JAMMU, Oct 13: Indian Army's assault dog 'Zoom' that was injured during an encounter in Anantnag district died during treatment at Military Veterinary noon today.

He said that apparently it was improving and responding well to the treatment but it suddenly started gasping and soon collapsed.

Earlier, Zoom was operated upon as it had gunshot wounds on face and rear right leg.

Zoom, the official said, was tasked with clearing the house where militants were hiding during an encounter in Kokernag area of Anantnag district on October 10.

"The dog went inside the house and attacked the militants. During the operation it was shot twice, resulting in critical injuries."

Zoom, a Melanois or Belgian Shepherd was born in September 2020 and has joined Army's 28 Army Dog Unit and had a service of 8 months.



**SpiceJet plane makes emergency landing at Hyderabad airport; DGCA orders probe**

NEW DELHI/HYDERABAD, Oct 13:

A SpiceJet plane coming from Goa made an emergency landing at Hyderabad airport on Wednesday night after smoke was observed in the cabin and aviation regulator DGCA is probing the incident, according to officials.

The plane landed safely and passengers disembarked through the emergency exit. One passenger sustained minor scratches on the feet while disembarking from the aircraft, a DGCA official said.

A Hyderabad airport official said there were 86 passengers onboard the Q400 aircraft VT-SQB and that due to the emergency landing, as many as nine flights were diverted on Wednesday night after the incident at around 11 pm.

SpiceJet has been facing operational and financial headwinds in recent times, and it is already under enhanced surveillance of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA). The regulator had also directed the airline to operate only 50 per cent of its total flights till October 29.

On Thursday, the DGCA official said the regulator is probing the incident.

"SpiceJet Q400 aircraft operating from Goa to Hyderabad landed safely at its destination on October 12 after smoke was observed in the cabin during descent. Passengers were safely disembarked," an airline spokesperson said.

According to the DGCA official, the plane made an emergency landing due to smoke observed in the cockpit.

On July 27, DGCA directed SpiceJet to operate a maximum of 50 per cent of its flights, which were approved in the summer schedule for a period of eight weeks owing to a series of incidents involving its flights.

Last month, the restrictions were extended till October 29. (PTI)

**Govt of India not sincere in holding polls in J&K: Vakil**

SOPORE, Oct 13: Jammu and Kashmir Peoples Conference, senior vice president and former minister Abdul Gani Vakil has said the Central Government doesn't seem interested in holding assembly polls in Jammu and Kashmir.

"While the Government talks of holding elections soon, but there seems no reality in what they say given the conditions being created around. The Government has shifted the examinations of students to March-April session, which is clear that the elections won't be held in that time frame too. So, it is ample clear that there is no seriousness from the BJP led government to hold polls in J&K," he said.

Addressing workers' meetings in Sopore and Rafiabad constituencies which included Patoosa Reban, Manzseer and Lalad, Vakil said the bureaucratic system imposed on the people of J&K has failed at every front. The unemployment is touching new heights and the apple sector is in losses. The development works have stopped and the ruling dispensation is restricted to press statements making lofty claims while on the ground, the situation is pathetic.

He asked the Prime Minister Modi to take necessary CBMs before holding assembly elections in J&K. "The Government of India should implement Confidence Building Measures (CBM), if they want larger participation including restoration of statehood to J&K," Vakil said.

He said apart from these CBMs, the fruit and tourism industry should be rejuvenated as thousands of families are directly or indirectly associated with these industries.

"Government should take special measures to boost fruit and tourism industry as the worst affected for the last three years of lockdown and restrictions including waving of KCC loans and other business loans," Vakil said.

"There are no jobs for our youth, petrol and diesel prices are touching the skies. There is no one who can speak on these issues faced by common people," he added.

Although the administration is talking of development, but that is restricted to papers and statements only. "There are thousands of daily wagers who have been assured regularization on different occasions but nothing has been done so far and it would add feather in the cap if before elections government orders regularization of these workers," he said.

Senior leaders Tariq Ahmad, Tariq Khan, Fayaz Ahmad Naikoo, Mohd Muzaffar Naikoo and others also spoke on the occasion.

KARGIL, Oct 13: Deputy Commissioner/CEO, LAHDC, Kargil Santosh Sukhadeve today chaired a review meeting regarding progress on shifting of District Hospital Kargil to newly constructed 300 bedded hospital at Kurbathang.

The meeting was attended by Superintending Engineer R&B, Chief Planning Officer Abdul Hadi, Chief Medical Officer, Executive Engineer R&B, Executive Engineer PHE, Executive Engineer Electric Distribution Division, Executive Engineer Mechanical and Medical Superintendent of District Hospital Kargil.

During the meeting, DC Santosh inspected the work progress of every section of the 300 bedded hospital and sought details about the ongoing works by the concerned departments.

He directed that all pending works should be completed and the sections should be functional before October 20 and directed to present requirements for early approval.

The DC gave deadline to Mechanical Department to complete the work by October 17. He also instructed to complete elevator work and ensure its functioning before October 25.

Santosh directed the Medical Superintendent, District Hospital to closely monitor the progress of shifting of various departments to 300 bedded hospital and ensure that all the formalities are put in place before the timelines prescribed by the administration. Further, the MS was asked to submit daily updates of progress on shifting.
