverified rumours.

Further the NHAI was directed to follow all timelines given in by the Chief Secretary in his last meeting for clearance of muck from Cafeteria Morh and Mehar.

It was said that all the directions would be carried out in letter and spirit so that the travel time on the highway gets reduced considerably besides ensuring that no vehicle remains stranded for hours together.

Meanwhile, the administration has undertaken massive efforts to clear all fruit-laden trucks stranded on the Srinagar-Jammu National Highway after fruit growers raised the issue of apple trucks stuck on the way.

Govt likely to regularize all colonies of PoJK refugees in Jammu's outskirts

refugees are concerned, they were given 46,666 kanals of land on May 7, 1954 in Jammu, Samba and Kathua districts but were not conferred with ownership rights as they were not treated as the State Subjects.

The land was mostly allotted in Pargwal island in Akhnour, RS Pura and Bishnah tehsils in Jammu, parts of Samba and Hiranagar in Kathua district besides some other places.

As already reported by the Excelsior the Revenue Department is working out modalities on allotment of ownership rights to West Pakistani refugees. Number of refugees and their families, total land under their occupation, status of land and other formalities are being collected and a decision on conferring ownership rights to the refugees is expected to be taken soon.

The Government decision will end another major act of discrimination with refugees by the previous Governments which continued for more than 70 years till abrogation of special status of Jammu and Kashmir, the sources said.

As per the sources, the Government will take a decision as soon as all requisite formalities are completed by the Revenue Department.

Due to denial of rights to the West Pakistani refugees including State Subject rights, they couldn't get the Government jobs and other facilities to which residents of Jammu and Kashmir were entitled.

AC approves disinvestment proposal for JKCL

deductions like CP fund, GST etc. Earlier also, the Administrative Council vide its decision No. 113/15/2021 dated 19.10.2021 had given in-principle approval for complete sale of JK Cements Limited by exploring the option of ascending e-auction and an authorization to utilize 240 kanals of land adjacent to Khrew Plant at Industrial Estate.

The interested bidder should have a minimum net-worth of Rs 250 crore. The interested bidder should have a net positive EBITDA in at least three out of the immediately preceding last five financial years.

Key principles and actions underlying the recommended disinvestment modality includes 100% ownership in JKCL in favour of a private company/consortium. Further all the assets of JKCL on an as-is-where-is basis, along with approvals and licenses (including mining license) will be transferred as part of the share purchase sale.

"Referring to the alleged recruitment scam after which the Lt Governor's Administration cancelled recruitment for the post of Sub Inspectors (SIs) in J&K Police, Finance Accounts Assistants (FAA) and Junior Engineers in PW(R&B), Mehbooba said this is the biggest ever recruitment scam in the history of J&K."

"If there is any corrupt party on the face of earth, it is BJP. How did it become the richest party in the past eight years?" the PDP leader asked, accusing the party of using money power to bring down elected Governments.

"People are electing their representatives and the government. They are buying each MLAs for Rs 50 crore after the Enforcement Directorate, CBI, NIA and ACB fail to deliver in accordance with their plan," she alleged.

However, Mehbooba said, the people need to stand up and strengthen all those who can safeguard the country and its democratic institutions.

"Telling me the name of one BJP leader who went to jail for freedom of the country, leave aside sacrificing his life. You went to Balakote (in Pakistan) and used it to win the 2019 (Parliamentary) elections," she said, referring to the Air Force strike across the border in response to the Pulwama terror attack in February 2019.

2426 Dengue cases reported so far in J&K, 2092 alone in Jammu dist

on October 6, 135 on October 7 and 75 on October 8. They said with the change in weather and control measures taken by Health Department, the cases will start declining after 10-15 days. Pertinently, a total of 1709 Dengue cases and 4 deaths due to the vector-borne disease were reported last year in J&K, however, according to the sources no official death due to Dengue has been reported so far this year, which is a matter of satisfaction.

Sources said that every year after monsoon season, some Dengue cases are reported but sudden rise in cases this season, particularly in Jammu district has increased their problems.

"Citizens should change water in flower pots/money plant pots and water-coolers after every 7 days and does not allow stagnation of water in scrap materials such as old tyres and cans on their roof top or neighbourhood as after 7 days, mosquito larvae starts developing in stagnant water," they said adding, people should also prevent themselves from mosquitoes bites and for this they may use mosquito repellents and may wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants.

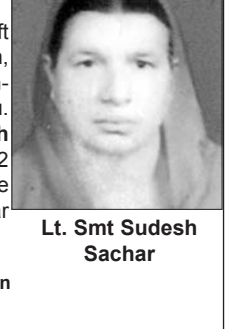

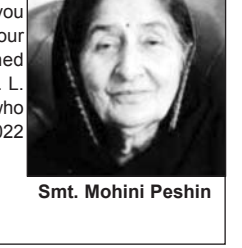

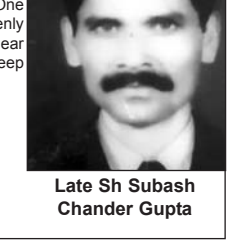
